leaders of the world, from the least to the greatest, taken from the collection of Prayers for the Precious. As a fellow worker in Christ Jesus (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), we lift up the leaders of the world, your nation and your people to our Father in heaven. God is good. His mercy endures forever. God is good to all your people for Lord God is faithful, who will establish you and guard *you* from the evil one. Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come into their heart. Your will be done in their life on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), Jesus Christ, we give thanks to the Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for leaders that God has raised up and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall for you and your bloodline and all your house (Ezek. 13:5). In the name of Jesus Christ, we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). The words that Christ through us speak are spirit and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Cor. 15:57)!

In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, by the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), we call upon the Lord God of hosts (2 Sam. 5:10) to work deliverance in your life; may the arrow of the Lord's deliverance strike your heart (2 Kin. 13:17) and pull down the strongholds of your mind, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God (2 Cor. 10:4-5), likewise to all your people. That Your beloved may be delivered, Save, O Lord, with Your right hand, and hear us (Ps. 108:6). Now may the Lord of peace Himself give you and your bloodline peace always in every way. The Lord be with you and your bloodline (2 Thess. 3:16). The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you (2 Thess. 3:18). In the name of Jesus Christ, an everlasting light (Is. 60:19), the God of patience and comfort (Rom. 15:5) deliver you and your bloodline and your people from anything that binds you (Num. 30:3), lift the heavy burdens from your shoulders (Matt. 23:4), bring you and your people out of darkness and the shadow of death, and break your chains in

pieces (Ps. 107:14). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, the fountain of living waters (Jer. 2:13), may you and your bloodline and your people be set free for if **Jesus**, the Son, makes you free, you shall be free indeed (John 8:36). Let you and yours stand fast in the liberty by which **Christ** has made you free, and do not be entangled again with the yoke of bondage (Gal. 5:1). May the Lord have mercy on you and your house, for you and your people are weak (Ps. 6:2). Let the Lord who heals (Ex. 15:26), heal you and your bloodline and your house and all your land (Ps. 6:2). May you and your family fear the Lord your God and He will deliver you and yours from the hand of all your enemies (2 Kin. 17:39), on every side you shall dwell in safety (1 Sam. 12:11). He will lift you and your house above those who rise against you (2 Sam. 22:49); and deliver you and your people from the man who would destroy you and your house (2 Sam. 14:16), from the hand of the enemy, and from ambush along the road (Ezra. 8:31). For the Lord the God of recompense (Jer. 51:56) has seen your affliction, He has heard your cry, and He knows your sorrows (Ex. 3:7). Some trust in chariots, and some in horses; but we will remember the name of the Lord our God (Ps. 20:7). O Lord, our Lord, how excellent is Your name in all the earth, You who set Your glory above the heavens! (Ps. 8:1)

In the name of **Jesus Christ**, your high tower (Ps. 18:2), in **Christ** (John 15:4) we pray that El Roi, the God Who Sees (Gen. 16:13), will deliver you and your bloodline and yours away from the hands of the enemy and from those who persecute you (Ps. 31:15), bring you and your family from the hand of all who oppress you (Judg. 6:9), deliver you and your house from the hands of those who would plunder you (1 Sam. 14:48), deliver you and your people from those who hate you (2 Sam. 22:18), save you and yours from all those who persecute you (Ps. 7:1), bring you and your people out of the house of bondage (Judg. 6:8), and deliver you and your house from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God (Rom. 8:21). May the Lord turn away all ungodliness (Rom. 11:26) and deliver you and your house from the way of evil, from the man who speaks perverse things, from those who leave the paths of uprightness to walk in the ways of darkness (Prov. 2:12-13), and from the seductress who flatters with her words (Prov. 2:16). May the Most-High God (Ps. 78:35) deliver you and yours from being drawn toward death and hold you back from stumbling to the slaughter (Prov. 24:11). According to His abundant mercies (Neh. 9:27), may the Lord deliver you and your house from the hand of those who would curse you and turn their curse into blessing (Josh. 24:9-10). May the Father of Righteousness (Prov. 23:24) set you and your people free from their magic charms, tear off their veils and deliver you and your house out of their hand, that you and your bloodline shall no longer be as prey in their hand (Ezek. 13:20-21). We pray that the Just One (Acts 22:14) will deliver you and your house

from the hand of the wicked and redeem you and your people from the grip of the terrible (Jer. 15:21). They may fight against you and your bloodline, but they shall not prevail. The Lord is with you and your bloodline to deliver you (Jer. 1:19) on every side. You and your people shall dwell in safety (1 Sam. 12:11). May the Lord deliver you and yours out of all your troubles and give you and your family favor and wisdom (Acts 7:10). Your life shall be as a prize to you, because you have put your trust in the Lord (Jer. 39:18). May your life be precious in the sight of the Lord, and may He deliver you and your house out of all your tribulation (1 Sam. 26:24). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, your strength in whom you shall trust (Ps. 18:2), let your Redeemer (Gal. 4:5) deliver your soul from death (Ps. 33:19), deliver your feet from falling, that you and your bloodline and your people may walk before God in the light of the living (Ps. 56:13). For the Lord God is the tower of your salvation and He shows mercy to His anointed and to your descendants forevermore (2 Sam. 22:51). The Lord God will contend with those who contend with you and your house and He will save your children (Is. 49:25). The Lord God is your hiding place; He shall preserve you and your bloodline from trouble; He shall surround you with songs of deliverance (Ps. 32:7). Righteousness and justice are the foundation of His throne. A fire goes before Him, and burns up His enemies round about, His lightning's light the world (Ps. 97:2-3). For His is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. (Matt. 6:13)

In the name of **Jesus Christ**, King eternal, immortal, invisible (1 Tim. 1:17), in His name you and your bloodline have been redeemed; you have been called by name; and you belong to the Lord. When you and your people pass through the waters, God will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow you and your family. When you and your people walk through the fire, you shall not be burned, nor shall the flame scorch you. For He is the Lord, your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior (Is. 43:1-3), your Redeemer (Is. 43:14). The Lord will purify you and your house, and purge you and your people, that you and your bloodline may offer to the Lord an offering in righteousness (Mal. 3:3). Though you and your house may be hard pressed on every side, you will not be crushed; though you and your people may be perplexed, you will not despair; you and yours may be persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed always carrying about in the body the dying of the lord **Jesus**, that the life of **Jesus** also may be manifested in your body (2 Cor. 4:8-11). Though you and your bloodline and your people shall go through fire and through water, the Lord will bring you and your family out to rich fulfillment (Ps. 66:12). For the Lord has granted to you and your house that you, being delivered from the hand of your enemies, might serve Him without fear (Luke 1:74-75), in the newness of the Spirit (Rom. 7:6), in holiness and righteousness before Him

all the days of your life (Luke 1:74-75); that you and your children shall learn from **Jesus Christ** and you will find rest for your souls (Matt. 11:29). For **Jesus'** yoke is easy and His burden is light (Matt. 11:30). God has lovingly delivered your souls from the pit of corruption, for He has cast all your sins behind His back (Is. 38:17). You and your people have been upheld by Him from birth, He has carried you and your bloodline from the womb: even to your old age, even to gray hairs, He will carry you and your bloodline! (Is. 46:3-4). Where you and yours have sinned, may you return to God with all your heart and with all your soul and He will hear from heaven His dwelling place your prayer and your supplications, and maintain your cause, and forgive you and your bloodline and your house. (2 Chr. 6:38-39) God has delivered you and your bloodline and your family from the power of darkness and translated you and your people into the kingdom of the Son of His love (Col. 1:13). May the life of **Jesus** be manifested in your mortal flesh (2 Cor. 4:11). Grace to you and your bloodline and your house and peace from God the Father and our Lord **Jesus Christ**, who gave Himself for your sins that He might deliver you from this present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father, to whom be glory forever and ever. (Gal. 1:3-5)

In the name of **Jesus Christ**, called Faithful and True (Rev. 19:11), in **Christ** (John 15:4) we pray that wisdom will enter your hearts, and knowledge is pleasant to your souls, discretion will preserve you and your bloodline; understanding will keep you and your people, to deliver you from the way of evil (Prov. 2:10-12). According to the faith of God's elect (Titus 1:1), in **Christ** (John 15:4) we pray that you and your bloodline and your people will get wisdom and understanding, that you and yours will embrace the Wisdom of the Lord, and it shall exalt you and your house, promote you and your people, and bring honor to you and your family. The Lord's wisdom will place on your heads an ornament of grace, a crown of glory (Prov. 4:7-9). The Lord redeems your life from destruction, and crowns you with loving kindness and tender mercies (Ps. 103:1-4). Through knowledge, you and your bloodline and your family shall be delivered (Prov. 11:9). Your righteousness will deliver you from death (Prov. 10:2), and trouble (Prov. 11:8), and your posterity will be delivered (Prov. 11:21). In **Christ** (John 15:4) we pray that your thoughts are right and your mouth is upright (Prov. 12:5-6), that you and your family will walk wisely (Prov. 28:26), that you and your people are humble (2 Sam. 22:28), for the Lord is your lamp, and God lightens your darkness (2 Sam. 22:29). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, your buckler (Ps. 18:2), in **Christ** (John 15:4) we pray that you and your people are true witnesses who deliver souls (Prov. 14:25). In **Jesus'** name, as a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that **Christ** might make known to you and your bloodline the riches of His glory (Eph. 3:16), we pray that you and your people be not afraid of

their faces, for God is with you to deliver you. He has put His words in your mouth (Jer. 1:8-9); and has covered you and your house with the shadow of His hand (Is. 51:16). In **Christ** (John 15:4) we pray that you and your bloodline and your family will warn the wicked of his wickedness (Ezek. 3:19) and the righteous that they should not sin, and your souls shall be delivered (Ezek. 3:21). The Lord shall reward you and your bloodline and your house according to your righteousness; according to the cleanness of your hands, he will recompense you and your people (2 Sam. 22:21). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, the **Christ** of God (Luke 9:20), we ask that the Lord will stand with you and your bloodline and all your people and strengthen you, so that the message might be preached fully through you and your people (2 Tim. 4:17), that the word of the Lord may have free course and be glorified in you and your house, that you and your family be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men; for not all have faith. The Lord is faithful; he will establish you and your bloodline and your house and guard you and your family from the evil one (2 Thess. 3:1-3). The Lord will deliver you and your house from every evil work and preserve you and your people for His heavenly kingdom. To Him be glory forever and ever. (2 Tim. 4:18)

In the name of **Jesus Christ**, the breath of the Almighty (Job 33:4), let Jehovah-Raah, the Lord your Shepherd (Ps. 23:1), deliver your household (Ex. 12:27) and deliver you and your people unto a good and large land, a land flowing with milk and honey (Ex. 3:8). In **Christ** (John 15:4) we pray that Jehovah-Nissi, the Lord your banner (Ex. 17:15) and your victory (1 Cor. 15:57), may walk in the midst of your camp, to deliver you and yours and to give up your enemies before you and your bloodline; therefore. let your camp be holy, that God may not see an unclean thing in you and your house and turn away from you (Deut. 23:14). We ask, in the name of **Jesus Christ**, the righteous Branch (Jer. 23:5), that you and your bloodline and your family will possess your birthright (Gen. 43:33), your inheritance (Deut. 2:31), that little by little God will drive them out from before you and your people, until you are increased, and you inherit the land (Ex. 23:30). In **Christ** (John 15:4) we pray that you and your family will make no covenant with the unholy, nor with their gods (Ex. 23:32), neither shall you and your people serve their gods, for that will be a snare unto you and your house (Deut. 7:16). In **Christ** (John 15:4) we pray, in the name of **Jesus Christ**, the son of God (Heb. 4:14), that your Father that is in heaven (Matt. 6:9) will not lead you and your bloodline into temptation but deliver you from the evil one (Matt. 6:13). Arise, O Lord, confront him, cast him down; may the Lord deliver your life from the wicked with His sword, with His hand from men (Ps. 17:13-14). Break the arm of the wicked and the evil man; O Lord, seek out his wickedness until You find none (Ps. 10:15). Let the Lord deliver you and your

bloodline and your people out of the mouth of the lion (2 Tim. 4:17). May the Lord therefore be judge, and judge between you and the evil one, and see and plead your cause, and deliver you and your people from his hand (1 Sam. 24:15). The Lord is your rock and your fortress and your deliverer; your God, your strength, in whom you shall trust; your shield and the horn of your salvation, your stronghold (Ps. 18:1-2). Blessed be you and your bloodline and your family of God Most High, Possessor of heaven and earth; and blessed be God Most High (Gen. 14:19-20). As for God, His way is perfect; the promise of the Lord proves true; he is a shield for all those who take refuge in him (2 Sam. 22:31). Now my God, we pray, let Your eyes be open and let Your ears be attentive to this prayer (2 Chr. 6:40). Heed our prayer, because we put our trust in You (1 Chr. 5:20). We give thanks to Your holy name, and triumph in Your praise. Blessed be the Lord God of Israel from everlasting to everlasting (1 Chr. 16:35-36). For of Him and through Him and to Him are all things, to whom be glory forever. (Rom. 11:36)

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline, your house and all of your people; by the blood of the lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space by the overpowering presence of God, who has made his home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our **Lord Jesus Christ** (1 Thess. 5:23).

As a vessel of honor (Rom. 9:21), we continue petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to you and your bloodline and your descendants according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to you and your house (Luke 11:9). In Your name we rejoice all day long, and in Your righteousness, we are exalted! For You are the glory of our strength, and in Your favor our horn is exalted! For our shield belongs to the Lord, and we belong to our King, to the Holy One of Israel (Ps. 89:16-18)! In **Jesus'** (John 16:23) name so be it! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever!
