A Prayer for Donald Trump from the collection of Prayers for the Precious. Hear our prayer, O Lord, give ear to our supplications! In Your faithfulness answer us, and in Your righteousness (Ps. 143:1). As a fellow worker

in <u>Christ Jesus</u> (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), we lift up you President Donald Trump, and your entire house, your nation, the United States of America, and all of your people to our Father in heaven. God is good. His mercy endures forever. God is good to you Donald Trump. God is good to all of your people for the Lord God is faithful, who will establish you and guard *you* from the evil one.

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come into the heart of President Trump and his bloodline. Your will be done in the life of President Trump and his bloodline on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). As an ambassador of *Christ* (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in *Christ* (John 15:4-5, John 6:56) and one with Him (John 17:22), we come into agreement with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). The words that *Christ*, through us, speaks to you President Trump and your bloodline and your family are spirit, and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through your Lord *Jesus Christ* (1 Cor. 15:57)!

For he who heeds the word wisely will find good, and whoever trusts in the Lord, happy is he (Prov. 16:20). May the Holy Spirit (John 14:26) teach you President Trump and your bloodline His statues (Ps. 119:12). May you President Trump and your bloodline rejoice in the way of God's testimonies (Ps. 119:14), meditate on His precepts, contemplate His ways (Ps. 119:15) and not forget His Word (Ps. 119:16). May the Lord turn away your

eyes from worthless things (Ps. 119:37), establish His word to you President Trump and your bloodline and your house (Ps. 119:38) and revive you in His righteousness (Ps. 119:40). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you President Trump and your bloodline will entreat God's favor with your whole heart that He will be merciful to you and your house according to His word (Ps. 119:58). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that God will deal well with you President Trump and your bloodline and your people according to His word (Ps. 119:65), that He will teach you good judgment and knowledge (Ps. 119:66), that He will give you understanding (Ps. 119:73), that you are good and do good (Ps. 119:68). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that God's merciful kindness be for your comfort, according to His word. Let His tender mercies come to you President Trump and your bloodline that you may live and delight (Ps. 119:76-77) and hope in His word (Ps. 119:74). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that the God of love (John 15:10), revive you President Trump and your bloodline and your family according to His loving kindness, so that you will keep the testimonies of His mouth. Forever, O Lord, Your word is settled in heaven. Your faithfulness endures to all generations. You established the earth, and it abides (Ps. 119:88-90). May the word of God be sweet to your taste, sweeter than honey to your mouth (Ps. 119:103)! Let the word of God be a lamp to your feet and a light to your path (Ps. 119:105). May you President Trump and your bloodline and your house praise the name of the Lord, for His loving kindness and His truth; For God has magnified His word above all His name (Ps. 138:2). How great are His signs, and how mighty His wonders! His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and His dominion is from generation to generation (Dan. 4:3)!

In the name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23), who is full of grace and truth (John 1:14), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you President Trump and your bloodline and your children will not stray from God's precepts. Great are Your tender mercies, O Lord (Ps. 119:156)! May the great physician (Luke 4:23), send His word and heal you, and deliver you from your destruction's. Oh, that you President Trump and your bloodline and your people will give thanks to the Lord for His goodness, and for His wonderful works to you! May you sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare His works with rejoicing (Ps. 107:20-22)! We ask, in the name of **Jesus** (John 16:23), whom God set forth, to be a propitiation by His blood, through faith (Rom. 3:25), that God will accept the freewill offerings of your mouth and teach you His judgments (Ps. 119:108). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray to our Father in Heaven, in the name of his only begotten son, *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), that he will give you President Trump and your bloodline and your children another Helper, that he may abide with you forever - The Spirit of Truth (John 14:17), to guide you into all truth (John 16:13). Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, honor, and glory, and blessing (Rev 5:12)!

In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray, in the name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23), who has authority over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to you President Trump and your bloodline and your people (John 17:2), that your heart be blameless (Ps. 119:80), that you President Trump and your bloodline and your people walk at liberty (Ps. 119:45), trust in the word of God (Ps. 119:42), and may the God of Power (Matt. 26:64), make you bold with strength in your soul (Ps. 138:3), that you not be ashamed. (Ps. 119:46) but with all boldness you President Trump and your bloodline and your people speak the testimonies and the Word of God (Acts 4:29), with authority and power (Luke 4:36), giving yourselves continually to prayer and to the ministry of the word (Acts 6:4), the Lord working with you and confirming (Mark 16:20) and bearing witness to the word of His grace,

granting signs and wonders to be done by your hands (Acts 14:3). For the word of the Lord is right, and all His work is done in truth. He loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of the goodness of the Lord. By the word of the Lord the heavens were made. And all the host of them by the breath of His mouth. (Ps. 33:4-6).

In the name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23), through whom grace and truth came (John 1:17), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that the word of God will come to your house (1 Thess. 1:5), give you President Trump and your bloodline and your children everlasting life (Ps. 119:50) that you shall not come into judgment, but pass from death into life (John 5:24), that you will never see (John 8:51) nor taste death (John 8:52), and may the God of grace (Eph. 2:7, Zech. 12:10), comfort you President Trump and your bloodline in your afflictions (Ps. 119:50). Though you walk in the midst of trouble, God will revive you President Trump and your bloodline; He will stretch out His hand against the wrath of your enemies, and His right hand will save you. The Lord will perfect that which concerns you President Trump and your bloodline; His mercy endures forever; He will not forsake you (Heb.13:5), for you are the works of His hands (Ps. 138:7-8). Remember His covenant always, the word which He commanded, for a thousand generations (1 Chr. 16:10-15).

In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we commend you President Trump and your bloodline and your house to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you President Trump and your bloodline and your house up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified (Acts 20:32). As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), we ask, in the name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23), the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world, that God will sanctify you President Trump and your bloodline and your children by His word. President Trump and your bloodline and your people will receive the word of God, that you will welcome it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which also effectively works in you President Trump and your bloodline and your family who believe (1) Thess. 2:13). Sing to Him a new song; play skillfully with a shout of joy! For the word of the Lord is right, and all His work is done in truth! He loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of the goodness of the Lord! By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth. He gathers the waters of the sea together as a heap; He lays up the deep in storehouses. Let all the earth fear the Lord; Let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him! For He spoke, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast!

In the name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23), by the precious blood of <u>Christ</u>, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), may you President Trump and your bloodline and your house, all of your people, renounce the hidden things of shame, not walking in craftiness nor handling the word of God deceitfully, but by manifestation of the truth commending yourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God (2 cor. 4:2). By the word of God's lips, may you President Trump and your bloodline and your people keep yourselves from the paths of the destroyer. Uphold the steps of President Trump and his bloodline and his children in Your paths, O Father, that his footsteps may not slip (Ps. 17:5). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you President Trump and your bloodline and your house will lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness (James 1:21) all malice, all guile, hypocrisy, envy, and all evil speaking, as newborn babes, desiring the pure milk of the word, you may grow thereby, if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is gracious (1 Pet. 2:1-3), and receive with meekness the implanted word (James 1:21), the word of truth (James 1:18), which is able to save your soul (James 1:21)

and make you free (John 8:32). But may you President Trump and your bloodline and your people be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves (James 1:21-22). Let your hearts be steadfast; and may you President Trump and your bloodline and your people awaken the dawn with your praise. For the Lord's mercy reaches unto the heavens, and His truth unto the clouds. Be exalted, O God, above the heavens; let Your glory be above all the earth (Ps. 57:7-11).

In the name of **Jesus** (John 16:23), declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness (Rom. 1:3), in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you President Trump and your bloodline and your children will continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with thanksgiving; (Col. 4:2-3) for the gospel did not come to you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Spirit and in much assurance, (1 Thess. 1:5) so whatever you do in word or deed, in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray you President Trump and your bloodline and your people do all in the name of the Lord <u>Jesus</u>, giving thanks to God the Father through Him (Matt. 4:4) and do all things without murmuring and disputing, becoming an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity (1 Tim. 4:12) that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, holding fast the word of life, being poured out as a drink offering on the sacrifice and service of your faith (Phil. 2:14-17). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you President Trump and your bloodline and your house will keep His word. and the love of God be perfected in you and your people (1 John 2:5). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you President Trump and your bloodline and your children will love **Jesus**, keep His word, and the Father in heaven and the Son of God, Jesus Christ, will come to you and your children and make His home with you (John 14:23). Oh, bless our God, President Trump and your bloodline and all of your people! And make the voice of His praise to be heard, who keeps your soul among the living, and does not allow your feet to be moved. For You, O God, have proved; You have refined President Trump as silver is refined. Thou you President Trump and your bloodline may go through fire and through water; God, our Faithful God, will bring you President Trump and your bloodline out to rich fulfillment (Ps. 66:8-12).

Now may our Lord **Jesus Christ** Himself, and our God and Father, who has loved you President Trump and your bloodline and your house and given you everlasting consolation and good hope by grace, comfort your hearts and establish you President Trump and your bloodline and your people in every good word and work (2 Thess. 2:16-17). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray, in the name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23), God's Holy Servant (Acts 4:27), that you President Trump and your bloodline and your children will be diligent to present yourselves approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth (2 Tim 2:15). Your covenant You will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of Your lips (Ps. 89:34), O God of Mercy! May all these things come to pass by the word of the Lord, and not one word will fail of any of the good things which the Lord has spoken to your house President Trump and your bloodline (Joshua 23:14)!

As a fellow worker in *Christ* (Rom. 16:3), a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (ls. 61:2)! As a vessel of mercy, so that **Christ** might make known to you President Trump the riches of His glory, we claim you President Trump and your house, your entire bloodline, all of your people, your family, your children and your children's children as our joint inheritance (Eph. 1:18) with our Lord **Jesus Christ**. By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of God Most-High, and the time has come for the saints (you President Trump and your bloodline) to possess the kingdom (Dan. 7:22). Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and *Christ* will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin! And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now, our salvation is near (Rom. 13:11)! Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), we pray with confidence (1 John 5:14) for God's thoughts towards you are thoughts of peace, to give you a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11). In the name of our Lord **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), who upholds all things by the word of His power (Heb. 1:3), in *Christ* (John 15:4) we ask our Father in heaven believing that you receive all we ask (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14). As a vessel of ministry (Heb. 9:21), we continue to petition (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to you President Trump and your bloodline and your descendants according to His word (Luke 1:38), and what we have asked shall be given to you and your house (Luke 1:9). The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations (Ps. 33:11). It is written: "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." says the Lord God Almighty (Ps 89:34). God is watching over His word to perform it (Jer. 1:12) and it shall not return to Him void; but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it (ls. 55:11). The Lord gives voice before His army, for His camp is very great; for strong is the One who executes His word (Joel 2:11)! In Jesus' name (John 16:23) so be it! We will worship toward Your holy temple, and praise Your name for Your loving-kindness and Your truth; for You, O Lord, have magnified Your word above all Your name (Ps, 138:2)! You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of Your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! We will rejoice in our salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners! May the Lord fulfill all our petitions (Ps. 20:5)! For Yours, O Lord, is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever (Matt. 6:13)! It is done! Amen!
