A Prayer for Our Children: Healing



To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him *be* glory and dominion forever and ever (Rev. 1:5-6). As a king (Rev. 5:10) abiding in (1 John 2:29) and one with (John 17:11) the King of Kings (Rev. 17:14), in the authority

given to us (Luke 10:19) in the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Philp. 2:10) we speak words of life (John 6:63) over the children of the United States of America, all those the Lord God chose before the foundation of the world, that they should be holy and without blame before Him in love, having predestined them to adoption as sons by <u>Jesus Christ</u> to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He has made them accepted in the Beloved (Eph. 1:4-6). They are the inheritance of our <u>Lord</u> <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Ps. 2:8) and we are joint heirs with <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 8:17) so we call them Our Beloved Children.

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come into the heart of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21). Your will be done in the life of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). As an ambassador of Christ (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in Christ (John 15:4-5) and one with Him (John 6:56, John 15:5), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), in His Son Jesus Christ (1 John 5:20), we give thanks to the Lord (1 Thess. 5:18), the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21), their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire family (Acts 13:26), and their nation (Math. 21:43) for the saints (Eph. 6:18), for the leaders that God has raised up on their behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23) so that Christ might make known to them the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21), their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), for their entire family (Acts 13:26), their friends, neighbors and countrymen (1 Tim. 2:1-2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43); for all the brethren (Eph. 6:18), all those called by the name of the Lord (Deut. 28:10); for the leaders of their nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the wellbeing of God's people; and all the people of their nation, and all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2), so that Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) may lead a guiet and peaceable life in

all godliness and reverence (1 Tim. 2:1-2). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), We proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2)! We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God (Rom. 5:2)! It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) (James 5:16) their family (Acts 13:26) and their nation (Math. 21:43), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that *Christ*, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) are spirit and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Cor. 15:57)!

We don't come to the Father in Heaven (Math. 6:9) based on our own worthiness (Is. 64:6), or on the worthiness (Is. 64:6) of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26). Abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), we come to God's throne of grace (Heb. 4:16) on the merits of His Son (Eph. 4:13), *Jesus Christ of Nazareth* (Acts 3:6), and the blood that He shed (Rev. 7:14). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), who upholds all things by the word of His power (Heb. 1:3), as a fellow worker in *Christ Jesus* (Rom. 16;3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), on every side (Job 1:10), all of their family (Acts 13:26), all of their blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all their natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of their spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43).

Grace be with Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Col. 4:18). It is written "I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live; that you may love the Lord your God, that you may obey His voice, and that you may cling to Him, for He is your life and the length of your days" (Deut. 30:19-20). According to Your word, so shall it be to our descendants, O Lord. As a fellow worker in <u>Christ Jesus</u> (Rom. 16;3), abiding in Him (John 15:4-5), and one with Him (John 17:22), in the mighty name (Jer. 32:18) of our Lord and

Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), Jesus Christ, we ask our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) to heal Our Children (ls. 61:9) and they shall be healed; save them, and they shall be saved, for He is our praise (Jer. 17:14). It is written: "Peace, peace to them who is far off and to them who is near," says the Lord, "And I will heal them" (Is. 57:18). May the Lord have compassion on Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Mat. 9:16) and restore health to them and heal them of their wounds (Jer. 30:17), that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses" (Matt. 8:17). Now Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) are His servants and His people, whom He has redeemed by His great power, and by His strong hand (Neh. 1:10). Whom He has ransomed from the hand of one stronger than them (Jer. 31:11). O Lord, in *Christ* (John 15:4) we pray (James 5:16), please let Your ear be attentive to this prayer, for we desire to fear Your name; let Our Children (ls. 61:9) prosper this day, and God grant them mercy in the sight of all men (Neh. 1:10-11)! In their distress we call upon the Lord, and cry out to our God; He hears our voice from His temple, and our cry comes before Him, even to His ear (Ps. 18:6). Hear our prayer, O Lord, give ear to our supplications! In Your faithfulness answer us, and in Your righteousness (Ps. 143:1)! In the multitude of Your Mercy Hear us, in the truth of Your salvation (Ps. 69:13). According to Your Word, be merciful to Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Ps. 119:58) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), and with Your Spirit speak to Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Rev. 2:7) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21).

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), let us glorify His name forevermore (Ps. 86:12), let Our Children (Is. 61:9), by the mercies of God, present their body as a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God (Rom. 12:1), being the temple of God (1 Cor. 3:16), as a faithful ambassador (Prov. 13:17), and may the Spirit of God dwell in them (1 Cor. 3:16). For as many as receive Him, <u>Jesus Christ</u>, are given the right to be called the children of God, even those who believe in His name, being born of God, not by blood, not by the will of the flesh, nor by the will of man, but born of God (John 1:13). In <u>Christ</u> (John 15:4) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall receive <u>Jesus Christ</u> and He will make them alive together with Him, forgiving their trespasses (Col. 2:13). The earth is the Lord's, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein! For He has founded it upon the seas, and established it upon the waters (Ps. 24:1-2)!

In the name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23), who is the way, the truth, and the life (John 14:6), Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the Lord (Ps. 118:17). We entreat Your favor, O Lord, with our whole heart; may the Lord be merciful to Our

Children (Is. 61:9) (Ps. 119:58), deal well with His servant (Ps 119:65), revive them (Ps. 119:107) according to His word. Let, we pray (James 5:16), God's merciful kindness be their comfort (Ps. 119:76), and may the Mighty God establish His word to Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Ps. 119:38) that they will trust (Ps. 119:42) and hope in His word (Ps. 119:81). According to the hope of eternal life (Titus 3:7), may Jehovah Ralpha, the Lord who heals (Ex. 15:26), send His word and heal Our Children (ls. 61:9), and deliver them from their destructions (Ps. 107:20), uphold them, strengthen them (Ps. 119:28) and establish them (Ps. 119:38), comfort them in their affliction and give them life (Ps. 119:50) according to His word, and do not let them be ashamed of their hope, but deliver them according to His word (Ps. 119:170), so that they shall glorify Him (Ps. 50:15). The Lord is their portion (Ps. 119:57)! May Jesus Christ cast out the spirits with a word, and heal Our Children (Is. 61:9) for He is willing to cleanse them (Matt. 8:3) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21). He is faithful to heal the lame, blind, mute and the maimed (Matt. 15:31). According to His great goodness towards Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Is. 63:7), may power go out of <u>Christ</u> and heal them all (Luke 6:19). In <u>Christ</u> (John 15:4) we pray (James 5:16), Our Children (Is. 61:9) will prosper in all things and be in health, as their soul prospers (3 John 1:2). Let them take the water of life freely (Rev. 22:17). With joy shall they draw water from the wells of salvation (ls. 12-3); and God will bless their bread and their water and take all sickness away from the midst of Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Ex. 23:25) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21). Lord, You have been our dwelling place in all generations! Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever You had formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, You are God (Ps. 90:1-2)!

Tremble before Him, all the earth. The world also is firmly established; it shall not be moved. Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; and let them say among the nations, "The Lord reigns" (1 Chr. 16:30-31)! God has made Our Children (Is. 61:9) in His own image (Gen. 1:27); God has made them to have dominion over the works of His hands; He has put all things under their feet (Ps. 8:6). *Jesus* gave us authority. It is written: *"I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you"* (Luke 10:19). Therefore, demons, in the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), the Prince of Life (Acts 3:15), listen well, let us introduce Our Children (Is. 61:9) who are children of (John 1:12) the God Most-High (Gen. 14:18). In the name above all other names (Eph. 1:20-21), *Jesus Christ*, Our Children (Is. 61:9) are sprinkled by the blood of *Jesus Christ* (Heb. 12:24), they are called by His name (Is. 43:7). Our Children (Is. 61:9) have a covenant relationship with the God Most-High (Rom. 11:27). Their body and brain (Rom. 12:1), mind and heart (Eph. 4:23), soul (Luke 1:46) and spirit (Eph. 3:16) are the temple (1 Cor. 3:16) of the living God (Deut. 5:26), the God Most-High (Gen. 14:18), the Lord of Hosts (2 Sam 7:26), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End (Rev 1:8) the Creator of all things (ls. 40:28), the only true God (John 17:3), the everlasting God (Is. 40:28) and in Christ (John 15:4) we speak (Jer. 1:7) to you Satan (Math. 4:10) and to all evil (Luke 7:21), wicked (Ps. 97:10) and unclean (Luke 8:29) spirits, in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ (John 16:23) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), who is the head of all principality and power (Col. 2:10), in *Christ* (John 15:4) we command you not to defile this temple, that is Our Children (Is. 61:9), in any manner or by any means for if anyone defiles the temple of God, which Our Children (Is. 61:9) are, God will destroy them. For the temple of God is holy (1 Cor. 3:17)! In *Christ* (John 15:4) we ask the Father God (Phil. 4:20), in the name of His beloved son (Math. 3:17), Jesus *Christ* (John 16:23), who is the image of God (2 cor. 4:4), to fill this temple, which Our Children (Is. 61:9) are, with His Holy Spirit (1 Cor. 3:16) and make it Holy ground (1 Cor. 3:17, Acts 7:33). Likewise, to all their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21). Let them give thanks to Your holy name, O Lord, to triumph in Your praise (1 Chr. 16;35)! Blessed be the Father and God of our Lord Jesus Christ (Rom. 15:6) from everlasting to everlasting (1 Chr. 16:36)!

Thanks be to God, who has given Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) victory through our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Cor. 15:57)! And His name, through faith in His name, has made them strong. Yes, the faith which comes through Jesus has given them this perfect soundness (Acts 3:16). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the precious lamb slain (Rev. 5:12) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Rev. 5:12), may the God Most-High (Gen. 14:18) release the fruit of Calvary (Acts 2:30), the fruit to holiness and everlasting life (Rom. 6:22) over them and their family (Acts 13:26) and declare the victory of Jesus Christ in their lives (1 Cor. 15:57) for the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty (2 Cor. 3:17). Surely, He has borne their grief's and carried their sorrows. He was wounded for their transgressions, He was bruised for their iniquities; the chastisement of their peace was upon Him, and by His stripes they are healed (Is. 53:4-5). For the Lord God is a sun and a shield; the Lord will give grace and glory; no good thing will He withhold from those who walk uprightly (Ps. 84:11)! He has seen their ways, and He will heal them and their people (Ps. 148:14); and lead them and their family (Acts 13:26), and restore comforts to Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Is. 57:18) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). May the Lord be merciful to them, heal them body (Rom. 12:1) and soul (Ps. 41:4), heal their backsliding (Jer. 3:22), and love them freely (Hos. 14:4). According to His promise (2 Pet. 3:13) let the Lord God bind up the bruise of His

child and heal the stroke of their wounds (Is. 30:26). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), their strength in whom they shall trust (Ps. 18:2), may the God of their strength (Ps. 43:2), the God of their defense, the God of mercy. (Ps. 59:17) bring health and healing to Our Children (Is. 61:9); heal and reveal to them the abundance of peace and truth (Jer. 33:6). May the Father of glory (Eph. 1:17 -19) release the power of the Holy spirit (Rom. 15:13) to break through every barrier (2 Cor. 10:4), to heal every hurt (Acts 18:9-10), to heal all broken heartedness (Ps. 147-3), to open their eyes to the truth, to turn them from darkness to light and the power of Satan to God (Acts 26:18) and to reconcile them to Himself (Col. 1:20). May the Spirit of God hover over Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Gen. 1:2) and their family (Acts 13:26) releasing love (1 John 4:8), power (2 Tim. 1:7) and truth (John 14:17) into their lives. May the Holy Spirit hover over Our Children (Is. 61:9) birth a new creation in them (1 Pet. 1:23), the old things shall pass away and they are a new creation (2 Cor. 5:17). Blessed be God, who has not turned away my prayer, nor His mercy from Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Ps. 66:20) and their people (Ps. 148:14)!

Abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) take up the whole armor of God, that they may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to <u>stand</u> (Eph. 6:13). *Jesus Christ*, Himself, who sits at the right hand of God Almighty (Mark 16:19), gives us authority over all the power of the enemy (Luke 10:19). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), in <u>His Son Jesus Christ</u> (1 John 5:20), in His mighty name (Jer. 32:18), we take authority over all the power of the enemy over their mind and heart (2 Tim. 1:7), body and brain (Rom. 12:1), soul (3 John 1:2) and spirit (2 Tim. 1:7) and command that nothing shall grow from it ever again, it shall wither away just as the fig tree withered away when <u>Jesus</u> cursed it in Matt. 21:19 (Luks 10:19). The Lord will perfect that which concerns Our Children (Is. 61:9). For His mercy endures forever (Ps. 138:8)!

In <u>Christ</u> (John 15:4-5), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) take up the whole armor of God, that they may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to <u>stand</u> (Eph. 6:13) against the wiles of the devil (Eph. 6:11). It is written: "I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven" (Matt. 16:19). Therefore, as God's vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), <u>Christ</u> abiding in us and we in Him (John 15:5), in His name, <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), we speak (Jer. 1:7) to all spirits that are not of God and command them to silence (1 Sam 2:9). We relieve them of their assignments and command them to take their rightful place in the footstool of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, for that is their destiny (Math. 22:44). As an ambassador of <u>Christ</u> (2 Cor. 5:20),

a vessel of God's honor (Rom. 9:21), Christ in us (John 15:4) speaks to you Satan (Math. 10:19) and all wicked (Eph. 6:16), unclean (Mark 9:25) or evil spirits (Acts 19:15) that have been assigned to (2 Cor. 12:7), or sent against Our Children (ls. 61:9) (Math. 14:10) or their children (Math. 2:16), and by the authority given to us by Jesus Christ, Himself (Luke 10:19), He who is the head of all principalities and powers (Col. 2:10) and He who abides in us (John 15:4), we bind (Math. 16:19) you Satan (Mark 1:13) and all wicked (Eph. 6:16), evil (Acts 19:15) or unclean spirits (Mark 9:25). In the mighty name (Jer. 32:18) of Jesus Christ (John 16:23) we break your power over this child of God (Luke 10:19), and loose them from your hold (Math. 16:19). In the name of our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 3:18), Jesus Christ (John 16:23), as God's vessel of ministry (Heb. 9:21), we command you Satan (Math. 4:10), and all demonic (Math. 17:18), wicked (Eph. 6:16), evil (Acts 19:15) or unclean spirits (Mark 9:25) to stop your maneuvers and schemes (2 Cor. 2:11), tricks (Eph. 6:11) and snares (2 Tim. 2:25), strategies, wiles (Eph. 6:11), devices (2 Cor. 2:11), and attempts to kill, steal, and destroy Our Children (Is. 61:9) (John 10:10) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21). We declare that Our Children (Is. 61:9) are covered by the blood of the Lamb, Jesus Christ (1 Pet 1:19). Their entire mind and heart (2 Tim. 1:7), body and brain (Rom. 12:1), soul (3 John 1:2) and spirit (2 Tim. 1:7) are covered by the blood of Jesus (Eph. 2:13), who is the mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:33), and by His precious blood (Heb. 12:24), abiding in *Christ* (John 15:4) we bind and break off of Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Math. 16:19) all principalities, powers, rulers of darkness of this age, and spiritual wickedness in high places (Eph. 6:12), all occult activity: witchcraft (Duet. 18:10), curses (Duet. 23:4-5), sorcery (Duet. 18:10), divination (Lev. 19:26) and all soul power that does not glorify our Lord Jesus Christ (Heb. 13:21). We bind the kings of darkness with chains and the nobles of darkness with fetters of iron and we execute the written judgment against them, for this honor has all His saints (Ps. 149:9). It is written: "The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that you may have life, and that you may have it more abundantly" says Jesus Christ (John 10:10), our Redeemer (Job 19:25). Therefore, Christ abiding in us (John 15:4-5, 6:56) commands life and life more abundantly for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). It is written: "It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing" (John 6:63). The words that *Christ*, through us, speaks to Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Math. 10:19) and their family (Acts 13:26) are spirit, and they are life (John 6:63). Christ, Him being in us and we being in Christ (John 15:4), in the glorious and awesome name (Deut. 28:58) of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), we speak (Jer. 1:7) words of life and blessing into their mind and heart (2 Tim. 1:7), body and brain (Rom. 12:1), soul (3 John 1:2) and spirit (2 Tim. 1:7). Jesus Christ through us (Math. 10:19)

commands obedience from their flesh (1 Pet. 1:2), and we release the blessings of God (Math. 16:19) to overtake their mind and heart (2 Tim. 1:7), body and brain (Rom. 12:1), soul (3 John 1:2) and spirit (2 Tim. 1:7). We release peace (John 14:27), prosperity (3 John 1:2) and joy (John 15:11) into their life. We loose (Math 16:19) the ministering angels of God to minister to Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Heb. 1:14). Abiding in Christ (John 15:4-5) and Him in us (John 6:56, John 15:5), being anointed by God with the Holy Spirit and with power (Acts 10:38) we loose Our Children (Is. 61:9) whom Satan has bound (Luke 13,16) and declare healing where they are being tormented by unclean spirits (Acts 5:16) for the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made them free from the law of sin and death (Rom. 8:2). In the glorious and awesome name (Deut. 28:58) of Jesus Christ (John 16:23) we cast out (Math. 16:18) into the outer darkness (Math. 22:13) and into the great abyss (Luke 8:31) all tormenting spirits (1 John 4:18, Rev. 9:5) that torment Our Children (Is. 61:9), we relieve them of all their power (Luke 10:19) and command them to be silent (Luke 10:19), forever mute (Luke 1:20), not to ever return (Math. 12:44) or be heard again by anyone (Mark 11:14). Furthermore, we execute the written judgment of God Almighty (Ps. 149:8-9) and decree destruction on all spirits that defile Our Children (ls. 61:9) in accordance with 1 Cor. 3:17. *Christ* has redeemed them from the curse of the law, having become a curse for Our Children (Is. 61:9) (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"), that the blessing of Abraham might come upon them in *Christ Jesus*, that they might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith (Gal. 3:13-15). If the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in Our Children (Is. 61:9), He who raised *Christ* from the dead will also give vibrant life, healing and energy to their mortal body through His Spirit who dwells in them (Rom. 8:11). As an ambassador of *Christ* (2 Cor. 5:20), like the Sabbath we declare today (Heb. 4:7) is holy to our Lord (Ex. 35:2). The joy of the Lord is our strength (Neh. 8:10). Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come into Our Children's (ls. 61:9) heart, for it is my Father's good pleasure to give them the kingdom (Luke 12:32). Your will be done, Father, in Our Children's (Is. 61:9) mind and heart (2 Tim. 1:7), body and brain (Rom. 12:1), soul (3 John 1:2) and spirit (Rom. 8:15) here on earth as it is in heaven, for Yours, O Lord, is the kingdom, the power, and the glory forever (Matt. 6:9-10).

Because they have made the Lord, who is their refuge, even the Most-High, their habitation, no evil shall befall Our Children (Is. 61:9), nor shall any plague come near their dwelling (Ps. 91:9-10); for God shall give His angels charge over them, to keep them in all their ways (Ps. 91:10-11). Because Our Children (Is. 61:9) have set their love upon God, therefore He will deliver them; He will set them on high, because they have known His

name. Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall call upon God, and He will answer them; He will be with them in trouble; He will deliver them and honor them. With long life He will satisfy them, and show them His salvation (Ps. 91:16). It is written: "Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismaved. for I am your God. I will strengthen you, yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand" (Is. 41:10). So be it to Our Children (Is. 61:9). The Lord is their light and their salvation; whom shall they fear? The Lord is the strength of their life; of whom shall they be afraid? When the wicked come against Our Children (Is. 61:9) to eat up their flesh, their enemies and foes, they stumble and fall. Though an army should encamp against Our Children (Is. 61:9), their heart shall not fear; though war should rise against them, in this they shall be confident: that they shall dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of their life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to inquire in His temple. For in the time of trouble He shall hide them in His pavilion; in the secret place of His Tabernacle He shall hide them; He shall set them high upon a rock. And now their head shall be lifted up above their enemies all around and they shall offer sacrifices of joy in His tabernacle; yes, sing praises to the Lord! When God said, "Seek My face," let their heart say to Him, "Your face, Lord, I will seek" (Ps. 27:1-9). Let them praise the Lord their God with all their heart; sing praises to Him (Ps. 138:1), who keeps His covenant and mercy with those who love Him (Dan. 9:4)! Let them worship toward His holy temple, and praise His name for His loving-kindness and His truth; for He has magnified His word above all His name (Ps. 138:1-2)!

Bless the Lord, O Our Children (Is. 61:9) with all your soul; and all that is within you, bless His holy name! Bless the Lord, O your soul, and forget not all His benefits: The Lord forgives all Our Children's (Is. 61:9) iniquities. The Lord heals all their diseases. The Lord redeems their life from destruction. The Lord crowns them with loving-kindness and tender mercies. The Lord satisfies their mouth with good things, so that their youth is renewed like the eagle's (Ps. 103:5). The Lord executes righteousness and justice for all who are oppressed (Ps. 103:6). Let them trust in the Lord with all their heart, and lean not on their own understanding (Prov. 3:5). In all their ways acknowledge the Lord, and He shall direct their paths (Prov. 3:6). Peace **Jesus** leaves with Our Children (Is. 61:9), they and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21). His peace He gives to Our Children (Is. 61:9). Therefore, let not their heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid (John 14:27). Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning (James 1:17). For God has not given them a spirit of fear, but

of power and of love and of a sound mind (2 Tim. 1:7). Grace and peace be multiplied to Our Children (Is. 61:9) in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, as His divine power has given to them all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called them by glory and virtue, by which have been given to them exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these they may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust (2 Pet. 1:2-4). According to the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23, Eph. 3:16) may the Lord grant (Eph. 3:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) will be neither barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ (2 Pet. 1:8). God has seen their ways, and He will heal Our Children (Is. 61:9). He will also lead them, and restore comforts to them (ls. 57:18). Therefore, they shall seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to them (Matt. 6:33). The Lord is their shepherd: they shall not want (Ps. 23:1). My God will provide all their needs according to His riches and glory (Phil. 4:19)! The Lord will perfect that which concerns Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Ps. 138:8). Therefore, count it all joy when they fall into various trials, knowing that the testing of their faith produces patience. But let patience have its perfect work, that Our Children (Is. 61:9) may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing (James 1:2-4). In all these things Our Children (Is. 61:9) are more than a conqueror through Him who loves them (Rom. 8:37), for God always leads them in triumph through Jesus Christ (2 Cor. 2:14). Greater is He who is in Our Children (Is. 61:9) than He who is in the world (1 John 4:4) and If God is for them, who can be against them (Rom. 8:31)? The Lord is at hand (Phil. 4:5). God is their refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore, they shall not fear, though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea; though its waters roar and be troubled, though the mountains shake with its swelling! Selah (Ps. 46:1-3)

Our Children (Is. 61:9) will be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let their requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard their heart and mind through <u>*Christ Jesus*</u> (Phil. 4:6-7). In <u>*Christ*</u> (John 15:4) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) will give attention to God's words; incline their ear to His sayings and not let them depart from their eyes; keep them in the midst of their heart; for they are life to those who find them, and health to all their flesh (Prov. 4:20-27). The entrance of His words gives light; it gives understanding to the simple (Ps. 119:116). Your word, O Lord, is a lamp to their feet and a light to their path (Ps. 119:105). In <u>*Christ*</u> (John 15:4) we pray (James 5:16) Our Children (Is. 61:9) will

seek those things which are above, where <u>Christ</u> is, sitting at the right hand of God. Set their mind on things above, not on things on the earth (Col. 3:1-2). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) keep their eyes on the Lord and they will have perfect peace (Is. 26.3)! God grant that Our Children (Is, 61:9) will meditate on whatever things are true, whatever things are noble. whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, and whatever things are lovely and on whatever things are of good report (Phil. 4:8). Our Children (Is. 61:9) are the elect of God, holy and beloved. Therefore, they shall put on tender mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, patience and forgive others even as *Christ* forgives them (Col. 3:12-13). Jesus Christ, Him who poured out His soul unto death for them, Him who bore their sin and made intercession for their transgressions (ls. 53:12), in His glorious name (1 Chr. 29:13) we pray (James 5:16) the prayer of faith which will save the sick, and the Lord will raise them up. And if they have committed sins, they will be forgiven (James 5:15). For the effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much (James 5:16). Therefore, Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall not cast away their confidence, which has great reward. For Our Children (Is. 61:9) have need of endurance, so that after they have done the will of God, they may receive the promise (Heb. 10:35-36). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) hold fast the confession of their hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful (Heb. 10:23), there has not failed one word of all His good promise (1 Kin. 8:56), so judge Him faithful who has promised (Heb. 11:11) and do not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but be strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He has promised He is also able to perform (Rom. 4:20-21). By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth (Ps. 33:6). Let all the earth fear the Lord; let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him (Ps. 33:8). "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." Says the Lord (Ps. 89:34). In Christ (John 15:4) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (ls. 61:9) will overcome by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and that they do not love their life to the death (Rev. 12:11). Oh, satisfy us early with Your mercy, O Lord, that we may rejoice and be glad all our days. Let Your work appear to Our Children (Is. 61:9), and Your glory to their children! And let the beauty of the Lord our God be upon them, and establish the work of their hands for them; yes, establish the work of their hands (Ps, 90:14-17)!

In Him who is true, in His <u>Son Jesus Christ</u> (1 John 5:20), we pray (James 5:16) the Lord will take away from Our Children (Is. 61:9) all sickness, and will afflict them with none of the terrible diseases of Egypt (Deut. 7:15). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), through faith

in His name (Acts 3:16), let the blind receive their sight and the lame walk; the lepers be cleansed and the deaf hear; the dead be raised up and the poor have the gospel preached to them (Matt. 11:5-6). May the Lord Jesus Christ (Rom. 16:24) lay His hand on Our Children (Is. 61:9) and heal them. Every unclean spirit or demon come out of them (Luke 4:40-41) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21). Let every sickness and every disease (Matt. 9:35), all those who are afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who are demonpossessed, epileptics, and paralytics (Matt. 4:24), and all kinds of addictions (1 Cor. 6:12) and all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease (Matt. 1:34) be healed by Jesus Christ today. May power go out of Him and heal them all (Luke 6:19), heal their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), and revoke all blood curses (Gal. 3:13) in their DNA (Ex. 34:7) and replace their DNA with the DNA of God for it is written that Our Children (Is. 61:9) have the divine nature of God and have escaped the corruption of this world (2 Pet. 1:4) through the blood of Jesus Christ (Heb. 12:24) for their Savior Jesus Christ hung on a tree for Our Children (Is. 61:9) so that they would be delivered from the curse and receive the promise of Abraham (Gal. 3:13-14) and they are healed by His stipes (1 Pet. 2:24). For Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever (Heb. 13:8). He, Jesus Christ, will seek what was lost and bring back what was driven away, bind up the broken and strengthen the sick (Ezek. 34:16). For our heart shall rejoice in Him, because we have trusted in His holy name. Let Your mercy, O Lord, be upon Our Children (Is. 61:9), just as they hope in You (Ps. 33:21-22)!

It is written: "For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down imaginations, arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of <u>Christ</u>" (2 Cor. 10:3-5). As a fellow worker in <u>Christ Jesus</u> (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him (John 15:4-5), and one with Him (John 17:22) we release (Matt. 16:19) the weapons in God to pull down and demolish the strongholds of pride (Rom. 1:30), fear (Rom. 8:15), self (Gal. 5:20), selfishness, selfcenteredness (2 Cor. 12:20, 2 Tim. 3:2, doubt and unbelief (Matt. 14:31); as well as discouragement (Math. 18:10, Rom 14:13), depression (1 Sam. 16:14, James 4:9, Rev. 18:11), Suicide (Math. 27:5), blame placing (Is. 58:9), fault finding or criticism (Is. 54:7, Dan 6:4), murmuring (John 6:43) complaining (Philp. 2:14) and any alcohol (Titus 2:2-3), drug or substance abuse (1 Cor. 6:12) in Our Children (Is. 61:9). As a coworker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), <u>Christ</u> abiding in us and we in Him (John 15:4), and in the name which is raised up above all other names (Phil. 2:9), <u>Jesus Christ</u>, we come against the spirits of, and demolish the strongholds of, and cast down the imaginations of (2 cor. 10:4-5), fever (Math. 8:15), infections (Ps. 27:2, 2 Pet. 1:4), virus (2 Pet. 1:4), addictions (1 Cor. 6:12), sickness (Ex. 23:25), disease (Ps. 41:8, Math. 10:1), brokenness (Ezek. 34:16), wounds (Is. 30:26), blindness (Math. 12:22), muteness (Math. 12:22), infirmity (Luke 13:12), lameness (Math. 11:5), deafness (Mark 7:37), poison (Mark 16:18) and demon possession (Math. 12:22), for it is written "by His stripes you are healed" (Is. 53:5). Therefore, we rebuke all fever (Luke 4:39), infections (Ps. 27:2, 2 Pet. 1:4), Virus (2 Pet. 1:4), addictions (1 Cor. 6:12), sickness (Ex. 23:25, disease (Ps. 41:8, Math. 10:1), brokenness (Ezek. 34:16), wounds (Is. 30:26), blindness (Math. 12:22), muteness (Math. 12:22), infirmity (Luke 13:12), lameness (Math. 11:5) deafness (Mark 7:37), poison (Mark 16:18) and command (Math. 16:19) all unclean spirits (Acts 5:16) be removed from their body, brain and heart (Matt. 21:21). In all their affliction, He, Jesus Christ, is afflicted, and the Angel of His Presence saves them; in His love and in His Pity He redeems them; and He bears them and carries them all of their days (ls. 63:9). He was wounded for their transgressions. He was bruised for their iniquities: the chastisement for their peace was upon Him, and by His stripes they are healed (ls. 53:5). The Lord will make an utter end of it and (Nahum. 1:9) as a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), in *Christ* (John 15:4) we command the affliction not to rise up a second time (Nahum 1:9). According to His own purpose and grace which was given to them in *Christ Jesus* before time began (2 Tim 1:9) the Lord grant (1 Tim 1;18) their eyes are opened and they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and return and be healed (Is. 6:10). Let the weak say 'I am strong' (Joel 3:10-15). For according to His promise (2 Pet. 3:13) Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall know that He has healed them (Hosea 11:3). Jesus Christ, who is their redeemer (Gal. 4:5), their savior (2 Pet. 1:11), and their healer (Ex. 15:26), having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it (Col. 2:15). Thanks be to God who gives them victory through our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Cor. 15:57) and always leads them in triumph through our Lord Jesus **Christ** (2 Cor. 2:14)! For God has not given them a spirit of fear, but a spirit of power and a spirit of love and a spirit of a sound mind (2 Tim. 1:7). You Our Children (Is. 61:9) are complete in Him, *Jesus Christ*, who is the head of all principalities & powers. Be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might (Eph. 6:10). Great is our Lord, and mighty in power; His understanding is infinite! The Lord lifts up the humble; sing to the Lord with thanksgiving (Ps. 147:5-7). The Lord takes pleasure in those who fear Him, in those who hope in His mercy! Praise the Lord (Ps. 147:11-12)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), who is the bread of life (John 6:48), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) will give attention to God's word, incline their ear to His sayings, and not let His word depart from their eyes, but keep them in the midst of their heart; for they are life to them, and health to all their flesh (Prov. 4:20-23). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) keep their heart with all diligence, for out of it spring the issues of life (Prov. 4:20-23). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) will not be wise in their own eyes; but that they fear the Lord and depart from evil. For it will be health to their flesh, and strength to their bones (Prov. 3:7-8). Let God's word be a lamp to their feet and a light to their path (Ps. 119-105). For the word of the Lord is true and it is proven (Ps. 119:116)!

May the Lord help Our Children (ls. 61:9) meditate on His word through the night watches (Ps. 119-148), and direct their steps by His word, and let no iniquity have dominion over them (Ps. 119-133). May the word of God become sweet to their taste, sweeter than honey to their mouth (Ps. 119-103) that they will rejoice at His word as one who finds great treasure (Ps. 119-162). Let their heart stand in awe of their word (Ps. 119:160) and their tongue speak of His word, for all His commandments are righteousness (Ps. 119:172). God creates the fruit of their lips (Is. 57:19), for by their words they will be justified, and by their words they will be condemned (Matt. 12:37) therefore may the words of their mouth be words of life and blessing (Duet. 30:19). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) have a merry heart for a merry heart does good, like medicine (Prov. 17:22) and they who has a merry heart has a continual feast (Prov. 15:15). Therefore, in everything may they give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for them (1 Thess. 5:18). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we beseech them whenever they are afraid, trust in the Lord (Ps. 56:3), in God put their trust; do not be afraid (Ps. 56:11). According to truth (Rom 2:12) may Our Children (Is. 61:9) believe the Word of God and sing His praise (Ps. 106-12)! Let Our Children (ls. 61:9) diligently heed the voice of the Lord their God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, for He is the Lord who heals them (Ex. 15:26) and He will not let sin have dominion over them (Prov. 4:21-22). He will uphold Our Children (Is. 61:9) according to His word, that they may live (and more abundantly); and He will not let them be ashamed of their hope (Ps. 119-116). Therefore, as an ambassador in chains to Jesus Christ (Eph. 6:20), we plead with Our Children (Is. 61:9) to take up the whole armor of God, that they may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having girded their waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and having shod their feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; above all, taking the shield of faith with which they will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. And take the helmet of salvation,

and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. According to all His wonderful works (Jer. 21:2) may <u>Jesus Christ</u> help their unbelief (Mark 9:24) and give Our Children (Is. 61:9) utterance, that they may open their mouth boldly, taking the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, speaking boldly, as they ought to speak; praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication (Eph. 6:13-20). Therefore, Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall submit to God and resist the devil and he will flee from them (James 4:7). Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, to Him be glory in the church by <u>Christ Jesus</u> throughout all ages, world without end (Eph. 3:20-21).

Because Our Children (ls. 61:9) have made the Lord, who is their refuge, even the Most-High, their habitation (Ps. 91;9), because they have set their love upon God, and because they have known His name (Ps. 91:14), surely He, our Great God, our mighty and awesome God (Deut. 1:17), will deliver them from the snare of the fowler and from the perilous pestilence. He will cover them with His feathers, and under His wings they shall take refuge; His truth shall be their shield and buckler (Ps. 91:3-4). Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall not be afraid of the terror by night, nor of the arrow that flies by day, nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness, nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday. A thousand may fall at their side, and ten thousand at their right hand; but it shall not come near Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Ps. 91:5-7). Only with their eyes shall they look, and see the reward of the wicked (Ps. 91:8). No evil shall befall them, nor shall any plague come near their dwelling; for He shall give His angels charge over Our Children (ls. 61:9), to keep them in all their ways. They shall bear Our Children (Is. 61:9) up in their hands, lest they dash their foot against a stone (Ps. 10:13). Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall tread upon the lion and the cobra, the young lion and the serpent they shall trample under foot. He will deliver them; He will set them on high. Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall call upon God, and He will answer them. He will be with them in trouble; He will deliver them and honor them. With long life He will satisfy them, and show them His salvation (Ps. 91:16). Amen

In the mighty name of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, He who God raised from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come. And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things (Eph. 1:20-22). It is written "Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of <u>Jesus</u> every knee

should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that *Jesus Christ is Lord*, to the glory of God the Father (Phil. 2:9-11). In that awesome name (Deut. 28:58), we command all these blessings to come upon Our Children (Is. 61:9) and overtake them (Duet. 28:2). We command blessing (Duet. 28:2) and life (Duet. 30:19), prosperity (3 John 1:2) and health (3 John 1:2), joy (John 15:11) and peace (John 14:27) upon them. In the name of **Jesus** (John 16:23) they are healed, body and brain (Rom. 12:1), mind and heart (Rom. 12:2) soul (3 John 1:2) and spirit (Rom. 8:15). They do not deny the Holy One and the Just (Acts 3:14), and His name, through faith in His name, has made Our Children (Is. 61:9) strong (Acts 3:16). Yes, the faith which comes through Him has given Our Children (Is. 61:9) this perfect soundness in the presence of all (Acts 3:14-16). We praise the name of the Lord, let it be magnified in Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Ps. 69:30), and all their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21)! Extol the name of the Lord (Ps. 68:4)! The Lord be magnified (Ps. 40:16)!

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), their nation (Math. 21:43) and all of their people (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify their time (ls. 9:7, ls. 59:21) so that they will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify their space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in them (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify them completely; and may their whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Thess. 5:23). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), Jesus Christ, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed (Dan. 7:14). The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein (Ps. 24:1). The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness. He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it (Ps. 10:11). For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him (Col. 1:16). You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created (Rev. 4:11)! As a fellow worker in Christ (Rom. 16:3), a

fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (ls. 61:2)! As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that **Christ** might make known to Our Children (Is. 61:9) their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7. Prov. 11:21), and their nation (Math. 21:43) the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23, Eph. 1:18), we claim Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), their family (Acts 13:26), their children and their children's children (Prov. 11:21) as our joint inheritance (Eph. 1:18) with our Lord Jesus Christ (Gal. 4:7). By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most-High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom (Dan. 7:22). Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and *Christ* will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin! And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now, our salvation is near (Rom. 13:11)! Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it (Is. 34:1)! In **Christ** (John 16:23) we pray that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) in one accord (Acts 1:14) will pray for the peace of Jerusalem for it is written: "May they prosper who love you" (Ps. 122:6). The LORD bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) out of Zion, and may they see the good of Jerusalem all the days of their life (Ps. 128:5). As kings and priests of the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ (Rev. 1:6), we decree Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) shall stand (2 Chr. 11:13) with Israel against the ungodly nations (Ezek. 13:5) for their shield belongs to the LORD, and their king to the Holy One of Israel (Psalm 89:18).

In the name of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), Our Children (Is. 61:9) are washed, they are sanctified, they are justified in the name of the <u>Lord Jesus</u> and by the Spirit of our God (1 Cor. 6:11) so in His name we ask our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) and receive all these things (Math. 7:7) for Our Children (Is. 61:9). Concerning this prayer of faith (James 5:15) that we pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with them (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). Being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), we pray (James 5:16) with confidence (1 John 5:14) for God's thoughts towards Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) are thoughts of peace, to give them a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11). As a chosen vessel of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, to bear His name (Acts 9:15), we continue petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have

asked shall be given to them (Luke 11:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. Praise the LORD (Ps. 149:9)! It is written: "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips," says the Lord God Almighty Psalms 89:34. God is watching over His word to perform it Jerimiah 1:12 and it shall not return to Him void; but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it Isaiah 55:11. The Lord gives voice before His army, for His camp is very great; for strong is the One who executes His word **Joel 2:11**! The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations **Psalms 33:1.** It shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, as the Lord has said, among the remnant whom the Lord calls Joel 2:32. "For My name shall be great among the nations," says the Lord of hosts Malachi 1:11. We ask our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 16:23), who gave Himself for us, that He might purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works (Titus 2:14), believing that Our Children (Is. 61:9), their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) receive all we ask for them (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14). You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of Your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! In Jesus' name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! We will rejoice in our salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners! May the Lord fulfill all our petitions (Ps. 20:5)! By the blood of the everlasting covenant (Heb. 13:20), in the awesome name (Deut. 28:58) of Jesus Christ (Rom. 14:11), the mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24), we activate (Math 16:19) these Prophetic Scriptures (Rom. 16:25-27) in the lives of Our Children (ls. 61:9). These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God: Amen! (Rev. 3:14) For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God! (2 Cor. 1:20)!
