A Prayer for the Children of Israel The Word

To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him

be glory and dominion forever and ever (Rev. 1:5-6). As a king (Rev. 5:10) abiding in (1 John 2:29) and one with (John 17:11) the King of Kings (Rev. 17:14), in the authority given to us (Luke 10:19) in the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Philp. 2:10) we speak words of life (John 6:63) over the children Israel. We call all those the Lord God chose before the foundation of the world, that they should be holy and without blame before Him in love, having predestined them to adoption as sons by <u>Jesus Christ</u> to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He has made them accepted in the Beloved (Eph. 1:4-6). They are the inheritance of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (Ps. 2:8) and we are joint heirs with <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 8:17) so we call them Our Children.

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come into the heart of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21). Your will be done in the life of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). As an ambassador of *Christ* (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in *Christ* (John 15:4-5) and one with Him (John 6:56, John 15:5), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), in His Son Jesus Christ (1 John 5:20), we give thanks to the Lord (1 Thess. 5:18), the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21), their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire family (Acts 13:26), and their nation (Math. 21:43) for the saints (Eph. 6:18), for the leaders that God has raised up on their behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23) so that *Christ* might make known to them the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21) their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), for their entire family (Acts 13:26), their friends, neighbors and countrymen (1 Tim. 2:1-2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43); for all the brethren (Eph. 6:18), all those called by the name of the Lord (Deut. 28:10); for the leaders of their nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the wellbeing of God's people; and all the people of their nation, and all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2), so that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) may lead a quiet and peaceable life in

all godliness and reverence (1 Tim. 2:1-2). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2)! We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God (Rom. 5:2)! It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) (James 5:16) their family (Acts 13:26) and their nation (Math. 21:43), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that *Christ*, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) are spirit and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 cor. 15:57)!

We don't come to the Father in Heaven (Math. 6:9) based on our own worthiness (Is. 64:6), or on the worthiness (Is. 64:6) of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26). Abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), we come to God's throne of grace (Heb. 4:16) on the merits of His Son (Eph. 4:13), *Jesus Christ of Nazareth* (Acts 3:6), and the blood that He shed (Rev. 7:14). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), who upholds all things by the word of His power (Heb. 1:3), as a fellow worker in *Christ Jesus* (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), on every side (Job 1:10), all of their family (Acts 13:26), all of their blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all their natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of their spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43).

Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall grow in the grace and knowledge of our <u>Lord and Savior</u> <u>Jesus Christ</u>. To Him be the glory both now and forever (2 Peter 3:18). In the name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23), by the precious blood of <u>Christ</u>, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the Father in heaven bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and keep them (Num. 6:24). The <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> be with their spirit. Grace be with Our Children (Is. 61:9) (2 Tim. 4:22) and their people (Ps. 148:14). Glory to God in the highest! O Lord God of hosts, hear our prayer; give ear, O God of Jacob! Selah (Ps. 84:8)!

Let the name of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> be magnified forever (2 Sam. 7:26)! The God of gods and Lord of lords, the great God, mighty and awesome (Deut. 10:17), who remembers Our Children (Is. 61:9) in their lowly state, for His mercy endures forever (Ps. 136:23)!

As the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart, in the name of Jesus (John 16:23), a Minister of the sanctuary and the true tabernacle which the Lord erected (Heb. 8:1), let the Word of God pierce their heart and live on eternally in Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) throughout all generations, it shall not return to God void, but it shall accomplish what He pleases, and it shall prosper in the thing for which He sent it. Your kingdom come (Math. 6:10) Lord Jehovah, our everlasting strength, (Is. 26:4)! Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven (Math. 6:10). Do not hide Your face from Your servants: Hear us speedily (Ps. 69:17)! In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Beloved Children (Is. 61:9) may prosper in all things and be in health, just as their soul prospers (3 John 1:2). For Our Children (ls. 61:9) shall go out with joy, and be led out with peace; the mountains and the hills shall break forth into singing before them, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands (ls. 55:11-12). For the word of their God stands forever (ls. 40:8). The Word is very near Our Children (Is. 61:9), even in their mouth and in their heart, that they may do it (Deut. 30:14-16, Rom. 10:8). May the Lord, God Almighty, establish His covenant with Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) after them in their generations, for an everlasting covenant (John 8:31), the word which they commanded, for a thousand generations (1 Chr. 16:15), to be God to them and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) after them (Gen. 17:7). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their offspring abide in His word (John 8:31-32), for the counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations (Ps. 33:11). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask, in the name of Christ Jesus (John 16:23), their redeemer (Gal. 4:5), that His Spirit who is upon Our Children (Is. 61:9), and His words which He puts in their mouth, shall not depart from their mouth, nor from the mouth of their descendants, nor from the mouth of their descendants' descendants from this time forevermore (Is. 59:21). Let God Almighty establish His word (1 Sam. 1:23) in Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) with widespread revelation (1 Sam. 3:1). May it please God to bless their house so that it may continue forever before Him (2 Sam. 7:29), that their seed shall endure forever, as the sun before God. It shall be established forever like the moon, even like the faithful witness in the sky (Ps. 89:36-37). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) and

their people (Ps. 148:14) be a companion of all those who (Ps. 119:63) fear the Lord. May Our Children (Is. 61:9) have a poor and contrite spirit, and tremble at His word (Is. 66:2), for the mercy of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting on those who fear Him, and His righteousness to children's children, too such as keep His covenant, and to those who remember His commandments to do them. The Lord has established His throne in heaven, and His kingdom rules over all! Bless the Lord, you His angels, who excel in strength, who do His word, heeding the voice of His word! Bless the Lord, all you His hosts, you Ministers of His, who do His pleasure! Bless the Lord, all His works, in all places of His dominion! Bless the Lord, O our soul (Ps. 103:17-22)!

In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16), in the holy name of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 16:23), who is the way, the truth, and the life, that Our Children (ls. 61:9) will be blessed, be undefiled in the way, and walk in the Word of God (Ps. 119:1); that Our Children (Is. 61:9) will seek God with their whole heart; that they will be near to the Lord their God day and night (1 Kin. 8:59) and keep His testimonies (Ps. 119:2), loving them exceedingly (Ps. 119:167) and keep His precepts diligently (Ps. 119:4); that the God of truth (John 14:6) may direct their ways to keep His statues (Ps. 119:5), to fear His commandments (Prov.13:13) and fashion their hearts individually (Ps. 33:15); that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will take heed according to His Word, as a light that shines in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in their hearts (2 Pet. 1:19) and cleanse their way (Ps. 119:9). For they who heeds the word wisely will find good, and whoever trusts in the Lord, happy are they (Prov. 16:20). May the Holy Spirit (John 14:26) teach Our Children (Is. 61:9) His statues (Ps. 119:12). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) rejoice in the way of God's testimonies (Ps. 119:14), meditate on His precepts, contemplate His ways (Ps. 119:15) and not forget His Word (Ps. 119:16). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the creator of all things (Rom 1:25) will not hide His commandments from Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Ps. 119:19) but that their soul shall break with longing for His judgments at all times (Ps. 119:20). The entrance of God's word gives light (Ps. 119:130) and in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that their soul will keep His testimonies (Ps. 119:129). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) will rebuke the proud the cursed, who stray from His commandments (Ps. 119:21) and God Almighty will remove from them reproach and contempt (Ps. 119:22). May God revive Our Children (Is. 61:9) in His way (Ps. 119:37) and in His righteousness (Ps. 119:40), according to His loving kindness (Ps. 119:88, 149,159), His mercies (Ps. 119: 41), His justice (Ps. 119:149), His judgments (Ps. 119:156), and His Word (Ps. 119:27, 107,154). May

the Almighty God make Our Children (ls. 61:9) understand the way of His precepts (Ps. 119:27) and strengthen them according to His word (Ps. 119:28). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the God of Truth (John 14:6) shall remove from Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) the way of lying (Ps. 119:29) and that they will choose the way of truth (Ps. 119:30), hate every false way (Ps. 119:104), hate the double minded (Ps. 119:113), and hate and abhor lying (Ps. 119:163). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the God of power (Matt. 26:64), shall enlarge their heart (Ps. 119:32) and incline their heart (Ps. 119:36) to Himself, to be loyal to the Lord their God (1 Kin. 8;61), to perform His statues to walk in all His ways, and to keep His commandments and His statutes and His judgments (1 Kin. 8:58). May the Lord turn away their eyes from worthless things (Ps. 119:37), establish His word to Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Ps. 119:38) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21) and revive them in His righteousness (Ps. 119:40). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) will entreat God's favor with their whole heart that He will be merciful to them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) according to His word (Ps. 119:58). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that God will deal well with Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) according to His word (Ps. 119:65), that He will teach them good judgment and knowledge (Ps. 119:66), that He will give them understanding (Ps. 119:73), that they are good and do good (Ps. 119:68). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that God's merciful kindness be for their comfort, according to His word. Let His tender mercies come to Our Children (Is. 61:9) that they may live and delight (Ps. 119:76-77) and hope in His word (Ps. 119:74). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the God of love (John 15:10), revive Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) according to His loving kindness, so that they will keep the testimonies of His mouth. Forever, O Lord, Your word is settled in heaven. Your faithfulness endures to all generations. You established the earth, and it abides (Ps. 119:88-90). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will have more understanding than all their teachers (Ps. 119:99), even more than the ancients (Ps. 119:100). Let them share in all good things with them who teaches them (Gal. 6:6). May God give Our Children (Is. 61:9) wisdom, which is the fountain of life, to turn them away from the snares of death (Prov. 13:14). May God give Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) understanding (Prov. 13:15), that they act with knowledge (Prov. 13:16) so that they will be rewarded (Prov. 13:13), and gain favor (Prov. 13:15). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) will restrain their feet from every evil way (Ps. 119:101), that they will hate every false way (Ps. 119:104), that they

will not depart from God's judgments, for He, Himself, has taught them (Ps. 119:102). May the word of God be sweet to their taste, sweeter than honey to their mouth (Ps. 119:103)! Let the word of God be a lamp to their feet and a light to their path (Ps. 119:105). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) praise the name of the Lord, for His loving kindness and His truth; for God has magnified His word above all His name (Ps. 138:2). How great are His signs, and how mighty His wonders! His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and His dominion is from generation to generation (Dan. 4:3)!

In the name of **Jesus** (John 16:23), who is full of grace and truth (John 1:14), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their children (Ps 103:17) will not stray from God's precepts. May they and their family take His testimonies as a heritage forever and their heart rejoice in His testimonies (Ps. 119:110-111). The entirety of God's word is truth, and every one of His righteous judgments endure forever (Ps. 119:160). As for God, His way is perfect; the word of the Lord is proven; there has not failed one word of all His good promise (1 Kin. 8:56). His word is very pure (Ps. 119:140) and endures forever (1 Peter 1:25). He is a shield to all who trust in Him. For who is God, except the Lord? And who is a rock, except their God? God is their strength and power, and He makes their way perfect (2 Sam. 22:31-33). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21) rejoice at the word of God as one who finds great treasure (Ps. 119:162), love the Word of God and have great peace and not stumble (Psm119:165). May the God of all authority (Rom. 13:1) direct their steps by His word, and let no iniquity have dominion over Our Children (ls. 61:9) and may **Jesus** redeem them from the oppression of man (Ps. 119:134) and from the snare of the wicked (Ps. 119:110), nor let the proud oppress them (Ps. 119:122) but plead their cause (Ps. 119:154) before their God and Father (Phil. 4:20). Great are Your tender mercies, O Lord (Ps. 119:156)! May the great physician (Luke 4:23), send His word and heal Our Children (Is. 61:9), and deliver them from their destruction's. Oh, that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will give thanks to the Lord for His goodness, and for His wonderful works to them! May they sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare His works with rejoicing (Ps. 107:20-22)! We ask (John 11:22, Mark 11:23), in the name of **Jesus** (John 16:23), whom God set forth, to be a propitiation by His blood, through faith (Rom. 3:25), that God will accept the freewill offerings of their mouth and teach them His judgments (Ps. 119:108). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) to our Father in Heaven (Math. 6:9, John 14:16), in the name of His only begotten son (John 3:18), Jesus Christ (John 16:23), that they will give Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their children (Ps 103:17) another Helper, that they may abide

with them forever - The Spirit of Truth (John 14:16-17), to guide them into all truth (John 16:13). Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, honor, and glory, and blessing (Rev 5:12)!

In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16), in the name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23), who has authority over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to Our Children (Is. 61:9) (John 17:2) and their people (Ps. 148:14), that their heart be blameless (Ps. 119:80), that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) walk at liberty (Ps. 119:45), trust in the word of God (Ps. 119:42), and may the God of Power (Matt. 26:64), make them bold with strength in their soul (Ps. 138:3), that they not be ashamed (Ps. 119:46) but with all boldness Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) speak the testimonies and the Word of God (Acts 4:29), with authority and power (Luke 4:36), giving themselves continually to prayer and to the ministry of the word (Acts 6:4), the Lord working with them and confirming (Mark 16:20) and bearing witness to the word of His grace, granting signs and wonders to be done by their hands (Acts 14:3). For the word of the Lord is right, and all His work is done in truth. He loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of the goodness of the Lord. By the word of the Lord the heavens were made. And all the host of them by the breath of His mouth (Ps. 33:4-6).

In the name of **Jesus** (John 16:23), through whom grace and truth came (John 1:17), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that the word of God will come to their house (1 Thess. 1:5), give Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their children (Ps 103:17) everlasting life (Ps. 119:50) that they shall not come into judgment, but pass from death into life (John 5:24), that they will never see (John 8:51) nor taste death (John 8:52), and may the God of grace (Eph. 2:7, Zech. 12:10), comfort Our Children (Is. 61:9) in their afflictions (Ps. 119:50). Though they walk in the midst of trouble, God will revive Our Children (Is. 61:9); He will stretch out His hand against the wrath of their enemies, and His right hand will save them. The Lord will perfect that which concerns Our Children (Is. 61:9); His mercy endures forever; He will not forsake them (Heb.13:5), for they are the works of His hands (Ps. 138:7-8). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will hear the word of the Lord (Jer. 7:2) and amend their ways and their doings (Jer. 7:3). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the Lord God will remove falsehood and lies far from Our Children (Is. 61:9). give them neither poverty nor riches, but feed them with the food He prescribes for them (Prov. 30:8), for they shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God (Matt. 4:4). Glory in His holy name; let the hearts of those rejoice who seek the Lord! Seek the Lord and His strength; seek His face evermore! He is the Lord our

God; His judgments are in all the earth! Remember His covenant always, the word which He commanded, for a thousand generations (1 Chr. 16:10-15).

In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we commend Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) up and give them an inheritance among all those who are sanctified (Acts 20:32). As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), we ask (John 11:22, Mark 11:23), in the name of Jesus (John 16:23), the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world (John 1:29), that God will sanctify Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their children (Ps 103:17) by His word. God's word is truth (John 17:17). Let the word of *Christ* dwell in Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another (Col. 3:16-17) in truth (Matt. 22:16) and may Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) increase in faith by hearing, and hearing by the word of God (Rom. 10:17). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will receive the word of God, that they will welcome it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which also effectively works in Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) who believe (1 Thess. 2:13). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) trust in God, after they hear the word of truth, the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God (Eph. 6:17), the gospel of their salvation: in whom also, having believed, Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their children (Ps 103:17) are sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise (Eph. 1:13), who is the guarantee of their inheritance (Eph. 1:14). May the Holy Spirit fall upon Our Children (Is. 61:9) and all their people (Ps. 148:14) who hear the word (Acts 10:44). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that none among them will hear the word of the kingdom and not understand it (Matt. 13:19), nor allow the cares of this world and deceitfulness of riches choke the word (Matt. 13:22), nor allow tribulation or persecution make them stumble (Matt. 13:21) but rather that all of them shall receive the seed on the good ground, understand and bear fruit and produce: some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty (Matt. 23:23). Sing to Him a new song; play skillfully with a shout of joy! For the word of the Lord is right, and all His work is done in truth! He loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of the goodness of the Lord! By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth. He gathers the waters of the sea together as a heap; He lays up the deep in storehouse. Let all the earth fear the Lord; let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him! For He spoke, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast!

In the name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23), by the precious blood of <u>Christ</u>, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), may Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), renounce the hidden things of shame, not walking in craftiness nor handling the word of God deceitfully, but by manifestation of the truth commending themselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God (2 Cor. 4:2). By the word of God's lips, may Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) keep themselves from the paths of the destroyer. Uphold the steps of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) in Your paths, O Father, that their footsteps may not slip (Ps. 17:5). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) will lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness (James 1:21) all malice, all guile, hypocrisy, envy, and all evil speaking, as newborn babes, desiring the pure milk of the word, they may grow thereby, if indeed they have tasted that the Lord is gracious (1 Pet. 2:1-3), and receive with meekness the implanted word (James 1:21), the word of truth (James 1:18), which is able to save their soul (James 1:21) and make them free (John 8:32). But may Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving themselves (James 1:21-22). Let their hearts be steadfast; and may Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) awaken the dawn with their praise. For the Lord's mercy reaches unto the heavens, and His truth unto the clouds. Be exalted, O God, above the heavens; let Your glory be above all the earth (Ps. 57:7-11).

In the name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23), declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness (Rom. 1:3), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their children (Ps 103:17) will continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with thanksgiving (Col. 4:2-3); for the gospel did not come to them in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Spirit and in much assurance, (1 Thess. 1:5) so whatever they do in word or deed, in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) do all in the name of the <u>Lord Jesus</u>, giving thanks to God the Father through Him (Matt. 4:4) and do all things without murmuring and disputing (Phil. 2:14), becoming an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity (1 Tim. 4:12) that they may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom they shine as lights in the world, holding fast the word of life, being poured out as a drink offering on the sacrifice and service of their faith (Phil. 2:14-17). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will purify their souls in obeying the

truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, that they will love one another fervently with a pure heart (1 Pet. 1:22), not loving in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth (1 John 3:18), having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever (1 Pet. 1:22-23). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) will keep His word, and the love of God be perfected in them (1 John 2:5) and their people (Ps. 148:14). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their children (Ps 103:17) will love *Jesus*, keep His word, and the Father in heaven and the Son of God, *Jesus Christ*, will come to them and their children (Ps 103:17) and make His home with them (John 14:23). Oh, let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their children (Ps 103:17) bless our God! And make the voice of His praise to be heard, who keeps their soul among the living, and does not allow their feet to be moved. For You, O God, have proved; You have refined Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) as silver is refined. Thou Our Children (Is. 61:9) may go through fire and through water; God, our Faithful God, will bring Our Children (Is. 61:9) out to rich fulfillment (Ps. 66:8-12).

Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and our God and Father, who has loved Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and given them everlasting consolation and good hope by grace, comfort their hearts and establish Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) in every good word and work (2 Thess. 2:16-17). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16), in the name of Jesus (John 16:23), God's Holy Servant (Acts 4:27), that Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their children (Ps 103:17) will be diligent to present themselves approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth (2 Tim 2:15). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that God would open to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) a door for the word, to speak the mystery of *Christ*, (Col. 4:2-3), that the word of the Lord may have free course and be glorified (2 Thess. 3:1-3), that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) be ready to preach the word in season and out of season (2 Tim 4:2). May the Lord God (Gen. 2:4, Luke 1:32) give Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) the tongue of the learned, that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and theirs should know how to speak a word in season to them who is weary (ls. 50:4) for the Lord God has committed to them the word of reconciliation (2 Cor. 5:19). By the word of His power (Heb. 1:3) may Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men, for not all have faith. But the Lord is faithful, who will establish Our Children (Is. 61:9), uphold their steps in His path (Ps. 17:5)

and guard them from the evil one (2 Thess. 3:1-3). A word spoken in season, how good it is (Prov. 15:23)! As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23) we ask, in the name of Jesus (John 16:23), the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God (Rev. 3:14), that the Spirit of the Lord will speak by Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14), and His word will be on their tongues (2 Sam. 23:2), that they are able to convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teach (2 Tim. 4:2), in truth (1 Kin. 17:24), not adding to or taking from God's word (Deut. 4:2), but holding fast the faithful word as they have been taught by the Holy Spirit (John 14:26), that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) may be able, by sound doctrine, both to exhort and convict those who contradict (Titus 1:9), that the word of God may profit those who hear it and be mixed with faith (Heb. 4:2), so that the word of the Lord might grow mightily and prevail in their hearts (Acts 20:32). Through Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) may the Word of life (1 John 1:1) grow and be multiplied (Acts 12:24). May God the Most-High know their works and set before Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) an open door, that no one can shut; because they have a little strength, and have kept His word, and have not denied His name (Rev. 3:8). May God Most-High be over their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and may all of their people (Ps. 148:14) be ruled according to His word (Gen. 41:40). And now in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16), O God of all authority, let Your word come true which You have spoken through Your servant (1 Kin. 8:26). Let our cry come before You, O Lord (Ps. 119:169), let our supplication come before You (Ps. 119: 170), our lips shall utter praise (Ps. 119:171), our tongue shall speak of Your word (Ps. 119:17), let Your hand become help for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21)! Your covenant You will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of Your lips (Ps. 89:34), O God of Mercy! May all these things come to pass by the word of the Lord, and not one word will fail of any of the good things which the Lord has spoken to Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Joshua 23:14) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21)! It is written: "I have manifested Your name to the men whom You have given Me

out of the world. They were Yours, You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your word" (John 17:6) says our *Lord Jesus Christ*. In *Jesus*' name (John 16:23), a High Priest, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and has become higher than the heavens (Heb. 7:26), now, Lord, grant to Your servants, Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), that with all boldness Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) may speak Your word, by stretching out Your

hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of **Your Holy Servant Jesus** (Acts 4:29-30).

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), their nation (Math. 21:43) and all of their people (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify their time (ls. 9:7, ls. 59:21) so that they will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify their space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in them (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify them completely; and may their whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our **Lord** Jesus Christ (1 Thess. 5:23). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), Jesus Christ, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed (Dan. 7:14). The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein (Ps. 24:1). The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it (Ps. 10:11). For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him (Col. 1:16). You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created (Rev. 4:11)! As a fellow worker in *Christ* (Rom. 16:3), a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (ls. 61:2)! As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that *Christ* might make known to Our Children (Is. 61:9) their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), and their nation (Math. 21:43) the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23, Eph. 1:18), we claim Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), their family (Acts 13:26), their children and their children's children (Prov. 11:21) as our joint inheritance (Eph. 1:18) with our Lord Jesus Christ (Gal. 4:7). By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most-High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom (Dan. 7:22). Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and **Christ** will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin! And do this, knowing

the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now, our salvation is near (Rom. 13:11)! Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it (Is. 34:1)! In *Christ* (John 16:23) we pray that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) in one accord (Acts 1:14) will pray for the peace of Jerusalem for it is written: "May they prosper who love you" (Ps. 122:6). The LORD bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) out of Zion, and may they see the good of Jerusalem all the days of their life (Ps. 128:5). As kings and priests of the God and Father of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (Rev. 1:6), we decree Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) shall stand (2 Chr. 11:13) with Israel against the ungodly nations (Ezek. 13:5) for their shield *belongs* to the LORD, and their king to the Holy One of Israel (Psalm 89:18).

In the name of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), who upholds all things by the word of His power (Heb. 1:3), we ask and receive all these things (Math. 7:7). Concerning this prayer of faith (James 5:15) that we pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with them (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). Being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), we pray (James 5:16) with confidence (1 John 5:14) for God's thoughts towards Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) are thoughts of peace, to give them a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11). As a chosen vessel of **Jesus Christ**, to bear His name (Acts 9;15), we continue petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to them (Luke 11:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment--This honor has all His saints. Praise the LORD (Ps. 149:9)! It is written: "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." says the Lord God Almighty Psalms 89:34. God is watching over His word to perform it Jerimiah 1:12 and it shall not return to Him void; but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it **Isaiah 55:11**. The Lord gives voice before His army, for His camp is very great; for strong is the One who executes His word **Joel 2:11!** The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations **Psalms 33:1.** It shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, as the Lord has said, among the remnant whom the Lord calls **Joel 2:32**. "For My name shall be great among the nations," says the Lord of hosts Malachi 1:11. We ask our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) in the name of our

Lord Jesus Christ (John 16:23), who gave Himself for us, that He might purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works (Titus 2:14), believing that Our Children (Is. 61:9), their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) receive all we ask for them (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14). You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of Your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! In **Jesus**' name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! We will worship toward Your holy temple, and praise Your name for Your loving-kindness and Your truth; for You, O Lord, have magnified Your word above all Your name (Ps, 138:2)! We will rejoice in our salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners! May the Lord fulfill all our petitions (Ps. 20:5)! By the blood of the everlasting covenant (Heb. 13:20), in the awesome name (Deut. 28:58) of **Jesus** Christ (Rom. 14:11), the mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24), we activate (Math 16:19) these Prophetic Scriptures (Rom. 16:25-27) in the lives of Our Children (ls. 61:9). These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God: Amen! (Rev. 3:14).). For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God! (2 Cor. 1:20)!
