always, the word which He commanded, for a thousand generations (1 chr. 16:10-15). Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9). In the name of *Jesus Christ*, at the name of *Jesus* every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and those on earth, and of those under the earth, and every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God (Phil 2:8); therefore in *Jesus'* name we lift up you and your entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to the Father (Math. 6:9), all of your family (Acts 13:26), all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 chr. 18:1), all your natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of your spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2). In the mighty and awesome name of *Jesus Christ*, His name be magnified forever (2 Sam. 7:26), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for you, your posterity (Prov. 11:21) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). The words that *Christ*, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to you and your family (Acts 13:26) are spirit, and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Cor. 15:57)!

In the name of *Jesus Christ* of Nazareth (John 16:23), by the precious blood of *Christ*, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the Father in heaven put His name on you and bless you and your house (Num. 6:27). The blessing of the Lord be upon you; we bless you in the name of the Lord (Ps. 129:8)! Glory to God the Father (Luke 2:14)! In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), all flesh shall bless His holy name forever and ever (Ps. 145:21), abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), Hear, O Lord, when we cry with our voice! Have mercy also upon us and answer us (Ps. 27:7)! In the name of *Jesus* (John 16:23), who is the Desire of all Nations (Hag. 2:7), may the God who restores (Ps. 60:1) make you and your house new (Rev. 21:47) and release the past for the former things have passed away (Rev.21:47), so that you and your people will not live in it, but forget those things which are behind and reach forward to those things which are ahead (Phil. 3:13-14); that you no longer shall live the rest of your time in the flesh for the lusts of men, but for the will of God (1 Pet. 4:2), drinking freely from the fountain of

the water of life, and you and yours shall inherit all things (Rev. 21:47). In the name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23), he is <u>Christ</u>, the chosen of God (Luke 23:35), in His name we ask the Father of mercy to bind up your wounds (Ps. 147:3) and help you and yours to forgive, so that you may be forgiven (Luke 6:37). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that the God of your salvation will restore your soul (Ps. 23:3), renew your spirit (2 Cor. 4:16), and that you be renewed in the spirit of your mind (Eph. 4:22-24), receiving a new heart and a new spirit (Ezek. 18:31). Oh, sing to the Lord a new song! Sing to the Lord, all the earth! Sing to the Lord, bless His name; proclaim the good news of His salvation from day to day! Declare His glory among your people, His wonders among all peoples (Ps. 96:1-3)!

In the name of Jesus (John 16:23), the great High Priest (Heb. 10:21), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your people will renounce any gifts or gain (Prov. 1:19, Is. 33;15, Ezek. 22:27, Ezek. 33:31) or authority (Luke 4:6) that came from the wicked one (1 John 4:19), renounce the ungodly part of your past and break out of and cast out the spiritual commitments, rash vows (Num. 30:13), unholy alliances, and unholy covenants (Ex. 23:32) that put you or your house in bondage (Ex. 23:33, Gal. 2:4). Let no one defraud you of your reward, guard against taking delight in false humility and worship of angels (Col. 2:18). By the precious blood of *Christ*, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), by the blood of the new covenant (Matt. 26:28) may Jesus make void every vow and every binding oath you or your people have made to afflict your souls (Num. 30:13) and command every unclean spirit to come out of you and your house (Mark 5:8). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your people will stand fast in the liberty by which *Christ* has set you free and not become entangled again in a yoke of bondage (Gal. 5:1). The whole world lies under the sway of the wicked one (1John 5:19) so in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house renounce any authority or unclean spirits or different spirits (2 Cor. 11:4), sorceries of any kind, that have been guiding you (Rev. 9:21). Let you and your people be born of God, do not sin and keep yourselves in the presence of God so the wicked one does not touch you (1 John 5:18). Away with you Satan! For it is written "You shall worship the Lord your God and Him only you shall serve" (Matt. 4:10). May you, your house and all of your descendants' summit yourselves completely to the authority of *Jesus Christ*, our King and our Savior. In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you right now will confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead (Rom. 10:9). Let you hold fast the confession of your hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful (Heb. 10:23). Repent and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:38). May you and your people ask for and receive the gift of Holy Spirit (Luke 11:13) into your hearts and receive the righteousness of God (2 Cor. 5:21), a free gift (Rom. 5:15), an indescribable gift (2 Cor. 9:15). For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for you so you could become the righteousness of God (2 Cor. 5:21). The grace of Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you and your house (2 Cor. 13:14). Let your hearts rejoice, and your tongues be glad; more over let your flesh rest in hope, because God will not leave your soul to Hades, nor will he allow you to see corruption (Acts 2:26:27). Only with your eyes shall you look and see the reward of the wicked (Ps. 91:8). God will make known to you and your people the ways of life and make you full of joy in His presence (Acts 2:28). Then you shall know that God is in the midst of your house. For He is the Lord our God and there is no other (Joel 2:27). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and all of your people will have an ear to hear what the Holy Spirit says, that you will overcome and receive the hidden manna to eat, and a white stone, and on the stone a new name (Rev. 2:17). Truly, the Lord Jesus Christ will write the name of His God and the Name of the city of His God, the New Jerusalem, and His new name on you and your people (Rev. 3:12), and the angel of God shall seal you and your people, the servants of God, on your foreheads (Rev. 7:3). You are worthy, Oh Jesus, to take the scroll, and to open its seals: for You were slain, and have redeemed us to God by Your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation, and have made us kings and priests to our God; and we shall reign on the earth (Rev. 5:9-10). Worthy is the Lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing (Rev. 5:12)!

You and your people have spent enough of your past lifetime in doing the will of Satan when you walked in licentiousness, lusts, drunkenness, revelries, drinking parties, and abominable idolatries (1 Pet. 4:3). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray, in the name of *Jesus* (John 16:23), the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world (John 1:29), that you and your people shall walk in the newness of life (Rom. 6:4), for God shall create in you and yours a clean heart and a pure heart and renew a steadfast spirit within you (Ps. 51:10). May the Lord give you and your people a heart to know the Lord, and you shall return to God with your whole heart (Jer. 24:7). May the God of all truth (Ps. 31:4) put His law in your minds, and write it on your hearts, and may all of your people know God, from the least of you to the greatest of you (Jer. 31:34). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we make request for you that the Lord take the stony heart out of your flesh and give you a new heart of flesh (Ezek. 11:19). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your people will walk in His statutes and keep His judgments and do them (Ezek. 11:20), and out of your heart shall flow rivers of living water (John 7:38). May God, the Judge of all (Heb. 12:23),

not remember the sins of your youth nor your transgression; according to His mercy, for His goodness' sake. As far as the east is from the west, so far has God removed your transgressions from you (Ps. 102:12). Darkness is passing away, and the true light is shining on you and your house (1 John 2:8). Therefore, beloved, be diligent to be found by Him in peace, without spot and blameless (2 Pet. 3:14), for you and your house are called to receive the promise of the eternal inheritance (Heb. 9:15). You and your house shall be a crown of glory in the hand of the Lord, and a royal diadem in the hand of your God. You shall no longer be termed Forsaken, nor shall your land any more be termed Desolate (Is. 62:3-4). Honor and majesty are before the Lord our God; strength and beauty are in His sanctuary! Give to the Lord, O kindred of the peoples, give to the Lord glory and strength! Give to the Lord the glory due His name; bring an offering of love (Eph. 5:2) and come into His courts! Oh, worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness! Tremble before Him, all the earth (Ps. 96:6-9)!

Whatever God does, it shall be forever. Nothing can be added to it, and nothing taken from it. God does it, that you and your house shall fear before Him (Eccl. 3:14). Although God requires an account of what is past (Eccl. 3:15), through the Lord's mercies you and your people are not consumed, because His compassion's fail not. They are new every morning, great is His faithfulness (Lam. 3:22-23). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray, in the name of Jesus (John 16:23), who is the way, the truth, and the life (John 14:6), that you and your people will cast away from you all the transgressions which you have committed, and get yourselves a new heart and a new spirit (Ezek 18:31). Let you and your people be in *Christ*, that you and yours are a new creation; old things have passed away; behold all things have become new for now all things concerning you are of God, who has reconciled you and your house to Himself through Jesus Christ (2 Cor. 5:17-18), through the cross (Eph. 2:16). May you and your people put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and that you put on the new man, which was created according to God, in righteousness and true holiness. Let all lying (Eph. 4:25), stealing (Eph. 4;28), bitterness, wrath, anger, blasphemy (Col. 3:8), filthy language (Col. 3:8) clamor and evil speaking be put away from you and your house with all malice (Eph. 4:31). May you and your people put off the old man with his deeds and put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created you (Col. 3:10). Having died with Christ from the basic principles of the world, may you grow with the increase which is from God (Col. 2:19). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that as the elect of God, holy and beloved, you put on tender mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering; bearing with one

another, and forgiving one another (Col. 3:12-13), putting on love, which is the bond of perfection (Col. 3:14). And that you let the peace of God rule in your hearts and let the word of <u>Christ</u> dwell in you richly in all wisdom, being thankful always (Col. 3:15). And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the <u>Lord Jesus</u>, giving thanks to God the Father through Him (Col. 3:17). Peace and mercy be upon you and your house (Gal. 6:16), for God, Himself, is your peace (Eph. 2:16). For the word of the Lord is right, and all His work is done in truth. He loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of the goodness of the Lord (Ps. 33:4-5). Let all the earth fear the Lord, let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him (Ps. 33:8).

Out of heaven may God let you hear His voice, that He might instruct you (Deut. 4:36) with His presence and His mighty power (Deut. 4:37). Therefore, know this day, and consider it in your heart, that the Lord Himself is God in heaven above and on the earth beneath; there is no other (Deut. 4:39). Behold, the former things have come to pass, and new things He declares to you and your house (Is. 42:9). Do not remember the former things, nor consider the things of old for God will do a new thing, it shall spring forth upon you and your house (Is. 42:18-109). He will make you hear new things from this time, even hidden things (Is. 48:60). He will give drink to you and your family, His people, His chosen (Is. 43:20). Behold, He will make you and your house into a new threshing sledge with sharp teeth; you shall thresh the mountains and beat them small and make the hills like chaff. You shall winnow them, the wind shall carry them away, and the whirlwind shall scatter them; you shall rejoice in the Lord, and glory in the Holy One of Israel (Is. 41:15-16)!

In the name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23), the ruler over the kings of the earth (Rev. 1:5-6), may God restore to you and your house the years that the swarming locust has eaten, the crawling locust, the consuming locust, and the chewing locust, the great army which was sent among you (Joel 2:25). Let it come to pass that God the Most-High will pour out His Spirit on all your flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions; and also on His menservants and on His maidservants among you, He will pour out His Spirit (Joel 2:28-29). And this in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray, that you and your descendants will abound still more and more in love, in knowledge, and all discernment, that you may approve the things that are excellent, that you may be sincere and without offense until the day of <u>Christ</u>, being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by <u>Jesus Christ</u>, to the praise and glory of God (Phil. 1:9-11). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you shall not labor in vain, nor bring forth children for trouble; for you shall be the descendants of the blessed of the Lord, and your offspring with you (is. 65:23). For as the new

heavens and the new earth which God will make shall remain before Him, so shall your descendants and your name remain (Is. 66:22). For God has made a new covenant with you and your people (Jer. 31:31). Your sufficiency is from God, who also made you sufficient as ministers of the new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit (2 Cor. 5-6). May you and your house be known as the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes, redeemed from among men, being the first fruits to God and to the Lamb (Rev. 14:4), and these signs will follow you and your house because you believe: In the name of Jesus (John 16:23), the tried stone (Is. 28:16), you will cast out demons, you will speak with new tongues, you will take up serpents; and if you drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt you; you will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover (Mark 16:17-18). May you be serious and watchful in your prayers. And above all things have fervent love for one another, being hospitable to one another without grumbling, for love will cover a multitude of sins. As each one has received a gift, may you minister to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God so that in all things God may be glorified through *Jesus Christ*, to whom belong the glory and the dominion forever and ever (1 Pet. 4:7-11). The Lord is your portion so hope in Him! The Lord is good to those who wait for Him, to the soul who seeks Him (Lam. 3:24-25). For of Him and through him and to Him are all things, to whom be glory forever (Rom. 11:36)

We pray to our Father in heaven, hallowed be His name, that His kingdom come to you and your house, His will be done in you and your people on earth as it is in heaven, that He give to you and your house this day your daily bread, and forgive you your debts, as you and your people forgive your debtors. That He not lead you into temptation, but deliver you and your house from the evil one. For His is the Kingdom and the Power and the Glory forever (Matt. 6:9-13)! In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray, in the name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23), God's Holy Servant (Acts 4:27, that you and your people will have boldness to enter the holiest by the blood of **Jesus**, by a new and living way which he consecrated for you, through the yeil, that is, His flesh (Heb. 10:19-20). May you draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having your hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and your bodies washed with pure water (Heb. 10:22). According to His promise (2 Pet. 3:13) may the God of the living (Mark 12:27) bestow on you and your people the privilege of coming to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, to an innumerable company of angels, to the general assembly and church of the firstborn who are registered in heaven, to God the Judge of all, to the spirits of just men made perfect, to **Jesus** the Mediator of the new covenant (Heb 12:24), the great High Priest over the house of God (Heb. 10:21), and to the blood of sprinkling that speaks better things than that of Abel. See that you do not refuse Him who speaks. For if they did not escape who refused Him who spoke on earth, much more shall you not escape if you turn away from Him who speaks from heaven, whose voice shakes not only the earth, but also heaven (Heb. 12:22-26). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your people receive the kingdom which cannot be shaken, and that God be at your right hand, so that you may not be shaken (Acts 2:25). May the everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the earth (ls. 40:28), give you grace, by which you may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear (Heb 12:28), with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth (1 Cor. 5:8). God, whose faithfulness reaches to the clouds (Ps. 36:5), will save you and your family, as the flock of His people. For you shall be like the jewels of a crown, lifted like a banner over His land for how great is His goodness. And how great His beauty (Zech. 16-17)! O sing to the Lord a new song! For He has done marvelous things in your house; His right hand and His holy arm have gained Him the victory. The Lord has made known to you and your people His salvation; His righteousness He has openly shown you. He has remembered His mercy and His faithfulness to your house. You and yours have seen the salvation of our God! Shout joyfully to the Lord! Break forth in song, rejoice and sing praises (Ps. 98:1-4)! Rejoice in our Maker (Ps. 149:2), be joyful in our King (Ps. 149:2), praise His name (Ps. 149:3)! He will beautify your house with salvation, be joyful in glory (Ps. 149:4-5)

Justified by faith (Rom. 5:1), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and all of your people (Ps. 148:14); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time (Is. 9:7, Is. 59:21) so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Judges 18:6, Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Thess. 5:23). In the name of *Jesus Christ*, the One God loved before the foundation of the world (John 17:24), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2)! In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment---This honor has all His saints. God said it. We believe it. It is settled forever. In *Jesus'* name (John 16:23) So be it (Mark 11:23)! You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! Amen!
