Binding & Loosing



PRAY FOR YOU

Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne; mercy and truth go before Your face (Ps. 89:4). A fire goes before You and burns up

Your enemies' round about (Ps. 94:3). Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9). In the name of <u>Jesus</u> <u>Christ</u>, we take up the cup of salvation, and call upon the name of the Lord (Ps. 116:13); we lift up you and your entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to the Father (Math. 6:9), all of your family (Acts 13:26), all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all your natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of your spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2). In the mighty and awesome name of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, thanks to the name of the Lord (Ps. 122:4), in His awesome name we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for you, your posterity (Prov. 11:21) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). The words that <u>Christ</u>, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to you and your family (Acts 13:26) are spirit, and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (1 Cor. 15:57)!

Grace and peace be multiplied to you and your family in the knowledge of God and of *Jesus* our Lord, as His divine power has given to you and your family all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called you and yours by glory and virtue, by which have been given to you exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you and your family may be a partaker of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust (2 Pet. 1:2-4). And we know that the Son of God has come and has given you and your family an understanding, that you may know Him who is true; and you are in Him who is true, in *His Son Jesus Christ*. This is the true God and eternal life (1 John 5:20). He is the Rock, His work is perfect; for all His ways are justice, a God of truth and without injustice; righteous and upright is He. BIND SATAN AND BREAK CURSES

The righteous cry out, and the Lord hears, and delivers us out of all our troubles (Ps. 34:17). Some trust in chariots, and some in horses; but we will remember the name of the Lord our God (Ps. 20:7). It is written in Matthew 16:19: "And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on

earth will be loosed in heaven." In the name of <u>Jesus Christ (John 16:23</u>), who sits at the right hand of the Majesty on high (Heb. 1:3), as an ambassador of *Christ*, abiding in *Christ* (John 15:4-5) and Him in us (John 6:56, John 15:5), born of God and One with Him, we bind you (Matt. 16:19), Satan, according to Ephesians 6:12. In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), Jesus Christ, we break Satan's powers (Luke 10:19) over you and your family (Acts 13:26). In *Christ* (John 15:4), Him who God raised from the dead and seated *Him* at His right hand in the heavenly *places*, far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come, and in His name, Jesus Christ, we break off of you and your family and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) all principalities, powers, the rulers of the darkness of this age, spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places (Eph.6:12) and all occult activity -- curses (Duet. 23:4-5), spells (Duet. 18:10) witchcraft, soothsaying (Duet. 18:10), divination (Lev. 19:26) and sorcery (Duet. 18:10) and all soul power that does not glorify our Lord Jesus Christ. We command every curse sent against you and your family and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to return to its source. Whosoever curses you and your posterity (Prov. 11:21), His trouble shall return upon his own head, and his violent dealing shall come down on his own crown (Ps. 7:16). May the Lord your God turn every curse into a blessing for you and your family and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), for the Lord your God loves you and your family and your people (Ps. 148:14) (Duet. 23:5). In the precious name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), who has authority over all flesh (John 17:2), as an ambassador of *Christ* (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in *Christ* (John 15:4-5) we bind the kings of evil with chains, and the nobles of evil with fetters of iron; to execute on them the written judgment - this honor have all His saints (Ps. 149:8-9). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), who is the head of all principality and power (Col. 2:10), and by the authority of **Jesus** Christ, who is from God and sent by God (John 7:29), as a chosen vessel of Jesus Christ (Acts 9;15), to bear His name, we destroy the works (1 John 3:8) of the enemy over you and your family (Acts 13:26), and come against any soul power (Luke 10:19) or emotional ties that do not glorify our Lord Jesus Christ. By the word of truth, by the power of God, by the armor of righteousness on the right hand and on the left (2 Cor. 6:7), in the mighty name of **Jesus Christ**, and by the blood of His sacrifice, we break off of you and your family all generational curses, blood curses, rash vows, and we sever all unholy alliances that you or your ancestors might have made. For you and your family are not your own, your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own (1 Cor. 6:19). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23) and by the power of the Highest , who has authority over all flesh (John 17:2), by the blood of *Jesus Christ*, we close all doors left open to Satan or any demonic

influence, for the promise of God is He will make justice the measuring line in your life and righteousness the plummet in your heart (Ps. 72:4, Ps. 102:28, Ps 103:17, Ps. 115:14, Prov. 14:26; the hail will sweep away the refuge of lies you have believed, and the waters will overflow the hiding place, the secret sins (Ps. 19:13) and the hidden bitter roots (Heb. 12:15) in your heart. In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), who sits with you and your family on the right hand of the power of God (Luke 22:69), we command Satan and all those who answer to him to get under your feet. It is written: "And the God of peace will crush Satan under your foet shortly. The grace of our Lord <u>Jesus Christ</u> be with you and your family and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Amen" (Rom. 16:20).

AUTHORITY

It is written: "Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you" (Luke 10:19). As a vessel of mercy, so that <u>Christ</u> might make known to you and your family the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23), we loose (Matt. 16:19) you and your family (Acts 13:26) from his (Satan's) hold and destroy his works (1 John 3:8-9) and his assignment in the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), the Son of Man which has come to seek and to save that which was lost (Luke 19:10). As an ambassador of <u>Christ</u> (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in <u>Christ</u> (John 15:4-5) and one with Him (John 17:22) we speak to you, Satan, in the mighty and precious name of <u>Jesus</u> of Nazareth (John 16:23),

declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness (Rom. 1:3). Abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), in the precious name of our savior, <u>Jesus Christ</u>, we take authority (Luke 10:19) and bind (Matt. 16:19) all demonic spirits assigned to you and your family (Acts 13:26) and we relieve them of their assignments. In Him who is true, <u>Jesus Christ</u>, in His mighty name, we take authority over all the power of the enemy over you and your family and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and command that nothing shall grow from it ever again, it shall wither away at the root just as the fig tree withered away when <u>Jesus</u> cursed it in Matt. 21:19.

STRONGHOLDS AND MIND SETS

In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask Father God, in the name of His beloved son, *Jesus* Christ (John 16:23), the author and finisher of your faith (Heb. 12:2), to help you and your family and (Acts 13:26) tear down all strongholds that empower wicked, unclean or evil spirits, casting down arguments, imaginations, and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of *Christ*, and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled (2 cor. 10:4-6). He is a spirit of justice to him who sits in judgment. and He is strength to those who turn back the battle at the gate (ls. 28:5-6). Lift up your heads, O you gates! And be lifted up, you everlasting doors! And the King of glory shall come in. Who is this King of glory? The Lord strong and mighty, The Lord mighty in battle. Lift up your heads, O you gates! And lift them up, you everlasting doors! And the King of glory shall come in. Who is this King of glory? The Lord of hosts, He is the King of glory. Selah (Ps. 24.7-10)

As a vessel of mercy, so that *Christ* might make known to you and your family the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23), we command Satan to loose (Matt. 16:19) you and your family (Acts 13:26) and let you go free in the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), the Mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), *Jesus Christ*, we demand that Satan and his demonic hoard stop their maneuvers, their schemes, their tricks, their designs, their devices (2 Cor. 2:11) against you and your family and your people (Ps. 148:14), for you and your family (Acts 13:26) are the children of God (1 John 3:1). You and your family (Acts 13:26) are covered by the blood of *Jesus Christ* (1 Pet. 1:19), the precious Lamb slain for you (John 1:29), the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world (John 1:29). The voice of the Lord makes the deer give birth, and strips the forests bare; and in His temple everyone says, "Glory!" The Lord sat enthroned at the Flood, and the Lord sits as King forever. The Lord will give strength to His people; the Lord will bless His people with peace. (Ps. 29:9-11).

DEMON WARNING

Demons listen well. In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we declare, in the name of Jesus (John 16:23), for God created all things through Jesus Christ (Eph. 3:9), you and your family (Acts 13:26) are the children of the God Most-High (Gen. 14:18, Rom 8:16). You and your people (Ps. 148:14) are covered by the blood of *Jesus Christ* (1 Pet. 1:19), our Lord and Savior. You and yours have a blood covenant relationship with the God Most-High (Gen. 14:18, 1 Cor. 11:25), the Lord God of hosts (2 Sam. 5:10). Your bodies and your minds are the temple of the living God (1 Cor. 3:16), the Most-High God (Gen. 14:18), the Lord God of hosts (2 sam.5:10), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Alpha and the Omega (Rev. 1:8), the Creator of all things (Gen. 1:1), the only true God (John 17:3) and the Spirit of God dwells within you and your family (1 Cor. 3:16) and His banner covers your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) (Ex. 17:15). If anyone defiles the temple of God, God will destroy him. For the temple of God is holy, which temple you. *Christ*, through us, takes authority and commands all demons not to defile this temple, which you are, in any manner or by any means. In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the great High Priest (Heb. 10:21), abiding in Him (John 15:4-5), and one with Him (John 17:22) we bind (Math 16:19) the spirits of doubt (Matt. 14:31), deception (Rom. 1:29), control and seduction, manipulation, intimidation, domination, bondage (Rom. 8:15), destruction (Rom. 3:16), idleness or laziness, gossip (1 Tim. 5:13), revelry, drunkenness or drug addictions, lewdness (Rom. 13:13), unrighteousness, sexual immorality, vile (Rom. 1:26) passion (Col. 3:5), wickedness, strife, evil-mindedness, violence, boasting, disobedience (Rom. 1:29-31), finger pointing, fault finding, critical, judgmental, religious spirits (), anger, bitterness, wrath, clamor, resentment, malice, evil speaking (Eph. 4:31), filthy language (Col. 3:8) jealousy, envy (Gal. 5:21), possessiveness, perceived injury, indignation (Rom. 2:8), guilt (Heb. 10:22), condemnation (Rom. 5:16, 8:1), division (Rom. 16:17), lies (Acts 5:3, Eph. 4:24), self-righteousness (false humility) (Col. 2:23), fear (Rom. 8:15), mockery, abuse, meanness, unkindness (1 Cor. 13:4), discouragement, depression, suicide, insanity (Rom. 1:28), conceit, rudeness, self-seeking (1 Cor. 13:5), (James 3:14) Selfishness (2 Cor. 12:20, 2 Tim. 3:2)), mammon (Luke 16:11), loving money (2 Tim. 3:2), idolatry (1 Cor. 10:14), evil desires (Col. 3:5) boasting, disobedience, blasphemy, un-thankfulness, slander, brutality, treachery, pleasure seeking (2 Tim. 3:3-4), foolishness (Rom. 1:22), futile thoughts, day dreaming (Rom. 1:21), pride (Rom. 1:30), covetous (Ex. 20:17), greed, gluttony, adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery and divination, hatred, contentions, jealousy, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, backbiting, whispering, conceit, tumult (2 Cor. 12:20) dissension's, heresies, murder, kidnapping, perjury, sodomy (1 Tim 1:10), drunkenness and addictions, revelries (Gal. 5:19-21) stealing (Eph. 4:28), corrupting (Eph. 4:29), foolish talking (Eph. 5:4), coarse jesting (Eph. 5:4), stubborn, prideful, know it all (), lawlessness, insubordination, profanity (1 Tim. 1:9), flattery, licentiousness (2 Pet. 2:18) and lusts of the flesh (2 Peter 2:18), the lust of the eye and the pride of life (1 John 2:16) and all unnamed evil (Luke 7:21), wicked (Ps. 12:8) or unclean spirits (Luke 8:29). As God's fellow worker (1 Cor. 3:9), in Christ (John 15:4) we bind (Math 16:19) the arrogant, pompous (1 Cor. 13:4), busy body (1 Tim. 5:13), provoking, evil thinking (1 Cor. 13:5), undiscerning, untrustworthy, unloving, unforgiving, unmerciful (Rom. 1:31), unholy (2 Tim. 3:3-4) critical (), judgmental (Rom. 2:1), defiling (Rev. 21:27) headstrong, and haughty spirits (2 Tim. 3:3-4) as well. As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), in *Christ* (John 15:4) we bind all spirits that cause you and your family to lack self-control (2 Tim. 3:3-4) or be haters of God, inventors of evil things (Rom. 1:2931), or despisers of good (2 Tim. 3:3-4). Abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), in the mighty name of Jesus Christ, Christ, Him being in us and we being in Christ (John 15:4), we bind (Math 16:19) the religious spirit (self-imposed religion) (Col. 2:23), having a form of godliness but denying its power (2 Tim. 3:5), as well as the antichrist spirit (1 John 2:18) and all unnamed demonic spirits that causes an abomination or a lie (Rev. 21:27). In the name of your Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, who has authority over all flesh (John 17:2), who is far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come, who is the head of all principality and power (Col. 2:10), as an ambassador of Christ (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in Christ (John 15:4) and Him in us (John 15:4-5), we loose you and your family and all of your people (Ps. 148:14) from the power these spirits have over you and by the authority that **Jesus Christ** has given us, we set you free. Therefore, if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed (John 8:36). He, Jesus Christ, is fairer than the sons of men; grace is poured upon His lips; therefore, God has blessed Him forever. Gird Your sword upon Your thigh, O Mighty One, with Your glory and Your majesty. And in Your majesty ride prosperously because of truth, humility, and righteousness; and Your right hand shall teach You awesome things. Your arrows are sharp in the heart of our enemies. Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; a scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom. You, Lord Jesus, love righteousness and hate wickedness; therefore, God, our God, has anointed You with the oil of gladness. All Your garments are scented with myrrh and aloes and cassia, out of the ivory palaces, by which they made You glad. (Ps. 45:2-8) The Lord of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge. Selah (Ps. 46:7). Thanks be to God, who gives you and your family the victory through our Lord Christ Jesus (1 Cor. 15:57). Yours, O Lord, is the greatness, the power and the glory, the victory and the majesty; for all that is in heaven and in earth is Yours's; Yours is the kingdom, O Lord, and You are exalted as head over all. (1 Chr. 29:11)

Being with Jesus Christ where He is (John 17:4), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and all of your people (Ps. 148:14); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time (Is. 9:7, Is. 59:21) so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Judges 18:6, Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in you (John 14:23).

Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Thess. 5:23). In the name of *Jesus Christ*, our help is in the name of the Lord, Who made heaven and earth (Ps. 124:8), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2)! In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. God said it. We believe it. It is settled forever. In *Jesus'* name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! Amen!
