## The Name



Yours, O Lord, is the greatness, the power and the glory, the victory and the majesty; for all that is in heaven and in earth is Yours; Yours is the kingdom, O Lord, and You are exalted as head over all. (1 Chr. 29:11). Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9). In the name

of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, for He has by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than the angels of God (Heb. 1:4), in His excellent name we lift up you and your entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to the Father (Math. 6:9), all of your family (Acts 13:26), all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all your natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of your spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2). In the mighty and awesome name of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, the great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant (Heb. 12:20), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for you, your posterity (Prov. 11:21) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). The words that <u>Christ</u>, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to you and your family (Acts 13:26) are spirit, and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (1 Cor. 15:57)!

Our *Father in heaven* hallowed be your name (Deut. 28:58). Doubtless You are our Father, though Abraham was ignorant of us, and Israel does not acknowledge us. You, O Lord, are our Father; our Redeemer from everlasting is Your Name (ls. 63:16). O Lord, You are our Father; we are the clay, and You our potter; and we are the work of Your hand (ls. 64:8). In the name (John 16:23) of Jesus Christ of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), our redeemer (Gal. 4:5, Job 19:25), our savior (2 Pet. 1:11), and our Lord (2 Pet. 1:11), may you and all of your family (Acts 13:26) receive Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11) and believe in His name for as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name (John 1:12). May the God of our salvation (1 Thess. 5:9) say to you and your family: "I will lead them. I will cause them to walk by the rivers of waters, in a straight way in which they shall not stumble for I am a Father to them". Let you and all your people be born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God (John 1:12-13). Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on you, that you should be called children of God! Therefore, the world does not know you, because it did not know Him (1 John 3:1-3). In the mighty name (Jer. 32:18) of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23) we pray (James 5:16) that you and all your family (Acts 13:26) will be led by the Spirit of God and be

known as the sons of God (Rom. 8:14). For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom you cry out, "Abba, Father!" (Rom. 8:15). For you are all sons of God through faith in *Christ Jesus* (Gal. 3:26). And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!" (Gal. 4:6). In *Christ* (John 15:4) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) are baptized into *Christ* and put on *Christ* (Gal. 3:26-28). Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven (Matt. 5:16). In *Christ* (John 15:4) we pray (James 5:16) that you and all your people will love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you, that you may be sons of your Father in heaven (Matt. 5:44-45). Let you and all your family (Acts 13:26) do good, and lend, hoping for nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Highest. For He is kind to the unthankful and evil. Therefore, be merciful, just as your Father also is merciful (Luke 6:36). Judge not, and you shall not be judged. Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven (Luke 6:37). Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you (Luke 6:38). Then you, the righteous, will shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of your Father. He who has ears to hear, let him hear (Matt. 13:43)! God grant (1 Sam. 1:17) that you know that you are of God, and the whole world lies under the sway of the wicked one. And you know that the Son of God has come and has given you an understanding, that you may know Him who is true; and you are in Him who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God and eternal life (1 John 5:19-20). We know that whoever is born of God does not sin; but he who has been born of God keeps himself, and the wicked one does not touch him (1 John 5:18). Therefore, you shall be perfect, just as your Father in heaven is perfect (Matt. 5:48). Blessed are You, Lord God of Israel, our Father, forever and ever! Yours, O Lord, is the greatness, the power and the glory, the victory and the majesty; for all that is in heaven and in earth is Yours; Yours is the kingdom, O Lord, and You are exalted as head over all! Both riches and honor come from You, and You reign over all! In Your hand is power and might; in Your hand it is to make great and to give strength to all! Now therefore, our God, we thank You and praise Your glorious name (1 Chr. 29:10-13)! You are our Father, Our God, and the rock of our salvation (Ps. 89:26)!

Our <u>Father in heaven</u> hallowed be your name (Math. 6:9). O Lord, our Lord, how excellent is Your name in all the earth, You who set Your glory above the heavens (Ps. 8:1)!

The Lord is our Shepherd (Ps. 23:1). He is named Jehovah Raah - Lord your Shepherd (Ps. 23:1). **Jesus Christ**, He is the Good Shepherd for He gave His life for you and your house (John 10:11). **Jesus Christ**, our savior and our redeemer (ls. 60:16), He is who is the way, the truth, and the life (John 14:6), sends to you and all your family (Acts 13:26) the Helper (John 16:17), the Comforter (John 15:26), even the Spirit of Truth, which will guide you into all truth (John 15:26), and because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father! Gal. 4:6). Therefore, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might (Eph. 6:10) having girded your waist with truth (Eph. 6:14). According to the eternal purpose (Eph 3:1) the Lord God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth (Ex. 34:6) keep you and all your family in His name (John 17:12) and sanctify you by His truth. His word is truth (John 17:17). Therefore, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might (Eph. 6:10) having girded your waist with truth (Eph. 6:14). In *Christ* (John 15:4) we pray (James 5:16) that you hear His voice, and He knows you, and you and all your people follow Him (John 10:27). For He, <u>Jesus Christ</u>, who came as High Priest of good things to come (Heb. 10:1), gives you eternal life, and you shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch you out of His hand (John 10:28). Let you be among the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes (Rev. 14:4). May you and all your loved ones be redeemed from among men (Rev. 14:4), and in your mouth let no guile be found (1 Pet. 2:22), instead may you be holy and blameless in love (Eph. 1:4), being without fault before the throne of God (Rev. 14:5). **Jesus Christ**, our High Priest, is seated at the right hand of the Majesty in the heavens (Heb. 8:1) and is confessing you and your house before His Father who is in heaven (Matt. 10:32). Behold, the Man whose name is the BRANCH, Jesus the Christ! From His Place He shall branch out, and He shall build the temple of the Lord; yes, He shall build the temple of the Lord. He shall bear the glory, and shall sit and rule on His throne; so, He shall be a priest on His throne, and the counsel of peace shall be between Him and you (Zech. 6:12-13)! For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; and the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace (Is. 9:6)! Let them praise the name of the Lord, for His name alone is exalted; His glory is above the earth and heaven (Ps. 148:13)!

And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by <u>Christ</u>

<u>Jesus</u> (Phil 4:19). His name is Jehovah-Jireh – the Lord will provide (Ex. 17:15). Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, to Him be glory in the church by <u>Christ Jesus</u> throughout all

ages, world without end (Eph. 3:20-21)! You shall eat in plenty and be satisfied, and praise the name of the Lord your God, who has dealt wondrously with you; and you, His people shall never be put to shame (Joel 2:26). And in that day, you will say: "Praise the Lord, call upon His name; declare His deeds among the peoples, make mention that His name is exalted (Is. 12:4)! Let us offer to You the sacrifice of thanksgiving, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth (Matt. 11:25), and let us call upon the name of the Lord (Ps. 116:17)! His name shall endure forever; His name shall continue as long as the sun! And men shall be blessed in Him; all nations shall call Him blessed! Blessed be the Lord God, the God of Israel, who only does wondrous things! And blessed be His glorious name forever! And let the whole earth be filled with His glory (Ps. 72:17-20)! We give thanks to You, O God, we give thanks! For Your wondrous works declare that Your name is near (Ps. 75:1)! Not unto us, O Lord, not unto us, but to Your name give glory, because of Your mercy, and because of Your truth (Ps. 115:1)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), for His name alone is exalted; His glory is above the earth and heaven (Ps. 148:13), may the door of your heart open (Rev. 3:20), and you hear His voice (Rev. 3:20); and He, the King, whose name is the Lord of hosts (Jer. 46:18), call you, His own sheep, by name and lead you (John 10:3), and go before you (John 10:4), and we pray (James 5:16) you and your family (Acts 13:26) follow him, for you know his voice (John 10:3-4). Now may the God of peace who brought up our *Lord Jesus* from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever (Heb. 13:20-21). For you were like sheep going astray but have now returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls (1 Pet. 2:25). He makes you to lie down in green pastures (Ps. 23:2). It is written: "I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture" (John 10:9). "The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly" (John 10:10). "I am the Good Shepherd. The Good Shepherd gives His life for the sheep" (John 10:9-11). So we, Your people and sheep of Your pasture (Ps. 79:13), will give You thanks forever; we will show forth Your praise to all generations (Ps. 79:13)! Praise the Lord! Praise, O servants of the Lord, praise the name of the Lord (Ps. 113:1)!

In the name above all other names (Eph. 1:21), <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), the Chief Shepherd (1 Pet. 5:4), may the Lord lead you and all your family (Acts 13:26) beside the still waters (Ps. 23:2) for His name is Jehovah-Shalom –the Lord is peace (Judge 6:24). **Jesus** 

**Christ**, whose name alone is the Lord, who is the Most-High over all the earth (Ps. 83:18), shall leave with you peace, His peace He gives to you; not as the world gives does He give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid (John 14:27). In Him, Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the High Priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek (Heb. 6:20), you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, He, our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 2:20), has overcome the world (John 16:33). Having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace (Eph. 6:15), be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might (Eph. 6:10) saying: "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!" (Luke 19:37). Blessed be the name of the Lord from this time forth and forevermore! From the rising of the sun to its going down the Lord's name is to be praised. The Lord is high above all nations, and His glory above the heavens. Who is like the Lord our God, who dwells on high, who humbles Himself to behold the things that are in the heavens and in the earth (Ps. 113:2-6)? He restores your soul (Ps. 23:3); Jehovah-Rapha – the Lord that heals is His name (Ex. 15:26). To you who fear His name the Sun of Righteousness shall arise with healing in His wings; and you shall go out and grow fat like stall-fed calves (Mal. 4:2). He has seen your ways, and He will heal you and your people; and lead you and your family (Acts 13:26) and restore comforts to you and your house (is. 57:18). May the Lord be merciful to you, heal you, body and soul (Ps. 41:4), heal your backsliding (Jer. 3:22), and love you freely (Hos. 14:4). According to His promise (2 Pet. 3:13) let the Lord God bind up the bruise of His child and heal the stroke of your wounds (Is. 30:26). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), your strength in whom you shall trust (Ps. 18:2), may the God of your strength (Ps. 43:2), the God of your defense, the God of mercy (Ps. 59:17) bring health and healing to you; heal and reveal to you the abundance of peace and truth (Jer. 33:6). May the Father of glory (Eph. 1:17-19) release the power of the Holy spirit (Rom. 15:13) to break through every barrier (2 Cor. 10:4), to heal every hurt (Acts 18:9-10), to heal all broken heartedness (Ps. 147-3), to open your eyes to the truth, to turn you from darkness to light and the power of Satan to God (Acts 26:18) and to reconcile you to Himself (Col. 1:20).

Lord Jehovah, our everlasting strength, (Is. 26:4), He leads us in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake (Ps. 23:3). For He is called Jehovah-Tsidkenu – the Lord our Righteousness (Jer. 23:6, Jer. 33:16). For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for you, that you might become the righteousness of God in Him (2 Cor. 5:21). No weapon formed against you shall prosper, and every tongue which rises against you in judgment you shall condemn. This is your heritage for you are not only a servant of the Lord (Is. 54:17) but also a child of God (Rom. 8:16), and your righteousness is from God (Is. 54:17, Eph. 4:24). Commit

your way to the Lord, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass. He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, and your justice as the noonday. Rest in the Lord and wait patiently for Him (Ps. 37:5-7). In Christ (John 15:4) we pray (James 5:16) for your sake He will not hold His peace, and for your family's (Acts 13:26) sake He will not rest, until your righteousness goes forth as brightness, and your salvation as a lamp that burns (ls. 62:1). The name of the Lord is a strong tower; the righteous run to it and are safe (Prov. 18:10). Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might (Eph. 6:10) having put on the breastplate of righteousness (Eph. 6:14). In Your name Lord Jesus we rejoice all day long, and in Your righteousness we are exalted. For You are the glory of our strength, and in Your favor our horn is exalted. For our shield belongs to the Lord, and our family to the Holy One of Israel (Ps. 89:16-18)! In the mighty name of Jesus Christ, the Son of living God (John 10:36, Matt. 16:16), they shall call His name Immanuel, which is translated, "God with us" (Matt. 1:23), in His name though you walk through the valley of the shadow of death, you will fear no evil (Ps. 23:4); for the Lord, our great and awesome God (Dan. 9:45) is with you; for His name is called Jehovah-Shammah – the Lord Is Present (Ezek. 48:35). For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." (Heb. 13:5). **Jesus** Christ, the light of the world, the light of life (John 8:12), is with you always, even to the end of the age (Matt. 28:20). And those who know Your name will put their trust in You; for You, Lord, have not forsaken those who seek You. Let us sing praises to the Lord, who dwells in Zion! Declare His deeds among the people (Ps. 9:10-11)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), the King, whose name is the Lord of hosts (Jer. 46:18) let His rod and His staff comfort you for He is Jehovah-Sabaoth – the Lord of Hosts (2 Sam. 5:10). May the Lord answer you in the day of trouble; may the name of the God of Jacob defend you; may He send you help from the sanctuary and strengthen you out of Zion (Ps. 20:1-2). Some trust in chariots, and some in horses; but God grant (1 Sam. 1:17) that you will remember the name of the Lord your God (Ps. 20:7). Through the Lord of hosts, the Mighty One of Israel (Is. 1:24) you and all your family (Acts 13:26) will push down your enemies; through His name you will trample those who rise up against you (Ps. 44:5). Your help is in the name of the Lord, who made heaven and earth (Ps. 124:8). In God may you and your people boast all day long and praise His name forever! Selah (Ps. 44:8)! He, Jehovah-Nissi – the Lord Your Banner (Ex. 17:15), prepares a table before you in the presence of your enemies (Ps. 23:5). So, shall you fear the name of the Lord from the west, and His glory from the rising of the sun; when the enemy comes in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord will lift up a standard against him (Is. 59:19). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John

16:23), for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved (Acts 4:12), may Jehovah-Mekoddishkem – the Lord Who Sanctifies You (Ec. 31:13), anoint your head with oil. It shall come to pass in that day that his burden will be taken away from your shoulder, and his yoke from your neck, and the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing oil (ls. 10:27). Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might (Eph. 6:10) taking the helmet of salvation (Eph. 6:17), for the Lord is your rock and your fortress and your deliverer; your God, your strength, in whom you shall trust; your shield and the horn of your salvation, your stronghold (Ps. 18:2). Therefore, be strong in the name of the Lord and in the power of His might (Eph. 6:10), taking the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God (Eph. 6:17). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the author of your salvation (Heb. 2:10), the door to salvation (John 10:9), in His name, that name which is raised up above all other names (Philip, 2:9), we ask the God of your salvation (Ps. 25:4) to give you the shield of His salvation; may His right hand hold you up, His gentleness make you and your house great (2 sam. 22:36). May the God of mercy (Ps. 59:17) enlarge your path under you; so that your feet do not slip (2 Sam. 22:37). Your cup runs over (Ps. 23:5) for El Shaddai – the All-Sufficient One is your God (Gen. 17:1). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) take up the cup of salvation and call upon the name of the Lord (Ps. 116:13). May you and your people rejoice in your salvation, and in the name of your God you shall set up your banners (Ps.18:35-36)! May the Lord fulfill all your petitions (Ps. 20:5). We give thanks to You, O God, we give thanks! For Your wondrous works declare that Your name is near (Ps. 75:1). We will worship toward Your holy temple and praise Your name for Your lovingkindness and Your truth; for You, O Lord, have magnified Your word above all Your name (Ps, 138:2)! May you praise the Lord your God, with all your heart, and you and your people (Ps. 148:14) shall glorify His name forevermore (Ps. 86:12). Let us praise the name of the Lord, that men may know that He, whose name alone is the Lord, is the Most-High over all the earth (Ps. 83:18), for His name alone is exalted; His glory is above the earth and heaven (Ps. 148:13)!

Surely goodness and mercy shall follow you and your house all the days of your life; and you will dwell in the house of the Lord forever (Ps. 23:1-6). For thus says the High and Lofty One Who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: "I dwell in the high and holy place, with him who has a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones (Is. 57:15)". Let us join ourselves to the Lord, to serve Him, and let us love the name of the Lord, be His servants, keep from defiling the Sabbath, and hold fast His covenant (Is. 56:6-6). Praise the name of the Lord! He shall bring

us to His holy mountain and make us joyful in His house of prayer (Is. 56:7). Praise the Lord! Praise the name of the Lord; praise Him, O you servants of the Lord! You who stand in the house of the Lord, in the courts of the house of our God, praise the Lord, for the Lord is good; sing praises to His name, for it is pleasant (Ps. 135:1-3)! Sing to God, sing praises to His name; extol Him who rides on the clouds, by His name YAH, and rejoice before Him (Ps. 68:4)! Let us praise the name of God with a song, and we will magnify Him with thanksgiving (Ps. 69:30)! Let us praise Your great and awesome name, O God, You are holy (Ps. 99:3)! So, the nations shall fear the name of the Lord, and all the kings of the earth Your glory (Ps. 102:15)! But You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of Your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)!

In Christ (John 15:4) we pray (James 5:16) according to all that the Lord has bestowed on you, and the great goodness toward your house, which He has bestowed on you according to His mercies, according to the multitude of His loving kindnesses (ls. 63:7), according to the riches of His grace (Eph 1:7) and hope of eternal life. (Titus 3:7), according to the good pleasure of His will (Eph. 1:5), may you and your family (Acts 13:26) be called by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ (Acts 15:17). Jesus Christ, Him who manifested God's name to men (John 17:6), who is the brightness of God's glory and the express image of His person (Heb. 1:3), who is the image of God (2 Cor. 4:4), being God who was manifested in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen by angels, preached among the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up in glory (1 Tim. 3:16), from the rising of the sun, even to its going down, His name shall be great among the nations (Matt. 1:11)! Jesus Christ, who stands at the right hand of God (Acts 7:55), who gave Himself for our sins, that He might deliver us from this present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father (Gal. 1:4-5), according to the working of God's mighty power by which He worked in *Christ* when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come. And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things (Eph. 1:19-23), receiving all authority in heaven and on earth (Matt. 28:18), being the head of all principality and power (Col. 2:10), having power and authority over all demons (Luke 9:1), and having authority over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to as many as our heavenly Father has given Him (John 17:2). At the name of **Jesus** every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and those on earth, and of those under the earth, and every tongue should confess that **Jesus Christ is Lord**, to the glory of God (Phil 2:8). **Jesus Christ**, a chosen vessel of God to bear His name before Gentiles,

kings, and the children of Israel (Acts 9:15), through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God (Rom. 5:2), for of Him and through Him and to Him are all things, to whom be glory forever (Rom. 11:36)! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest (Matt. 21:9)!

Jesus Christ, His name Immanuel, which is translated, God with us (Matt. 1:23). In Christ (John 15:4), the One God loved before the foundation of the world (John 17:24), according to the faith of God's elect (Titus 1:1) we pray (James 5:16) that you believe in the name of the only begotten Son of God (John 3:18), for His name is to be feared among the nations (Mal. 1:14), all peoples of the earth will know His name and fear Him (1 Kings 8:43)! According to His own purpose and grace which was given to you in *Christ Jesus* before time began (2 Tim 1:9), according to the measure of *Christ's* gift (Eph. 4:7) and His new covenant (Heb. 8:13), and His riches in glory (Phil 4:19) may you and your family (Acts 13:26) put on *Christ* (Gal. 3:27). For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ (Gal. 3:27). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls (1 Per. 2:25) the Great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant (Heb. 12:20), the firstborn of all creation (Col. 1:15), the image of the invisible God (Col. 1:15), He who is before all things, for through Him all things exist (Col. 1:17), all things were created through Him and for Him (Col. 1:16), by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers (Col. 1:16), Him who sits at the right hand of the Majesty on high (Heb. 1:3), the Dayspring (the dawn of the morning) from on high (Luke 1:78), all things are under His feet (Eph. 1:22), therefore in His holy name (Ps. 33:21, Jesus Christ, Him who upholds all things by the word of His power (Heb. 1:3), for He has by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than the angels of God (Heb. 1:4), we ask our God and Father (Phil. 4:20) to grant (1 Sam. 1:17) that you and your people clothe yourself in *Christ Jesus* (Gal. 3:26-28), and in the word, and in faith, walking by faith and not by sight (2 Cor. 5:7). It is written: "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God (John 1:1)." "And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth (John 1:14)." Let us praise Your Name for Your lovingkindness and Your truth; for You, O Lord, have magnified Your word above all Your name (Ps, 138:2)! The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make His face shine upon you, and be gracious to you; the Lord lift up His countenance upon you, and give you peace, put His name on you and your children and bless you (Num. 6:24-27). To you and all your family (Acts 13:26), to all those who are sanctified in *Christ Jesus*, called to be saints, with all who in every place call on

the name of **Jesus Christ our Lord**, both theirs and ours: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Cor. 1:2-3). The grace of the *Lord Jesus* Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all (2 cor. 13:14). Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the *Lord Jesus Christ*. Blessed be the God and Father of our *Lord Jesus Christ*, who has blessed you with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in *Christ*, just as He chose you in Him before the foundation of the world, that you should be holy and without blame before Him in love, having predestined you and your children to adoption as sons by **Jesus Christ** to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He has made you and your children accepted in the Beloved (Eph. 1:2-6). According to the faith of God's elect and the acknowledgment of the truth which is according to Godliness, in hope of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began, to you: Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Savior (Titus 1:1-4). Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of *Jesus* our Lord, as His divine power has given to you all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called you and your children by glory and virtue, by which have been given to you exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you and your children may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust (2 Pet. 1:2-4). Now may the Lord of peace Himself give you peace always in every way. The Lord be with you all. The grace of our **Lord Jesus Christ** be with you all (2 Thess. 3:16-18).

The Lord has made known His salvation; His righteousness He has openly shown in the sight of the nations (Ps. 98:2). You, O Lord, have established equity; You have executed justice and righteousness (Ps. 99:4)! Your righteousness is an everlasting righteousness, and Your law is truth (Ps. 119:142); the righteousness of Your testimonies is everlasting (Ps. 119:144)! You, O Lord, love righteousness and justice; the earth is full of all Your goodness (Ps. 33:5)! Also, your righteousness, O God, is very high, You who have done great things; O God, who is like You (Ps. 71:19)? Your righteousness is like the great mountains, your judgments are a great deep; O Lord, You preserve man and beast. How precious is Your loving-kindness, O God! Therefore, the children of men put their trust under the shadow of Your wings (Ps. 36:6-7). In the name that is above all other names (Eph. 2:4-5), *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), our buckler (Ps. 18:2), our high tower (Ps. 18:2), a sure foundation (Is. 28:16), a tried stone (Is. 28:16), a precious corner stone (Is. 28:16), author of eternal life (Heb. 5:9), King eternal, immortal, invisible (1 Tim. 1:17), our Glory (Jer. 2:11), our Maker (Job 35:10), the

author and finisher of our faith (Heb. 12:2), He who searches the minds and hearts (Rev. 2:23), may the Apostle and High Priest of our confession *Christ Jesus* (Heb. 3:1), clothe you and your people with the garments of salvation, cover you with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorns herself with his jewels (Is. 61:10-11). For as the earth brings forth its bud, as the garden causes the things that are sown in it to spring forth, so the Lord God will cause righteousness and praise to spring forth before all the nations (Is. 61:11).

Praise the Lord, O, our soul (Ps. 146:1)! Bless His holy name (Ps. 103:2)! Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord; peace in heaven and glory in the highest (Luke 19:38)! For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; and the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of His government and peace there will be no end, upon the throne of your heart and over His kingdom, to order it and establish it with judgment and justice from this time forward, even forever. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this (Is. 9:6-7). Let us sing praise to the *Christ of God* (Luke 9:20), Jesus Christ, that name which is above all names (Eph. 1:21, Philip.2:9); He who is the captain of the Lord's host (Josh. 5:15), the beloved Son (Pet. 1:17), called Faithful and True (Rev. 19:11), the firstborn from the dead (Col. 1:18), the Just One (Acts 3:14, 7:52), the High Priest over the house of God (Heb. 10:21), the covenant of the people (Is. 42:6), our advocate with the Father (1 John 2:11), our crown of glory (ls. 28:5), our diadem of beauty (ls. 28:5), a royal diadem in the hand of God (Is. 62:3), He who lives, and was dead, and behold, he lives forevermore (Rev. 1:18), He who by Himself purged our sins (Heb. 1:3), and signs and wonders may be done by you through the name of God's holy Servant Jesus (Acts 4:29-30). In Christ (John 15:4) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your people will believe in the name of **Jesus Christ** (Mark 16:17) and you will follow Him, and these signs will follow you: In His name, Jesus Christ, you will cast out demons; you will speak with new tongues; you will take up serpents; and if you drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt you; you will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover (Mark 16:17-18). It is written: "You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My Name He may give you (John 15:16). His name, Jesus Christ, be magnified forever (2 Sam. 7:26), all peoples of the earth will know His name and fear Him (1 Kings 8:43); He is the Lord of glory (1 Cor. 2:8), appointed heir of all things (Heb. 1:2), raised from the dead and seated at the right hand of God in the heavenly places (Eph. 1:20), our Deliverer (Rom. 11:26), our great High Priest, who has passed through the heavens

(Heb. 4:14), the true Light which gives light to every man who comes into the world (John 1:9), an everlasting light (Is. 60:19) our merciful and faithful High Priest (Heb. 2:17), the ruler over the kings of the earth (Rev. :5-6), the Holy One (Luke 1:35), He who was ordained by God to be Judge of the living and the dead (Acts 10:42), KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS (Rev. 19:16), the first, and the last; and beside Him there is no God (Is. 44:6. Let His name be magnified throughout the whole earth (Acts 19:17)!

In likeness of Melchizedek, He arose as High priest who came according to the power of an endless life (Heb. 7:16), because He, Jesus Christ, continues forever, He has an unchangeable Priesthood (Heb. 7:24), as a Son over His own house, whose house you and your family (Acts 13:26) are if you hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm to the end (Heb. 3:6). He who is able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him (Heb. 7:25), He who lives to make intercession for us (Heb. 7:25), in His name, Jesus Christ (John 16:23), a High Priest, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and has become higher than the heavens (Heb. 7:26), who offered up Himself as a sacrifice, once for all (Heb. 7:27), the Son who has been perfected forever (Heb. 7:28), appointed High Priest by the word of the oath of God (Heb. 7:28), a Minister of the sanctuary and the true tabernacle which the Lord erected (Heb. 8:1), the Lord Most High (Ps. 7:17), Lord of both the dead and the living (Rom. 14:9), the Lord of the harvest (Matt. 9:38), Lord even of the Sabbath (Matt.12:8), the Messenger of the covenant (Mal. 3:1), the Messiah (John 1:41) for God the Father has set His seal on Him (John 6:27), our Master (2 Tim. 2:21), He gives aid to the seed of Abraham (Heb. 2:16), which you are, and being tempted, He is able to aid those who are tempted (Heb. 2:18). To Him who is counted worthy of more glory than Moses (Heb. 3:3), O King of the nations (Jer. 10:7), King of the saints (Rev. 15:3), to Him who is true (1 John 5:20), called Faithful and True (Rev. 19:11) we give thanks (2 Sam. 22:50). Jesus Christ, He who came as High Priest of the greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with human hands (Heb. 9:11), with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place, once for all, having obtained eternal redemption, who through the eternal Spirit, offered Himself without spot to God (Heb. 9:14), who has entered the holy places of heaven to appear in the presence of God for you (Heb. 9:24) and all your people (Ps. 148:14). He, *Jesus Christ*, who, appeared, to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself (Heb. 9:26), who sits at the right hand of God (Heb. 10:12), who by one offering has perfected forever those who are being sanctified (Heb. 10:14) and His enemies are made His footstool (Heb. 10:13). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God (Heb. 12:2), who abolished death, and brought

life and immortality to light through the gospel (2 Tim. 1:10), whom God set forth, to be a propitiation by His blood, through faith (Rom. 3:25), who gave Himself for you and your family (Acts 13:26), that He might redeem you from every lawless deed (Titus 2:14), who gave Himself for you and your people, that He might purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works (Titus 2:14), yes in His glorious and awesome name (Deut. 28:58) let you be one with Him and one with God (John 17:21), **Christ** in you and you in **Christ** (John 15:4) for He gives you the glory which God gave Him, that you may be one just as He and God are one, that you may be made perfect in one (John 17:22-23).

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God (Rev. 3:14), holy and true (Rev. 6:10), for just and true are His works (Rev. 15:3), just and true are His ways (Rev. 15:3), true and righteous are His judgments (Rev. 16:7) for He is called faithful and true (Rev. 19:11), He who is holy, He who is true, He who has the key of David, He who opens and no one shuts, and shuts and no one opens (Rev. 3:7), for it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell (Col. 1:19), for in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily (Col. 2:9), yes in His holy name (Ps. 33:21) we bless (Deut. 10:8) you. Jesus Christ, King of glory (Ps. 24:7), righteous Judge (2 Tim. 4:8), holy Servant (Acts 4:27), the faithful witness (Rev. :5-6), He who sits on the throne (Rev. 5:13), He who is ready to judge the living and the dead (1 Pet. 4:5), he who has the keys of Hades and of Death (Rev. 1:18), He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars (Rev. 3:1), He who is from the beginning (1 John 2:13), the First and the Last, who was dead, and came to life (Rev. 2:8), he is *Christ*, the chosen of God (Luke 23:35), the rod out of the stem of Jesse, the Branch that grew out of his roots (Is. 11:1), the righteous Branch (Jer. 23:5), the breath of the Almighty (Job 33:4), through whom also God made the worlds (Heb. 1:2) and he is our bridegroom (Matt. 9:15). Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord; peace in heaven and glory in the highest (Luke 19:38)!

The Lord, the Holy One (Ezek. 39:7), let us praise the name of the Lord our God, who has dealt wondrously with us (Joel 2:26), let us walk in the name of the Lord our God forever and ever (Mic. 4:5). He is great to the ends of the earth (Mic. 5:4), majesty to the name of the Lord (Mic. 5:4)! Let you trust in the name of the Lord (Zeph. 3:12), King over all the earth (Zech. 14:9), His name One (Zech. 14:9) for His name is great in might (Jer. 10:6) there is none like Him (Jer. 10:7); know that His name is the Lord (Jer. 16:21), THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS (Jer. 23:6), the Great, the Mighty God, whose name is the Lord of hosts (Jer. 32:18). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), His name is exalted (Is. 12:4), the desire of our soul is for His name and for the remembrance of Him, let us trust in the name of the Lord and rely

upon our God (is. 50:10), let us love the name of the Lord (is. 56:6-7), let us fear the name of the Lord from the west, and His glory from the rising of the sun (ls. 59:19), let us glorify His name forevermore (Ps. 86:12), in His name we rejoice all day long (Ps. 89:16), the glory of our strength (Ps. 89:16). His great and awesome name (Ps. 99:3). Nations shall fear the name of the Lord (Ps. 102:15), praise the name of the Lord (Ps. 113:1), blessed be the name of the Lord from this time forth and forevermore; from the rising of the sun to its going down; the Lord's name is to be praised (Ps. 113:2-6). To His name give glory, because of His mercy, and because of His truth (Ps. 115:1). Through His name you will trample those who rise up against you (Ps. 44:5), through Him you and your house will push down your enemies (Ps. 44:5). Those who know His name will put their trust in Him (Ps.9:10) for His name shall endure forever; His name shall continue as long as the sun (Ps 72:17); all nations shall call Him blessed (Ps 72:17). Blessed be His glorious name forever (Ps 72:19); let the whole earth be filled with His glory (Ps 72:19) for His wondrous works declare that His name is near (Ps 75-1). You and your people are justified by faith in **Jesus Christ** (Gal. 2:16), in whom new creation avails (Gal. 6:15), by His blood you are made near (Eph. 2:13) for He Himself is your peace (Eph. 2:14), Himself being the chief cornerstone (Eph. 2:20) as the truth is in Him (Eph. 4:21) who delivers you from the wrath to come (1 Thess. 1:10). He only is your hope (1 Tim. 1:1), your savior (Titus 1:4), your surety of a better covenant (Heb. 7:22), the Lord of glory (James 2:1), your Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 2:20).

May the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness reign in your life through the One, <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 5:17), so that grace might reign through righteousness to eternal life through <u>Jesus Christ Your Lord</u> (Rom. 5:21), for your gift from God is eternal life in <u>Christ Jesus our Lord</u> (Rom. 6:23). To you who are sanctified in <u>Christ Jesus</u> (1 Cor. 1:2), who became for you wisdom from God and righteousness and sanctification and redemption (1 Cor. 1:30), for no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is <u>Jesus Christ</u> (1 Cor. 3:11) for you are washed, you are sanctified, you are justified in the name of the <u>Lord Jesus</u> and by the Spirit of our God (1 Cor. 6:11), through whom are all things, and through whom we live (1 Cor. 8:6). Praise be to His name, <u>Jesus Christ</u>, for though He was rich, yet for our sakes He became poor, that we through His poverty might become rich (2 Cor. 8:9).

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), the Son of the Highest (Luke 1:32), the Prince of Life (Acts 3:15), the chief cornerstone (Luke 20:17), the Son of Man which has come to seek and to save that which was lost (Luke 19:10), the true Light (John 1:9) for in him is life and life is the light of men (John 1:4), He being the light of the world (John 8:12), the bread of life (John 6:48),

the living bread which came down from heaven (John 6:41), the resurrection and the life (John 11:25), the true vine (John 15:1), not of this world (John 8:23), but from God and sent by God (John 7:29), Teacher and Lord (John 13:13), the great I AM (John 8:58), a quickening spirit (1 Cor.15:45), in His name the blessing of the Lord be upon you.

In the name (John 16:23) of **Jesus Christ of Nazareth** (Acts 3:6) (John 16:23), His only begotten Son, by the precious blood of *Christ*, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world (John 1:29), through whom grace and truth came (John 1:17), declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness (Rom. 1:3), God's Holy Servant (Acts 4:27), a man attested by God (Acts 2:22), in His glorious name (1 Chr. 29:13) may you and your family (Acts 13:26) have peace through Jesus Christ, for He is Lord of all (Acts 10:36) and let you take up the cup of salvation, and call upon the name of the Lord (Ps. 116:13). Thanks to the name of the Lord (Ps. 122:4) for our help is in the name of the Lord, who made heaven and earth (Ps. 124:8). All flesh shall bless His holy name forever and ever (Ps. 145:21)! Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! The King of Israel (John 12:13). And we know that the Son of God has come and has given us an understanding, that we may know Him who is true; and we are in Him who is true, in His **Son Jesus Christ**. This is the true God and eternal life (1 John 5:20). God created all things through Jesus Christ (Eph. 3:9) and His name is remembered in all generations (Ps. 45:17) for He is the Desire of all Nations (Hag. 2:7), there is no other Rock (Is. 44:8). Grace, mercy, and peace will be with you from God the Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love (2 John 1:3). Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers (3 John 1:2). Mercy, peace, and love be multiplied to you and all your people (Jude 1:2). The blessing of the Lord be upon you; We bless you in the name of the Lord (Ps. 129:8)! We call on our God and Father in the name above all names (Philip. 2:9), *Jesus Christ*, saying, "Oh, that You would bless your child indeed, and enlarge your servant's territory, that Your hand would be with your beloved and his house (1 Chr. 4:10), keep him as the apple of your eye (Ps. 17:8) and that You would keep him from evil, that he may not cause pain (1 Chron. 4:10))! For do you not know that you are the apple of His eye? Mercy surround you; be glad in the Lord and rejoice and shout for joy and mercy shall surround you (Ps. 32:10-11) and your family (Acts 13:26)! Grace to you and all your people and peace from God our Father and the *Lord Jesus Christ*. I thank my God upon every remembrance of you, always in prayer making request for you all with joy, giving thanks for your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now (Phil. 1:2-5) and for the hope which is laid up for you in heaven

(Col. 1:2-6). To you and all your family (Acts 13:26), the saints and faithful brethren in *Christ*: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the *Lord Jesus Christ*. By the will of God, according to the promise of life which is in *Christ Jesus*, by the commandment of God our Savior and the *Lord Jesus Christ*, our hope, to you: Grace, mercy, and peace from God our Father and *Jesus Christ our Lord* (2 Tim. 1:1-3) and God grant that you grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior *Jesus Christ*. To Him be the glory both now and forever (2 Peter 3:18)! The Lord bless you out of Zion, and may you see the good of Jerusalem all the days of your life. Yes, may you see your children's children. Peace be upon Israel (Ps. 128:5-6)! It is like the dew of Hermon, descending upon the mountains of Zion; for there the Lord commanded the blessing Life forevermore (Ps, 133:3). Praise the name of the Lord (Ps. 113:1)! Let the Lord be magnified (Ps. 35:27)!

Led by the Spirit of God (Rom. 8:14), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), your house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21) and all of your people (Ps. 148:14); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time (Is. 9:7, Is. 59:21) so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Judges 18:6, Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Thess. 5:23). In the name of Jesus Christ, the Shepherd and Overseer of our souls (1 Per. 2:25), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (ls. 61:2)! In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. God said it. We believe it. It is settled forever. In Jesus' name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! Amen!
