## A Prayer for Our Children: Increase

To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him *be* glory and dominion forever and ever (Rev. 1:5-6). As a king (Rev. 5:10) abiding in (1 John 2:29) and one with (John 17:11) the King of Kings (Rev. 17:14), in the authority given

to us (Luke 10:19) in the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Philp. 2:10) we speak words of life (John 6:63) over the children of the United States of America, all those the Lord God chose before the foundation of the world, that they should be holy and without blame before Him in love, having predestined them to adoption as sons by <u>Jesus Christ</u> to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He has made them accepted in the Beloved (Eph. 1:4-6). They are the inheritance of our <u>Lord</u> <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Ps. 2:8) and we are joint heirs with <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 8:17) so we call them Our Beloved Children.

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come into the heart of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21). Your will be done in the life of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). As an ambassador of *Christ* (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in *Christ* (John 15:4-5) and one with Him (John 6:56, John 15:5), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), in His Son Jesus Christ (1 John 5:20), we give thanks to the Lord (1 Thess. 5:18), the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21), their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire family (Acts 13:26), and their nation (Math. 21:43) for the saints (Eph. 6:18), for the leaders that God has raised up on their behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23) so that **Christ** might make known to them the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21) their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), for their entire family (Acts 13:26), their friends, neighbors and countrymen (1 Tim. 2:1-2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43); for all the brethren (Eph. 6:18), all those called by the name of the Lord (Deut. 28:10); for the leaders of their nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the wellbeing of God's people; and all the people of their nation, and all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2), so

that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence (1 Tim. 2:1-2). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2)! We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God (Rom. 5:2)! It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) (James 5:16) their family (Acts 13:26) and their nation (Math. 21:43), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that <u>Christ</u>, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) are spirit and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (1 Cor. 15:57)!

We don't come to the Father in Heaven (Math. 6:9) based on our own worthiness (Is. 64:6), or on the worthiness (Is. 64:6) of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26). Abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), we come to God's throne of grace (Heb. 4:16) on the merits of His Son (Eph. 4:13), *Jesus Christ of Nazareth* (Acts 3:6), and the blood that He shed (Rev. 7:14). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), who upholds all things by the word of His power (Heb. 1:3), as a fellow worker in *Christ Jesus* (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), on every side (Job 1:10), all of their family (Acts 13:26), all of their blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all their natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of their spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43).

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), by the precious blood of <u>Christ</u>, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the Lord bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) and keep them (Num. 6:24). Glory to God in the highest (Luke 2:14)! Worthy is the lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing (Rev. 5:12)! Do not hide Your face from Your servants, O Lord; hear us speedily (Ps. 69:17).

Grace, mercy, and peace be with Our Children (Is. 61:9) from God the Father and from the *Lord Jesus Christ*, the Son of the Father, in truth and love (2 John 1:3). Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord (Math. 21:9)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), the King of Israel (John 12:13), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we call upon our Father God (Math. 6:9) and we ask that God would bless them indeed, and enlarge their territory, that His Hand would be with Our Children (Is. 61:9), and that He would keep them from evil, that they not cause pain. God bless them indeed (1Chr. 4:10). Of the increase of their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) and peace may there be no end, to order it and establish it with judgment and justice from this time forward, even forever (Is. 9:7). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) find favor in the sight of God and He will increase His mercy toward them (Gen. 19:19) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43). May it come to pass that God Almighty will send hornets before them and their family (Acts 13:26), which shall drive out their enemies from before them (Ex. 23:28). Little by little He will drive them out from before them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), until Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) have increased, and they and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) inherit the land (Ex. 23:30). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) He will love Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) and bless them (Deut. 7:13) and their loved ones and multiply them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43). So they and their family (Acts 13:26) shall rejoice in every good thing which the Lord their God has given to them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), them and the church and the stranger who is among them (Deut. 26:11). The Lord their God will make Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) abound in all the work of their hands (Deut. 30:9). The Lord will rejoice over Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) for good, in the fruit of their body, in the increase of their possessions, and in the produce of their land for good (Deut. 30:9). He has made with Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) an everlasting covenant, ordered in all things and secure, and He will make it increase (2 Sam. 23:5). As a co-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), we ask in Jesus' name (John 16:23), the Lord, our Savior, and our Redeemer, the Mighty One of Jacob (ls. 49:26), that the God of mercy (Ps. 59:17) make a hedge around Our Children (ls. 61:9), around their household, and around all that they have on every side (Job 1:10) and bless the work of their hands and make their possessions increase (Job 1:10). As their riches increase, in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor.

1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) do not set their hearts on them (Ps. 62:10), but earnestly seek God and make their supplication to the Almighty, that they and their family (Acts 13:26) will be found pure and upright, surely now God will awake for them, and prosper their rightful habitation (Job 8:5-6). God Almighty (Ps 89:34), El Shaddai (Gen. 17:1) grant though their beginning is small, their latter end will increase abundantly (Job 8:7). For their seed shall be prosperous, the vine shall give its fruit, the ground shall give their increase, and the heavens shall give their dew. God will cause them and their people (Ps. 148:14) to possess all these things (Zech. 8:12). Praise the Lord our God. Then the earth shall yield their increase, God, our own God, shall bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Ps. 67:6) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43). The Lord has been mindful of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26); He will bless them; He will bless their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43). He will bless those who fear the Lord, both small and great (Ps. 115:12-13). May the Lord give Our Children (Is. 61:9) increase more and more, them and their children. May they be blessed by the Lord, who made heaven and earth (Ps. 115:14-15). God shall bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), and all the ends of the earth shall fear Him (Ps. 67:7). The Lord, in the beginning laid the foundation of the earth, and the heavens are the work of His hands; they will perish, but He remains; and they will all grow old like a garment; like a cloak He will fold them up, and they will be changed. But He is the same, and His years will not fail (Heb. 1:10-12). Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; a scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your Kingdom (Heb. 1:8)! Praise the Lord!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), His name is exalted (Is. 12:4), now may the author and finisher of their faith (Heb. 12:2), increase their faith (Luke 17:5), that their faith grows exceedingly, and the love of every one of them all abounds toward each other (2 Thess. 1:3). Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) Will abound with blessings (Prov. 28:20). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) will give all diligence to add to their faith, virtue, to virtue knowledge, to knowledge self-control, to self-control perseverance, to perseverance godliness, to godliness brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness love. For these things are theirs and abound in Our Children (Is. 61:9) (2 Pet. 1:5-8). Now may the God of hope fill Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) with all joy and peace in believing, that they and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) may

abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit (Rom. 15:13). May the Lord God increase their joy (ls. 29:19). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) will abound in everything in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in all diligence, and in love and in grace (2 Cor. 8:7). God is able to make all grace abound toward them and their family (Acts 13:26), that they and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), always having all sufficiency in all things, have an abundance for every good work (2 Cor. 9:8). God of peace (1 Thess. 5:23) increase Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) all the more in strength (Acts 9:22). May the Most-High (Num. 24:16, Ps. 50:14), and the Ancient of Days (Dan 7:22), lift up a banner over Our Children (ls. 61:9) (Ps. 60:40), their posterity (Prov. 11:21), and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the Lord our God to bring them and their family (Acts 13:26) to the banqueting house, and let His banner over them be love (Song. 2:4). May God increase Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) greatly, and make them and their people (Ps. 148:14) stronger than their enemies (Ps. 105:24). According to the integrity of His heart (Ps. 78:72, Jer. 3:15) may God make Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) be fruitful and increase (Jer. 23:3) abundantly, multiply and grow exceedingly mighty (Ex. 1:7), and produce a hundred fold (Mark 4:8). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) the Lord will increase their greatness and comfort them (Ps. 71:21) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) on every side (Job 1:10); joy and gladness will be found in them, thanksgiving and the voice of melody (ls. 51:3). Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed they have sown and increase the fruits of their righteousness, being enriched in all liberality (2 cor. 9:10). May the Lord God give the rain for their seed for which they sow, and bread of the increase of the earth; it will be fat and plenteous (Is. 30:23). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) will honor the Lord with their possessions, and with the first fruits of all their increase (Prov. 3:9), so that they will scatter, yet increase more (Prov. 11:24). Mercy and truth have met together; righteousness and peace have kissed each other. Truth shall spring out of the earth, and righteousness shall look down from heaven. Yes, the Lord will give what is good; and their land will yield its increase. Righteousness will go before Him, and shall make His footsteps their pathway (Ps. 85:10-13). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will be steadfast,

immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that their labor is not in vain in the Lord (1 Cor. 15:58). Let them and their family (Acts 13:26) gather by labor and increase (Prov. 13:11), and they will receive their own reward according to their own labor (1 Cor. 3:8). So that men will say, "Surely there is a reward for the righteous; surely He is God who judges in the earth" (Ps. 58:11).

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), may God give the increase (1 Cor. 3:6). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) grow with the increase that is from God (Col. 2:19), and expand all their borders (Is. 26:15). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) the Lord will make Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) increase and abound in love to one another and to all, so that He may establish their hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our <u>Lord Jesus</u> <u>Christ</u> with all His saints (1 Thess. 3:12-13). Concerning brotherly love (1 Thess. 4:9), may they and their people (Ps. 148:14) increase more and more (1 Thess. 4:10). And this in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16), that their love may abound still more and more in knowledge and all discernment, that they and their people (Ps. 148:14) may approve the things that are excellent, that they and their family (Acts 13:26) may be sincere and without offense till the day of <u>Christ</u>, being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by <u>Jesus Christ</u>, to the glory and praise of God (Phil. 1:9-11). Blessed be the Lord God of Israel from everlasting to everlasting! Amen and Amen (Ps. 41:13)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), who became for them wisdom from God and righteousness and sanctification and redemption (1 Cor. 1:30), in His name may Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) increase in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men (Luke 2:52). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) will know wisdom and instruction, to perceive the words of understanding, to receive the instruction of wisdom, justice, judgment, and equity, prudence, knowledge and discretion. May they and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) hear and increase learning (Prov. 1:2-5). Now thanks be to God who always leads them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) in triumph in <u>Christ</u>, and through them and their people (Ps. 148:14) diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place. For they and their family (Acts 13:26) are to God the fragrance of <u>Christ</u> (2 Cor. 2:14-15). Grace and peace be multiplied to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) in the knowledge of God and of <u>Jesus Our Lord</u>, as His divine power has given to them and

their family (Acts 13:26) all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called them and their people (Ps. 148:14) by glory and virtue, by which have been given to them exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these they may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust (2 Pet. 1:2-4). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) are diligent to make their calling and election sure, for if they do these things they will never stumble; for so an entrance will be supplied to them and their people (Ps. 148:14) abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our <u>Lord and Savior Jesus</u> <u>Christ</u> (2 Pet. 1:10-11). Let them and their family (Acts 13:26) increase their joy in the Lord, and rejoice in the Holy One of Israel (Is. 29:19). Then they and their people (Ps. 148:14) will go to the altar of God, to God their exceeding joy; and praise Him (Ps. 43:4).

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), their nation (Math. 21:43) and all of their people (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify their time (ls. 9:7, ls. 59:21) so that they will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify their space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in them (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify them completely; and may their whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our *Lord* Jesus Christ (1 Thess. 5:23). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), Jesus Christ, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed (Dan. 7:14). The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein (Ps. 24:1). The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it (Ps. 10:11). For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him (Col. 1:16). You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created (Rev. 4:11)! As a fellow worker in Christ (Rom. 16:3), a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day

of vengeance of our God (ls. 61:2)! As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that Christ might make known to Our Children (Is. 61:9) their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), and their nation (Math. 21:43) the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23, Eph. 1:18), we claim Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), their family (Acts 13:26), their children and their children's children (Prov. 11:21) as our joint inheritance (Eph. 1:18) with our Lord Jesus Christ (Gal. 4:7). By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most-High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom (Dan. 7:22). Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and *Christ* will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin! And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now, our salvation is near (Rom. 13:11)! Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it (Is. 34:1)! In <u>Christ</u> (John 16:23) we pray that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) in one accord (Acts 1:14) will pray for the peace of Jerusalem for it is written: "May they prosper who love you" (Ps. 122:6). The LORD bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) out of Zion, and may they see the good of Jerusalem all the days of their life (Ps. 128:5). As kings and priests of the God and Father of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (Rev. 1:6), we decree Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) shall stand (2 Chr. 11:13) with Israel against the ungodly nations (Ezek. 13:5) for their shield belongs to the LORD, and their king to the Holy One of Israel (Psalm 89:18).

In the name of Jesus, the Shepherd and Overseer of our souls (1 Per. 2:25), we ask and receive all these things (Math. 7:7). Concerning this prayer of faith (James 5:15) that we pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with them (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). Being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), we pray (James 5:16) with confidence (1 John 5:14) for God's thoughts towards Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) are thoughts of peace, to give them a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11). As a chosen vessel of **Jesus Christ**, to bear His name (Acts 9:15), we continue petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to them (Luke 11:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. Praise the LORD (Ps. 149:9)! It is written: "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." says the Lord God Almighty **Psalms 89:34**. God is

watching over His word to perform it **Jerimiah. 1:12** and it shall not return to Him void: but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it Isaiah 55:11. The Lord gives voice before His army, for His camp is very great; for strong is the One who executes His word **Joel 2:11**! The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations Psalms 33:1. It shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, as the Lord has said, among the remnant whom the Lord calls Joel 2:32. "For My name shall be great among the nations," says the Lord of hosts Malachi 1:11. We ask our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) in the name of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), who gave Himself for us, that He might purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works (Titus 2:14), believing that Our Children (Is. 61:9), their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) receive all we ask for them (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14). You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of Your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! In Jesus' name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! Amen and Amen! For God will save Zion and build the cities of Judah, that they may dwell there and possess it. Also, the descendants of His servants shall inherit it, and those who love His name shall dwell in it (Ps. 69:35-36). By the blood of the everlasting covenant (Heb. 13:20), in the awesome name (Deut. 28:58) Of Jesus Christ (Rom. 14:11), the mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24), we activate (Math 16:19) these Prophetic Scriptures (Rom. 16:25-27) in the lives of Our Children (ls. 61:9). These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God: Amen! (Rev. 3:14). For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God! (2 Cor. 1:20)!
