A Prayer for President and First Lady of the Republic of the United States of America, and all the leaders of the world, from the least to the greatest, taken from the collection of Prayers for

the Precious. As a fellow worker in <u>Christ Jesus</u> (Rom. 16;3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), we lift the leaders of the world up. God is good. His mercy endures forever. God is good to all your people for the Lord God is faithful, who will establish you and guard *you* from the evil one. Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom comes into their heart. Your will be done in their life on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), *Jesus Christ*, we give thanks to the Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), for the leaders that God has raised up and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that *Christ* might make known to you the riches of His glory, we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall for you and your bloodline and all your house (Ezek. 13:5). In the name of *Jesus Christ*, we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). The words that *Christ* through us speak are spirit and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord *Jesus Christ* (1 Cor. 15:57)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> of Nazareth (John 16:23), by the precious blood of <u>Christ</u>, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the Father in heaven the Lord lift His countenance upon you and give you peace (Num. 6:26)! For the Lord is righteous, He loves righteousness; His countenance beholds the upright (Ps. 11:7). Hear our prayer, O Lord, give ear to our supplications! In Your faithfulness answer us, and in Your righteousness (Ps. 132:1)! By awesome deeds in righteousness, You will answer us, O God of our salvation, you who are the confidence of all the ends of the earth, and of the far-off seas (Ps. 65:5)! We don't come to the Father based on our own worthiness or on your worthiness, but by

Jesus Christ, whose sandal strap we are not worthy to loosen (John 1:27). Abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), we come before God's mercy seat on the merits of His Son, Jesus Christ, and the precious blood that He shed (1 Pet. 1:19), for worthy is the lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and blessing (Rev 5:12)! In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), as a Son over His own house, whose house you are if you hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm to the end (Heb. 3:6). As a fellow worker in **Christ Jesus** (Rom. 16;3), abiding in Him (John 15:4-5), and one with Him (John 17:22), we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for you and your entire house, all of your people, on every side, all of your family, all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time, all those by adoption, and all those by marriage, all your natural seed and all of your spiritual seed. Grace be with you all (Titus 3:15)! Mercy and truth have met together; righteousness and peace have kissed each other! Truth shall spring out of the earth, and righteousness shall look down from heaven! Yes, the Lord will give what is good; and your land will yield its increase! Righteousness will go before Him and shall make His footsteps your pathway (Ps. 85:10-13)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 5:17), so in His name let you stand therefore, having put on the <u>breastplate of</u> <u>righteousness</u> (Eph. 6:10-20). For He (God) in His infinite wisdom made Him who knew no sin to be sin for you, so that you might become the righteousness of God through Him, <u>Jesus Christ</u> (2 Cor. 5:21), your savior, your redeemer, your life and your resurrection (John 11:25). In His righteousness you are exalted. He is the glory of your strength, and in His favor your horn is exalted (Ps. 89:16-17). God, who delights in exercising loving-kindness, judgment, and righteousness in the earth (Jer. 9:24), is upright; He is your rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him (Ps... 92:15)! The Lord, your God, will never forget you, you have been inscribed on the palms of His hands (Is. 9:16). He will never leave you, nor forsake you (Duet. 31:6). He will dwell in you and walk among you (2 Cor. 6:16). Even to the end of the age,

(Heb. 13:5). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that the Lord will impute righteousness to you (Rom. 4:11), that it will overtake you (ls. 59:9), and He who makes justice the measuring line, and righteousness the plum line (ls. 28:17); He will not rest until your righteousness goes forth as brightness (Is. 62:1), and you wear the crown of righteousness, which the Lord will give to you on the Day of Christ (2 Tim. 4:8). The Lord has called you in righteousness and will hold your hand (ls. 42:6-9). Surely, in the Lord you have righteousness and strength. Surely, in the Lord you and all your descendants shall be justified and shall glory (ls. 45:24-25)! In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that God in His mercy (Ps. 143:12) will put a hunger and thirst in you for righteousness, for blessed is he who hungers and thirst for righteousness, for he shall be filled. The Lord is exalted, for He dwells on high, truly, He will fill you with justice and righteousness (ls. 33:5.). Let you seek first the kingdom of God, and all other things will be added to you (Matt. 6:33). For the Kingdom of God is not what you eat or drink, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit (Rom. 14:17). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will commit your way to the Lord, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass. He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, and your justice as the noonday (Ps. 37:5-6). May you receive blessing from the Lord, and righteousness from the God of your salvation (Ps. 24:5). The Lord is your Shepherd you shall not want. He restores your soul; so that you may walk in the way of goodness and keep to the paths of righteousness (Prov. 2:20), follow righteousness and mercy, in the midst of the paths of justice (Prov. 8:20), and find life, righteousness and honor (Prov. 21:21), for righteousness delivers from death (Prov. 10:2). Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; a scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom (Ps. 45:6)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), who became for you wisdom from God and righteousness and sanctification and redemption (1 Cor. 1:30), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS (Jer. 23:6) will lead you and establish you (Prov. 25:5) in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake (Ps. 23:3). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we petition the Lord to open to you the gates of righteousness; and in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and all your loved ones will go through them (Ps. 118:19-21), offering the sacrifices of righteousness,

putting your trust in the Lord (Ps. 4:5). May the Lord lead you in righteousness and make your way straight before your face (Ps. 5:8), and for His righteousness' sake, revive you (Ps. 119:40), and bring your soul out of trouble (Ps. 143:11). The One who sits on the throne of mercy in truth, judging and seeking justice and hastening righteousness (ls. 16:5), He guards the paths of justice, and preserves the way of His saints. You are one of His saints (Rom. 1:7). He will make you understand righteousness and justice, equity and every good path (Prov. 2:8-9). For the mercy of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting on those who fear Him, and His righteousness to children's children (Ps. 103:17). The Lord executes righteousness and justice for all who are oppressed (Ps. 103:6). The Lord will raise you up in righteousness, and He will direct all your ways (ls. 45:13); your work will be peace, and the effect of your righteousness, quietness and assurance forever (ls. 32:17). Your peace will be like a river, and your righteousness like the waves of the sea (Is. 48:18). Then your light shall break forth like the morning, your healing shall spring forth speedily, and your righteousness shall go before you: the glory of the Lord shall be your rear guard (Is. 58:8). No weapon formed against you shall prosper and every tongue that rises up against you in judgment, you shall condemn, for you are servants of God, not only servants but also children of God (John 1:12), and your righteousness is from Him (ls. 54:17). You shall be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified (ls. 61:3). Do not hide His righteousness within your heart (Ps. 40:10), let your mouth tell of His righteousness and His salvation (Ps. 71:15), declare His faithfulness, loving-kindness and truth (Ps. 40:10), and let your tongue speak of His Word (Ps. 119:172) sing aloud of His righteousness (Ps. 51:14), and sing praise to the name of the Lord (Ps. 7:17) all the day long (Ps. 35:28)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), He who is before all things (Col. 1:17), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in righteousness and true holiness (Eph. 4:22:24). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will flee also youthful lusts; instead

pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, gentleness (1 Tim. 6:11, 2 Tim. 2:22), and peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart, sanctifying the Lord God in your hearts (1 Pet. 3:15-16). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will be quick to confess your sins, for He is faithful and just to forgive you your sins and to cleanse you from all unrighteousness (2 John 1:9). Let us pray to God, and He will delight in you, you shall see His face with joy, for He restores to man His righteousness (Job 33:26). God revealed the righteousness of God which is through faith in <u>Jesus Christ</u>, to you and being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in **Christ Jesus**, God has passed over the sins that were previously committed, to demonstrate at the present time His righteousness, that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in **<u>Jesus</u>** (Rom. 3:22-26). **<u>Christ</u>**, Himself, bore your sins in His own body on the tree, that you, who having died to sins, might live for righteousness (1 Pet. 2:24), presenting yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, submitted to the righteousness of God (Rom. 10:3), instruments of righteousness (Rom 6:13), obedient to righteousness (Rom. 6:16), and becoming slaves of righteousness (Rom. 6:18) for holiness sake (Rom. 6:19). Having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust, in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will awake to righteousness (1 Cor. 15:34), obtaining the precious faith by the righteousness of our God and Savior **Jesus Christ** (2 pet. 1:1), for with the heart one believes to righteousness (Rom. 10:10). Becoming an heir of righteousness which is according to faith (Heb. 11:7), believing the gospel of *Christ*, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, and believing on Him who justifies the ungodly; your faith is accounted for righteousness (Rom. 4:5). For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith." (Rom 1:17). Let the heavens declare His righteousness, for God Himself is Judge (Ps. 50:6)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), in whom grace might reign through righteousness to eternal life (Rom. 5:21), now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness (2 Cor. 9:10). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we

pray that you will sow for yourselves righteousness (Prov. 11:18); reap in mercy; break up your fallow ground, for it is time to seek the Lord, follow after righteousness (ls. 51:1), till He comes and rains righteousness on you and your house (Hosea 10:12). Let justice run down like water, and righteousness like a mighty stream (Amos 5:24). Rain down, You heavens, from above, and let the skies pour down righteousness; let the earth open, let them bring forth salvation, and let righteousness spring up together (Is. 45:8). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we beg of you, seek righteousness, seek humility (Zep. 2:3); and may God purify you, purge you as gold and silver (Mal. 3:3), bring you forth to the light (Mic. 7:9), that you may offer to the Lord an offering in righteousness (Mal. 3:3). God grant that you, being delivered from the hand of your enemies, might serve Him without fear, in holiness and righteousness before Him all the days of your life, walking before Him in truth, in righteousness, and in uprightness of heart (1 Kin. 3:6), seeking His glory and no unrighteousness be in you (John 7:18). O Lord, righteousness belongs to You, but to us shame of face (Dan. 9:7), for our righteousness is but filthy rags. Nevertheless, let you not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but be strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He has promised He is also able to perform (Rom. 4:20-22). For we through the Spirit eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness by faith (Gal. 5:5). According to all His righteousness, in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (Dan. 9:16), that the Father of righteousness (Prov. 23:24) will help you to keep justice and do righteousness; let His salvation come to you, and His righteousness be revealed to you (ls. 56:1). His righteousness is near it shall not be far off; His salvation shall not linger (ls. 46:23). May Jehovah-Tsidkenu, the Lord your righteousness (Jer. 23:6), make you walk uprightly, work righteousness, speak the truth in your hearts (Ps. 15:2), be skilled in the word of righteousness, eat the solid food of the Word, which belongs to those who are of full age, having your senses exercised to discern both good and evil (Heb. 5:13-14), sowing the fruit of righteousness in peace and declaring righteousness (Prov. 12:17). For if *Christ* is in you, the body is dead because of sin, but the Spirit is life because of righteousness (Rom. 8:10). For as the earth brings forth its bud, as the garden causes the things that are sown in it to spring forth,

so the Lord God will cause righteousness and praise to spring forth before all the nations (ls. 61:11).

But of Him you are in *Christ Jesus*, who became for you wisdom from God and righteousness and sanctification and redemption (1 Cor. 1:30); so in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray, in the name of **Jesus** (John 16:23) that you and all of your people will receive the abundance of grace and the gift of righteousness, which is through faith in *Christ*, the righteousness which is from God by faith (Phil. 3:9), and righteousness will reign in your life through the One, **Jesus Christ** (Rom. 5:17), fulfilling all righteousness (Matt. 3:15). Put on righteousness, and it will cloth you; your justice will be like a robe and a turban (Job 29:14). You shall shine like the brightness of the firmament, and turn many to righteousness like the stars forever and ever (Dan. 12:3). For God Almighty, High and Lofty One Who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy (ls. 57:15), has known you, in order that you may command your children and your household after you, that they keep the way of the Lord, to do righteousness and justice (Gen. 18:19). Let you disperse abroad, give to the poor (Ps. 112:9), be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath (James 1:19), keep justice, do righteousness at all times (Ps. 106:30), fear the Lord (Ps. 112:3), and by your spirit within you seek God early and learn righteousness (ls. 26:9), so that your work is honorable and glorious, and your righteousness endures forever (Ps. 111:3). Your horn will be exalted with honor (Ps. 112:9); wealth and riches will be in your house (Ps. 112:3); riches and honor will be with you, enduring riches and righteousness (Prov. 8:18). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will hold fast to your righteousness, you will not let it go; your heart shall not reproach you as long as you live (Job 27:6). Blessed be the Lord your God, who delights in you (1 Kin. 10;9), repaying you for your righteousness and your faithfulness (1 Sam. 26:23); He will reward you according to your righteousness; according to the cleanness of your hands He will recompense you (2 Sam. 22:21). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray you will see His face in righteousness; you shall be satisfied when you awake in His likeness (Ps. 17:15); being accepted by Him (Acts 10:35), who is Faithful and True (Rev. 19:11), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29). The Lord of hosts shall be exalted in judgment, and God who is holy shall be hallowed in righteousness (ls.

5:16); for His salvation will be forever, and His righteousness will not be abolished (ls. 51:6)!

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the Branch of righteousness (Jer. 23:5), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the God of righteousness (Ps. 4:1) to deliver you in His righteousness, so that you will never be ashamed. (Ps. 31:1); and cause you to escape; may He incline His ear to you, and save you (Ps. 71:2). In His abundant mercy (1 Pet. 1:3), the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ has vindicated you (Ps. 35:24), for He has begotten you again to a living hope through the resurrection of **Jesus Christ** from the dead, to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you, who are kept by the power of God through (1 Pet. 1:3-5) the righteousness of faith (Rom. 4:13). According to His own righteousness (Ps. 35:24), let Him make your way blameless (Prov. 13:6), convict you of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment (John 16:8), giving you righteous lips that are to His delight (Prov. 16:13); and you shall go in the strength of the Lord God; and make mention of His righteousness, of His only (Ps. 71:16). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that He will betroth you to Him in righteousness and justice, in loving-kindness and mercy; betroth you and all of your people to Him in faithfulness, and you shall know the Lord (Hosea 2:19-20). Let you seek Him daily, and delight to know His ways, take delight in approaching Him (ls. 58:2), and be found in the way of righteousness (Prov. 16:31). Oh, continue Your loving-kindness to those who know You, and Your righteousness to the upright in heart, O Lord (Ps. 36:10)! And this in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray, that your love may abound still more and more in knowledge and all discernment, that you may approve the things that are excellent, that you may be sincere and without offense till the day of *Christ*, being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by **Jesus Christ**, to the glory and praise of God (Phi. 1:9-11). God, who has given to you that indescribable (2 Cor. 9:13) gift of righteousness (Rom. 5:17, Phil. 3:9), is your God, in truth and righteousness (Zec. 8:8). May the Lord bless you (Num. 6:24), and give His angels charge over you to keep you and all of your people in righteousness (Ps. 91: 11); train you by gentle chastening, that afterward you yield the peaceable fruit of righteousness, as righteousness leads to life (Prov. 11:19); in

the way of righteousness is life, and in its pathway there is no death (Prov. 12:28). Righteousness shall exalt you (Prov. 14:34); the Lord loves him who follows righteousness (Prov. 15:9); to do righteousness and justice is more acceptable to the Lord than sacrifice (Prov. 21:3). The righteousness of the upright will deliver him (Prov. 11:6), the righteousness of the righteous shall be upon himself (Ezek. 18:20), and his righteousness shall answer for him (Gen. 30:33). God will judge you according to your righteousness, and according to your integrity within you (Ps. 7:8). Let your house be full of justice; righteousness shall lodge in it (ls. 1:21). Let it be called the house of righteousness, the faithful house (ls. 1:26). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness? (2 Cor. 6:14). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray you will execute judgment and righteousness, and deliver the plundered out of the hand of the oppressor. Do no wrong and do no violence to the stranger, the fatherless, or the widow, nor shed innocent blood (Jer. 22:3). You shall do no injustice in judgment. You shall not be partial to the poor, nor honor the person of mighty. But in righteousness you shall judge your neighbor (Lev. 19:15). But judgment will return to righteousness, and all the upright in heart will follow it (Ps. 94:15). Hear in heaven, and act and judge Your servants, condemning the wicked, bringing his way on his head, and justifying the righteous by giving him according to his righteousness (1 Kin. 8:32)! For He is coming, for He is coming to judge the earth! He shall judge the world with righteousness, and the peoples with equity (Ps. 98:9) and his truth (Ps. 96:13)! The heavens declare His righteousness, and all the peoples see His glory (Ps. 97:6)! According to Your name, O God, so is Your praise to the ends of the earth; Your right hand is full of righteousness (Ps. 48:10)!

The Lord has made known His salvation; His righteousness He has openly shown in the sight of the nations (Ps. 98:2). You, O Lord, have established equity; You have executed justice and righteousness (Ps. 99:4). Your righteousness is an everlasting righteousness, and Your law is truth (Ps. 119:142); the righteousness of Your testimonies is everlasting (Ps. 119:144). You, O Lord, love righteousness and justice; the earth is full of all Your goodness (Ps. 33:5)! Also, your righteousness, O

God, is very high. You who have done great things; O God, who is like You (Ps. 71:19)? Your righteousness is like the great mountains, your judgments are a great deep; O Lord, you preserve man and beast. How precious is your lovingkindness, O God! Therefore, the children of men put their trust under the shadow of Your wings (Ps. 36:6-7). Your delight is in the fear of the Lord, and You shall not judge by the sight of Your eyes, nor decide by the hearing of Your ears; but with righteousness You shall judge the poor, and decide with equity for the meek of the earth; You shall strike the earth with the rod of your mouth, and with the breath of You lips You shall slay the wicked. Righteousness shall be the belt of Your loins, and faithfulness the belt of Your waist (ls. 11:3-5). Clouds and darkness surround You (Ps. 97:2). Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne; mercy and truth go before Your face (Ps. 89:4). A fire goes before You, and burns up Your enemies round about (Ps. 94:3)! Let us meditate on the glorious splendor of Your majesty, and on Your wondrous works! Let us speak of the might of Your awesome acts, and we will declare Your greatness! We shall utter the memory of Your great goodness, and shall sing of Your righteousness (Ps. 145:5-7)! The Lord lives, in truth, in judgment, and in righteousness; the nations shall bless themselves in Him and in Him they shall glory (Jer. 4:2)! You shall bless yourselves in Him and in Him you shall glory! Let the heavens declare His righteousness (Ps. 50:6). Sing to Him a new song; play skillfully with a shout of joy! For the word of the Lord is right, and all His work is done in truth. He loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of the goodness of the Lord. By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth. He gathers the waters of the sea together as a heap; He lays up the deep in storehouses. Let all the earth fear the Lord; let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him! For He spoke, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast (Ps. 33:3-9)!

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline, your house and all of your people; by the blood of the lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify

your time so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space by the overpowering presence of God, who has made his home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Thess. 5:23). As a vessel of honor (Rom. 9:21), we continue petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to you according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to you (Luke 11:9). In Your name we rejoice all day long, and in Your righteousness, we are exalted! For You are the glory of our strength, and in Your favor our horn is exalted! For our shield belongs to the Lord, and we belong to our King, to the Holy One of Israel (Ps. 89:16-18)! In *Jesus'* (John 16:23) name so be it! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever!
