As a fellow worker in **Christ Jesus** (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), we lift the leaders of the world up. God is good. His mercy endures forever. God is good to all your people for the Lord God is faithful, who will establish you and guard *you* from the evil one. Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come into their heart. Your will be done in their life on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), **Jesus Christ**, we give thanks to the Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), for the leaders that God has raised up and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that **Christ** might make known to you the riches of His glory, we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall for you and your bloodline and all your house (Ezek. 13:5). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). The words that **Christ** through us speak are spirit and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord **Jesus Christ** (1 Cor. 15:57)!

As a fellow worker in **Christ Jesus** (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for you and your bloodline and your entire house, all of your people, on every side, all of your family, all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time, all those by adoption, and all those by marriage, all your natural seed and all of your spiritual seed. Peace to you, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord **Jesus Christ**. Grace be with all those who love our Lord **Jesus Christ** in sincerity (Eph. 6:23-24). In the name of **Jesus Christ** of Nazareth (John 16:23), who delivers us from the wrath to come (1 Thess. 1:10), by the precious blood of **Christ**, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), may the God of truth (Ps. 31:5, Deut. 32:4, Is. 65:16) enlarge and increase your ability to hear, understand and obey the word of God (Rom. 10:17), to believe that with God all things are possible (Matt. 19:26), to know in your hearts and believe in your minds the truth of the Word of the Lord, for the word of the Lord is proven (2

Sam. 22:31), pure (Ps. 12:6), and it endures forever (1 Pet. 1:25). We have called upon You, for You will hear us, O God; Incline Your ear to us, and hear our speech. Show Your marvelous loving-kindness by Your right hand, O You who save those who trust in You from those who rise up against them (Ps. 17:6-7). The word of God is living and powerful, quick and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that the word of God shall pierce your hearts and touch your souls (Luke 2:35). According to Your name, O God (Ps. 48:10), may the God of our **Lord Jesus Christ**, the Father of glory (Eph. 1:17), pour out on your house the Spirit of grace and supplication (Zech. 12:10). Let your heart (Ps. 73:1) cry out to God (Ps. 55:17), let you mourn (Zech. 12:12) for **Jesus** the **Christ** (Acts 9:34), as one mourns for his only son, and grieve for Him as one grieves for his firstborn (Zech. 2:10). By awesome deeds in righteousness He will answer you, O God of our salvation, You who are the confidence of all the ends of the earth, and of the far-off seas; who established the mountains by His strength, being clothed with power; You who still the noise of the seas, the noise of their waves, and the tumult of the peoples (Ps. 65:5-7).

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the blessing of the Lord be upon you (Ps. 129:8), surely you will believe and embrace the Promises of God, for not one word of all His good promises have failed (1 Kin. 8:56). May God of your strength (Ps. 43:2) show you His ways; teach you His paths. Lead you in His truth and teach you (Ps. 25:4). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will walk in God's Ways (Ps. 128:1), being rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, abounding in it with thanksgiving (Col. 2:6). Knowing as for God, His way is perfect; the word of the Lord is proven; He is a shield to all who trust in Him (2 Sam. 22:31). The statutes of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes; the fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever; the judgments of the Lord are true and righteous altogether. More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold; sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb (Ps. 19:8-10). Let you fear the Lord and have strong confidence (Prov. 14:26) in His Power, for all power belongs to God (Ps. 62:11). The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein (Ps. 24:1). For the shields of the earth belong to God; He is greatly exalted. (Ps. 47:9)

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the desire of our soul is for His name and for the remembrance of Him (Is. 26:8); in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will rejoice in the fact that you have been called with a holy calling (2 Tim. 1:9); you have been redeemed; you have been called by name; and you belong to the Lord (Is. 43:1-2). May your heart be comforted

by the knowledge that the Lord watches over His Word to see that it is performed (Jer. 1:12). “So shall My word be that goes forth; it shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it” says the Almighty God (Is. 55:11). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), to His name give glory, because of His mercy, and because of His truth (Ps. 115:1), in **Jesus’** name, abiding in Him (John 15:4-5), and one with Him (John 17:22), we pray that your faith does not stand in the wisdom of men but in the power of God (1 Cor. 2:5). According to His loving kindness; according to the multitude of His tender mercies (Ps. 51:1) may the God of all comfort (2 Cor. 1:3) teach you to live by faith, from faith to faith (Rom. 1:17), walk by faith, not by sight (2 Cor. 5:7), asking in faith with no doubting (Rom. 14:23), the desires of your heart (Ps. 20:4). Surely, you will not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but be strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He has promised He is also able to perform (Rom. 4:20-21). May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Ghost (Rom. 15:13). The righteous shall be glad in the Lord, and trust in Him. And all the upright in heart shall glory (Ps. 64:10). Praise is awaiting You, O God, in Zion; and to You the vow shall be performed (Ps. 65:1)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the light of the world, the light of life (John 8:12), may the Lord breathe (John 20:22) life into your mortal bodies through His Holy Spirit (Rom. 8:11). Let God deal to you and yours a measure of faith (Rom. 12:3) and may you continue in the faith, grounded and settled (Col. 1:23), abounding in grace (Rom. 1:5), in obedience to the faith (Rom. 16:26), building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit, keeping yourselves in the love of God, seeking the mercy of your **Lord Jesus Christ** unto eternal life (Jude 20-21). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that God would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, that **Christ** may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you and yours are rooted and grounded in love (Eph. 3:16). Let the name of **Jesus Christ** be glorified in you, and you in Him according to the grace of God and the **Lord Jesus** (2 Thess. 1:12). Let you be justified by faith and have peace with God through our Lord **Jesus Christ** (Rom. 5:1). To **Jesus Christ**, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved you and washed you from your sins in His own blood and has made you kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever (Rev. 1:5-6)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), for His name alone is exalted; His glory is above the earth and heaven (Ps. 148:13), according to the Spirit of holiness (Rom. 1:4), may God of

your righteousness (Ps. 4:1) increase your faith (Luke 17:5). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will be diligent to add to your faith virtue, to virtue knowledge, to knowledge self-control, to self-control perseverance, to perseverance godliness, to godliness brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness love. May you abound in these things so you will be fruitful in knowledge of our **Lord Jesus Christ** (2 Pet. 1:5-8). For the **Lord Jesus Christ** has called you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain (John 15:16). May you leave an inheritance to your children's children (Prov. 13:22) rich in the knowledge (Is. 11:8-9, 2 Pet. 1:2) and love of God (John 3:16-17), filled with the fullness of God (Eph. 3:19). May the God of your salvation (Ps. 25:5), the Father of Righteousness (Ps. 71:19), the God of glory (Acts 7:2), put a longing in your hearts to talk with Him face to face (Num. 12:8), to be His friend and confident (John 15:14-15). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that clearly you hear the voice of **Jesus Christ** and you and yours possess a spirit of obedience to follow Him (John 10:27), that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him (Col. 1:10). Surely you will commit your way to the Lord, and trust also in Him (Ps. 37:5), to be continually with Him, and to seek His guidance and counsel in all things (Ps. 73:23-24). May you dwell in the secret place of the Most-High God, and you shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty (Ps. 91:1). The Lord shall cover you with His feathers, and under His wings you shall take refuge; His truth shall be your shield and buckler (Ps. 91:4). For this is God, our God forever and ever; He will be your guide even to death (Ps. 48:14). The Mighty One, God the Lord, has spoken and called the earth from the rising of the sun to its going down. Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God will shine forth (Ps. 50:1-2)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), know that His name is the Lord (Jer. 16:21), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you trust in the Lord with all of your heart, and lean not to your own understanding, but in all your ways acknowledge the Lord, and He shall direct your paths (Prov. 3:5-6). May El Shadda, the All-Sufficient One (Gen 17:1), let you bask in His presence (Acts 2:28, Ex. 33:14) and His friendship forever (2 Chr. 20:7); for God Almighty will make known to you the ways of life; He will make you full of joy in His presence (Acts 2:28). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), His name be magnified forever (2 Sam. 7:26), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray you be held in the grip of the love of God (2 Cor. 5:14), totally surrendered to the love of **Christ**. Let the peace of God rule in your hearts (Col. 3:15). Let the word of **Christ** dwell in you richly in all wisdom (Col. 3:16). Surely God, whose faithfulness reaches to the clouds (Ps. 36:5), will show you the path of life; in His presence you may have fullness of joy; and pleasures forevermore (Ps. 16:11). May you seek God, your soul thirst for Him, your flesh long for Him (Ps. 63:1), and let you be led by God (Prov. 16:9), putting God first (Matt. 4:10), and acknowledging God in everything

you do. (Prov. 3:6), putting your faith into action to move the mountains of life. (Matt. 17:20); whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the **Lord Jesus**, giving thanks to God the Father through Him (Col. 3:17); knowing that you can do all things through **Christ** who strengthens you (Phil. 4:13), and therefore performing every work of faith with power, that the name of the Lord **Jesus** be glorified in you (2 Thess. 1:12). May the Lord call you to righteousness, and hold your hand, keep you and give you as a covenant to the people, as a light to the gentiles (Is. 42:6). May you and yours be as light to the world (Matt. 5:14), an example to the believers in words, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, and in purity (1 Tim. 4:12). Out of your heart may rivers of living water flow (John 7:38). According to His abundant mercy (1 Pet. 1:3), may the God of all power (Ps. 62:11) make your faith a shield of protection that will quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one (Eph. 6:16), for you and all that you have on every side (Job 1:10). Let the Lord perfect that which concerns you; for His mercy endures forever; and He will not forsake the works of His hands (Ps. 138:8). Oh, love the Lord, all of you, His saints! For the Lord preserves the faithful, and fully repays the proud person. Be of good courage, and He shall strengthen your heart, all you who hope in the Lord (Ps. 31:23-24). To God, alone wise, be glory through **Jesus Christ** forever. (Rom. 16:27)

May the angel of the Lord touch your eyes, saying "According to your faith let it be unto you." (Matt. 9:29), for the lamp of the body is the eye. If therefore your eyes are good, your whole body will be full of light (Matt. 6:22). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your souls prosper (3 John 1:2). Thank you, Father God, for the blood covenant given to us by the suffering of your only begotten Son and Your unfailing love and faithfulness (John 3:16).

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline, your house and all of your people; by the blood of the lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space by the overpowering presence of God, who has made his home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our **Lord Jesus Christ** (1 Thess. 5:23). As a vessel of honor (Rom. 9:21), we continue petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to you according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to you (Luke 11:9). In

Jesus' (John 16:23) name so be it! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever!
