## A Prayer for the Children of Israel Trouble, Trials & Tribulations



To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever (Rev. 1:5-6). As a king (Rev. 5:10) abiding in (1 John 2:29) and one with (John 17:11) the King of Kings (Rev. 17:14), in the authority given to us (Luke 10:19) in the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Philp. 2:10)

we speak words of life (John 6:63) over the children Israel. We call all those the Lord God chose before the foundation of the world, that they should be holy and without blame before Him in love, having predestined them to adoption as sons by <u>Jesus Christ</u> to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He has made them accepted in the Beloved (Eph. 1:4-6). They are the inheritance of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (Ps. 2:8) and we are joint heirs with <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 8:17) so we call them Our Children.

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come into the heart of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21). Your will be done in the life of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). As an ambassador of <u>Christ</u> (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in <u>Christ</u> (John 15:4-5) and one with Him (John 6:56, John 15:5), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), in His Son Jesus Christ (1 John 5:20), we give thanks to the Lord (1 Thess. 5:18), the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21), their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire family (Acts 13:26), and their nation (Math. 21:43) for the saints (Eph. 6:18), for the leaders that God has raised up on their behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23) so that Christ might make known to them the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21) their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), for their entire family (Acts 13:26), their friends, neighbors and countrymen (1 Tim. 2:1-2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43); for all the brethren (Eph. 6:18), all those called by the name of the Lord (Deut. 28:10); for the leaders of their nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the

wellbeing of God's people; and all the people of their nation, and all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2), so that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) may lead a guiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence (1 Tim. 2:1-2). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (ls. 61:2)! We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God (Rom. 5:2)! It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) (James 5:16) their family (Acts 13:26) and their nation (Math. 21:43), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that *Christ*, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) are spirit and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Cor. 15:57)!

We don't come to the Father in Heaven (Math. 6:9) based on our own worthiness (Is. 64:6), or on the worthiness (Is. 64:6) of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26). Abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), we come to God's throne of grace (Heb. 4:16) on the merits of His Son (Eph. 4:13), *Jesus Christ of Nazareth* (Acts 3:6), and the blood that He shed (Rev. 7:14). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), who upholds all things by the word of His power (Heb. 1:3), as a fellow worker in *Christ Jesus* (Rom. 16;3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), on every side (Job 1:10), all of their family (Acts 13:26), all of their blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all their natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of their spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43). The Lord will give strength to Our Children (Is. 61:9); The Lord will bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) with peace (Psalms 29:11).

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), by the precious blood of <u>Christ</u>, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the Father in heaven bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and keep them (Num. 6:24). Glory to God the Father (Luke 2:14)! I don't come to the Father (Math. 6:9) based on my own

worthiness (Is. 64:6) or on the worthiness (Is. 64:6) of Our Children (Is. 61:9) but by Jesus Christ whose sandal strap we are not worthy to loose (John 1:27). Abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), we come before God's mercy seat (Heb. 9:5) on the merits of His Son (Eph. 4:13), Jesus Christ, and the precious blood that He shed (1 Pet. 1:19), for worthy is the lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and blessing (Rev. 5:12)! In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), as a fellow worker in Christ Jesus (Rom. 16;3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we command: Depart from Our Children (Is. 61:9) their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), all you workers of iniquity; for the Lord has heard the voice of our weeping. The Lord has heard our supplication. The Lord will receive our prayer. Let all their enemies be ashamed and greatly troubled. Let them turn back and be ashamed suddenly (Ps. 6:8-10). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), according to the exceeding greatness of His power (Ps. 79:11, Eph. 1:19, 2 Tim. 1:8), may the Lord release the fruits of Calvary (righteousness) (Phil. 1:11) over Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and declare the victory of Christ in their lives (1 Cor. 15:57). May the God of all comfort who comforts Our Children (Is. 61:9) in their tribulations (2 Cor. 1:3-4), who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that they ask or think (Eph. 3:20), who knows the things they have need of before they ask Him (Matt. 6:8), pour the Holy Spirit out on them and all of their family (Acts 13:26), abundantly through **Jesus** *Christ* their savior (Titus 3:5-6) that they and their people (Ps. 148:14) may be filled with comfort and exceedingly joyful in all their tribulation (2 cor. 7:4). The thief does not come except to steal, and kill, and destroy. Jesus came that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly (John 10:10). Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our Lord Christ Jesus (1 Cor. 15:57)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23) may Jehovah-Nissi, the Lord our Banner (Ex.17:15), strengthen their hearts for battle (Ps. 18:39) and give them patience (Col. 1:11), faith (2 Thess. 1:4), peace (John 16:33), perseverance, character, hope (Rom. 5:3), and endurance (Heb. 10:36); though they may fall, let them rise again (Prov. 24:16). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), in a time of trouble (Jer. 14:18), may God their helper (Ps. 54:4) be not like a stranger: (Jer. 14:8) to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21) but instead let them and all of their family (Acts 13:26) hear His voice so that they do not harden their hearts in rebellion (Ps. 95:7-8). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23) may the God of their defense (Ps. 59:17) counsel them (Eph. 1:11-11) and all of their family (Acts 13:26) and give Our Children (Is. 61:9) His knowledge which He has reserved for the time of trouble, for the day of battle and war (Job

38:23). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), according to His excellent greatness (Ps. 150:2), may Our Children (Is. 61:9) and all of their family (Acts 13:26) have assurance in their hearts (Eph. 3:13) that God is their refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble (Ps. 46:1). Our Children (Is. 61:9) can do all things through *Christ* who strengthens them (Phil. 4:13). In all these things Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) are more than conquerors through *Jesus Christ* (Rom. 8:37). Let their delight be in the fear of the Lord, and let them not judge by the sight of their eyes, nor decide by the hearing of their ears (Is. 11:3) because with men not all things are possible but with God all things are possible (Matt. 19:26)! Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our *Lord Christ Jesus* (1 Cor. 15:57)!

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the great and awesome name (Ps. 99:3) that endures forever, to all generations (Ps. 102:12); let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and all of their family (Acts 13:26) cast their burdens on the Lord, and He shall sustain them (Ps. 55:22) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); for the steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord, and He delights in their way (Ps. 37:23). The Lord shall sustain them and all of their family (Acts 13:26), in a desert land, in a howling wilderness waste. He shall shield Our Children (Is. 61:9), care for them, and guard them as the apple of His eye (Deut. 32:10). May the Lord uphold them with His hand (Ps. 37:24). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the name that is a strong tower (Prov. 18:10), let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and all of their family (Acts 13:26) find their strength in Him (Ps. 28:7), rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer (Rom. 12:12) and they and their people (Ps. 148:14) shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint (is. 40:31); they shall come out of their tribulations washed and made white in the blood of the Lamb (Rev. 7:14); and may all things work together for their good (Rom. 8:28). May our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and their God and Father, who has loved Our Children (Is. 61:9) and given them everlasting consolation and good hope by grace, comfort their hearts and establish them in every good word and work (2 Thess. 2:16-17). The Lord is faithful who will establish them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21), and guard them and their family (Acts 13:26) from the evil one (2 Thess. 3:3). May the Lord direct their heart into the love of God and into the patience of Christ (2 Thess. 3:5). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), our help is in the name of the Lord, who made heaven and earth (Ps. 124:8), by His name may the angels of the Lord encamp all around Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their household and deliver them (Ps. 34:7) and their people (Ps. 148:14). Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our Lord Christ Jesus (1 Cor. 15:57)!

In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), inasmuch as there is none like Him, He is great and His name is great in might (Jer. 10:6); in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and all of their family (Acts 13:26) will be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let their requests be made known to God; and the peace of God which surpasses all understanding, will guard their hearts and minds through *Christ Jesus* (Phil. 4:6-7). According to the multitude of His tender mercies (Ps. 69:16, Lam. 3:32), let the Lord hold them up, in the multitude of their anxieties within them, His comforts, shall delight their souls (Ps. 94:18-19). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) will trust in the Lord with all of their heart and lean not to their own understanding but in all their ways acknowledge Him (Prov. 3:5-6); that they and their family (Acts 13:26) will commit their way to the Lord, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass. He shall bring forth their righteousness as the light, and their justice as the noonday (Ps. 37:5-6). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) put on righteousness, and it will clothe them; their justice will be like a robe and a turban (Job 29:14). In guietness and confidence shall be their strength (Is. 30-15) for if God is for Our Children (Is. 61:9), who can be against them (Rom. 8:31). Because Jesus guards them (2 Thess. 3:3) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), the wicked one cannot touch them (1 John 5:18) and their family (Acts 13:26). Neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate Our Children (Is. 61:9) from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus Our Lord (Rom. 8:38-39). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Jesus will give them and their people (Ps. 148:14) eternal life, and Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of His hand. For God is greater than all; and lo no one is able to snatch them out of His hand (John 10:28-29). Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our Lord Christ Jesus (1 Cor. 15:57)!

God is faithful, who will not allow Our Children (Is. 61:9) or their family (Acts 13:26) to be tempted beyond what they are able, but with every temptation, trouble, trial or tribulation, God will also make a way of escape (1 Cor. 10:13). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), the Mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) will ask and it will be given to them; Our Children (Is. 61:9) will seek, and they will find; Our Children (Is. 61:9) will knock and it will be opened (Luke 11:9). My God shall supply all their needs according to His riches and glory by <u>Christ Jesus</u> (Phil. 4:19). Let the God of knowledge (1 Sam. 2:3) guide Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26)

with His council, and afterward receive them to honor and glory (Ps. 73:24). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) they and their people (Ps. 148:14) will give attention to the word of God and incline their ear to His sayings; that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will not let them depart from their eyes; keep them in the midst of their hearts; for they are life to those who find them, and health to all their flesh (Prov. 4:20-22). In the world Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will have tribulation; but in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) they are of good cheer, for <u>Jesus</u> has overcome the world. In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) they and their people (Ps. 148:14) will receive the peace of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:33). Let not their hearts be troubled, neither let it be afraid (John 14:27). For though *Jesus* was crucified in weakness, ye He lives by the power of God. For Our Children (Is. 61:9) and all of their family (Acts 13:26), also are weak in Jesus, but they shall live with Jesus by the power of God (2 Cor. 13:4). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we call upon Jehovah-Shammah, Lord is here (Ezek. 48:35), to be with Our Children (Is. 61:9) in trouble; deliver them and honor them. With long life satisfy Our Children (ls. 61:9) and show them His salvation (Ps. 91:15-16). Though they may walk in the midst of trouble, He will revive them and their family (Acts 13:26), He will stretch out His hand against the wrath of their enemies, and His right hand will save them (Ps. 138:7) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). May the Lord cause their enemies who rise against Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to be defeated before their eyes; they shall come out against them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) one way and flee before them and their people (Ps. 148:14) seven ways (Deut. 28:7). Break the arm of the wicked and the evil man, O Lord; seek out their wickedness until You find none (Ps. 10:15). Destroy, O Lord, and divide their tongues (Ps. 55-9). May the Father (Math. 6:9), God of righteousness (Ps. 4:1), keep them and all of their family (Acts 13:26) from the snares they have laid for them, and from the traps of the workers of iniquity. Let the wicked fall into their own nets, while Our Children (Is. 61:9) and all of their family (Acts 13:26) escape safely (Ps. 141:9-10). Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our Lord Christ Jesus (1 Cor. 15:57)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), the great, the Mighty God, whose name is the Lord of hosts (Jer. 32:18), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and all of their family (Acts 13:26) will not be afraid of the terror by night, nor of the arrow that flies by day, nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness, nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday. A thousand may fall at their side, and ten thousand at their right hand; but it shall not come near Our Children (Is. 61:9). Only with their eyes shall they look, and see the reward of the wicked (Ps. 91:5-8). For God will redeem their lives from oppression and violence, and precious shall be their blood in His sight (Ps. 72:14). Violence shall no longer be heard in their land, neither wasting nor destruction within their walls; but He shall call their walls Salvation and their gates Praise (ls. 60:18)! May God Almighty arise and save Our Children (Is. 61:9) and all of their family (Acts 13:26). For He has struck all our enemies on the cheekbone; He has broken the teeth of the ungodly. Salvation belongs to the Lord! His blessing is upon Our Children (Is. 61:9) and all of their family (Acts 13:26)! For the Lord will bless the righteous, with favor He will surround them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) as with a shield (Ps. 5:12). The sun shall not strike them or their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) by day, nor the moon by night (Ps. 121:6)! In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) the Lord will plead their cause with those who strive with Our Children (Is. 61:9); fight against those who fight against them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Take hold of the shield and buckler and stand up for them and their people (Ps. 148:14). Also draw out the spear and stop those who pursue them and their family (Acts 13:26). Let those be put to shame and brought to dishonor who seek after their lives. Let those be driven back and brought to confusion who wish them and their people (Ps. 148:14) evil, who seek to destroy their lives, who plot their hurt, who rejoice at their hurt, who exalt themselves against Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our Lord Christ Jesus (1 Cor. 15:57)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), the King over all the earth (Zech. 14:9), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and all of their family (Acts 13:26) will not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good (Rom. 12:21). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that they and their people (Ps. 148:14) will examine themselves as to whether they are in the faith (2 cor. 13:5); <u>Jesus Christ</u> is in Our Children (Is. 61:9) (2 Cor. 13:5), they are not their own, they are bought with a price (1 Cor. 6:19-20), purchased with <u>Jesus'</u> blood (Acts 20:28), and are covered by the blood of the new covenant (Matt. 26:28) with God Most-High. Although the horn may make war against Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their posterity (Prov. 11:21) and prevail against them the Ancient of Days has judged in favor of the saints of the God Most-High and it is time for them to possess the kingdom (Dan. 7:21-22). Let each one of them examine their own work (Gal. 6:4), for Our Children (Is. 61:9) must bear their own load (Gal. 6:5), and by the measure which they give, will be given back to Our Children (Is. 61:9): pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into their bosom (Luke 6:38). God is not mocked, for whatever a man sows that he will also reap

(Gal. 6:7). Therefore, let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) confess their sins. God is faithful and just to forgive them their sins and to cleanse them from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9). May they confess their trespasses to one another and pray for one another that they may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much (James 5:16). Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), with all malice (Eph.4:31). May God forgive their sins just as Our Children (Is. 61:9) have forgiven those who sinned against them (Matt. 6:12). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) cast off the works of darkness, and let them put on the armor of light (Rom. 13:12). Let them and their people (Ps. 148:14) sow bountifully and reap bountifully (2 Cor. 9:6) the good seed of the Son of Man (Matt. 13:37); the spiritual things (1 Cor. 9:11). Let their natural bodies (1 Cor. 15:44) which are sown in corruption (1 Cor. 15:42), dishonor, and weakness (1 Cor. 15:43), know the resurrection of the dead and may they all be raised in incorruption (1 Cor. 15:42), glory, power (1 Cor. 15:43), a spiritual body (1 Cor. 15:44); having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever (1 Pet. 1:23). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) be clothed with the garments of salvation and covered with the robes of righteousness. Let them greatly rejoice in the Lord, their souls shall be joyful in their God (ls. 61:10). Rain down, You heavens, from above, and let the skies pour down righteousness; let the earth open, let it bring forth salvation, and let righteousness spring up together (Is. 45:8)! May the Lord deliver Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) from every evil work and preserve them for His heavenly kingdom (2 Tim. 4:18) and keep them as the apple of His eye; hide them under the shadow of His wings from the wicked who oppress them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), from the deadly enemies who surround them (Ps. 17:8-9) and their people (Ps. 148:14). Instead of shame may God give them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21) double honor, and instead of confusion let them and their family (Acts 13:26) rejoice in their portion. May everlasting joy be theirs (Is. 61:7). Let them enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him and bless His name (Ps. 100:4)! Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) dwell in the secret place of the Most-High and abide under the shadow of the Almighty (Ps. 91:1). In a time of trouble may He hide Our Children (Is. 61:9) in His pavilion; in the secret place of His tabernacle He shall hide them and their family (Acts 13:26). He shall set them and their people (Ps. 148:14) high upon a rock. And now their head shall be lifted up above their enemies all around them; therefore, offer sacrifices of joy in His tabernacle (Ps. 27:5-6). May

Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) bless the Lord with all their souls, with all that is within them. May they bless His holy name! And forget not all His benefits, who forgives all their iniquities, who heals all their diseases, who redeems their lives from destruction, who crowns them and their people (Ps. 148:14) with loving kindness and tender mercies (Ps. 103:1-4). Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our <u>Lord</u>. *Christ Jesus* (1 Cor. 15:57)!

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), their nation (Math. 21:43) and all of their people (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify their time (ls. 9:7, ls. 59:21) so that they will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify their space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in them (John 14:23). As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that Christ might make known to Our Children (Is. 61:9) their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), and their nation (Math. 21:43) the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23, Eph. 1:18), we claim Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), their family (Acts 13:26), their children and their children's children (Prov. 11:21) as our joint

inheritance (Eph. 1:18) with our *Lord Jesus Christ* (Gal. 4:7). By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most-High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom (Dan. 7:22). Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and *Christ* will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin! And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now, our salvation is near (Rom. 13:11)! Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it (Is. 34:1)! In *Christ* (John 16:23) we pray that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) in one accord (Acts 1:14) will pray for the peace of Jerusalem for it is written: "May they prosper who love you" (Ps. 122:6). The LORD bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) out of Zion, and may they see the good of Jerusalem all the days of their life (Ps. 128:5). As kings and priests of the God and Father of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (Rev. 1:6), we decree Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) out of Zion, and may they see the good of Jerusalem all the days of their life (Ps. 128:5). As kings and priests of the God and Father of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (Rev. 1:6), we decree Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) shall stand (2 chr. 11:13) with Israel against the ungodly nations (Ezek. 13:5) for their shield *belongs* to the LORD, and their king to the Holy One of Israel (Psalm 89:18).

In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the rod out of the stem of Jesse, the Branch that grew out of his roots (ls. 11:1), we ask our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) and receive all these things (Math. 7:7). Concerning this prayer of faith (James 5:15) that we pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with them (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). Being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), we pray (James 5:16) with confidence (1 John 5:14) for God's thoughts towards Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21) are thoughts of peace, to give them a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11). As a chosen vessel of Jesus Christ, to bear His name (Acts 9;15), we continue petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to them (Luke 11:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. Praise the LORD (Ps. 149:9)! It is written: "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." says the Lord God Almighty **Psalms: 89:34**. God is watching over His word to perform it **Jerimiah. 1:12** and it shall not return to Him void; but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it **Isaiah**: **55:11**. The Lord gives voice before His army, for His camp is very great; for strong is the One who executes His word **Joel: 2:11**! The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the

plans of His heart to all generations **Psalms: 33:1.** It shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, as the Lord has said, among the remnant whom the Lord calls **Joel: 2:32.** "For My name shall be great among the nations," says the Lord of hosts **Malachi: 1:11.** We ask our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) in the name of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), who gave Himself for us, that He might purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works (Titus 2:14), believing that Our Children (Is. 61:9), their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) receive all we ask for them (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14). You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of Your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! In <u>Jesus</u>' name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)!

God, our faithful God, He will set His glory among the nations; all the nations shall see His judgment which He has executed, and His hand which He has laid on them. We shall know that He is our Lord our God from that day forward. (Ezek.39:21-22). By the blood of the everlasting covenant (Heb. 13:20), in the awesome name (Deut. 28:58) of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 14:11), the mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24), we activate (Math 16:19) these Prophetic Scriptures (Rom. 16:25-27) in the lives of Our Children (Is. 61:9). These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God: Amen! (Rev. 3:14). <u>For</u> <u>all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God</u> (2 cor. 1:20)!.
