



Trouble, Trials & Tribulations

Inasmuch as there is none like You, O Lord (You are great, and Your name is great in might), who would not fear You, O King of the nations? For this is Your rightful due (Jer. 10:6-7). Praise Him!

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come.

Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, the Son of the Highest (Luke 1:32), we lift up you and your entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to the Father (Math. 6:9), all of your family (Acts 13:26), all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all your natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of your spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2). In the mighty and awesome name of **Jesus Christ**, the true Light (John 1:9), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for you, your posterity (Prov. 11:21) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). The words that **Christ**, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to you and your family (Acts 13:26) are spirit, and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our **Lord Jesus Christ** (1 Cor. 15:57)!

Depart from us, all you workers of iniquity; for the Lord has heard the voice of our weeping. The Lord has heard our supplication. The Lord will receive our prayer. Let all our enemies be ashamed and greatly troubled. Let them turn back and be ashamed suddenly (Ps. 6:8-10). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), according to the exceeding greatness of His power (Ps. 79:11, Eph. 1:19, 2 Tim. 1:8), may the Lord release the fruits of Calvary (righteousness) (Phil. 1:11) over you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and declare the victory of **Christ** in your lives (1 Cor. 15:57). May the God of all comfort who comforts you in your tribulations (2 Cor. 1:3-4), who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that you ask or think (Eph. 3:20), who knows the things you have need of before you ask Him (Matt. 6:8), pour the Holy Spirit out on you and all of your family (Acts 13:26), abundantly through **Jesus Christ** your savior (Titus 3:5-6) that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) may be filled with comfort and exceedingly joyful in all your tribulation (2 Cor. 7:4). The thief does not come except to steal, and kill, and destroy. **Jesus** came that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) may have life, and that you may have it more abundantly (John 10:10). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our **Lord Christ Jesus** (1 Cor. 15:57)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23) may Jehovah-Nissi, the Lord our Banner (Ex.17:15), strengthen your hearts for battle (Ps. 18:39) and give you patience (Col. 1:11), faith (2

Thess. 1:4), **peace** (John 16:33), **perseverance**, **character**, **hope** (Rom. 5:3), and **endurance** (Heb. 10:36); though you may fall, let you rise again (Prov. 24:16). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), in a time of trouble (Jer. 14:18), may God your helper (Ps. 54:4) be not like a stranger: (Jer. 14:8) to you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) but instead let you and all of your family (Acts 13:26) hear His voice so that you do not harden your hearts in rebellion (Ps. 95:7-8). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23) may the God of your defense (Ps. 59:17) counsel you (Eph. 1:11-11) and all of your family (Acts 13:26) and give you His knowledge which He has reserved for the time of trouble, for the day of battle and war (Job 38:23). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), according to His excellent greatness (Ps. 150:2), may you and all of your family (Acts 13:26) have assurance in your hearts (Eph. 3:13) that God is your refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble (Ps. 46:1). You and yours can do all things through **Christ** who strengthens you (Phil. 4:13). In all these things you and your people (Ps. 148:14) are more than conquerors through **Jesus Christ** (Rom. 8:37). Let your delight be in the fear of the Lord, and let you not judge by the sight of your eyes, nor decide by the hearing of your ears (Is. 11:3) because with men not all things are possible but with God all things are possible (Matt. 19:26)! Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our **Lord Christ Jesus** (1 Cor. 15:57)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the great and awesome name (Ps. 99:3) that endures forever, to all generations (Ps. 102:12); let you and all of your family (Acts 13:26) cast your burdens on the Lord, and He shall sustain you (Ps. 55:22) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); for the steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord, and He delights in your way (Ps. 37:23). The Lord shall sustain you and all of your family (Acts 13:26), in a desert land, in a howling wilderness waste. He shall shield you, care for you, and guard you as the apple of His eye (Deut. 32:10). May the Lord uphold you with His hand (Ps. 37:24). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the name that is a strong tower (Prov. 18:10), let you and all of your family (Acts 13:26) find your strength in Him (Ps. 28:7), rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer (Rom. 12:12) and you and your people (Ps. 148:14) shall renew your strength; you shall mount up with wings like eagles, you shall run and not be weary, you shall walk and not faint (Is. 40:31); you shall come out of your tribulations washed and made white in the blood of the Lamb (Rev. 7:14); and may all things work together for your good (Rom. 8:28). May our **Lord Jesus Christ Himself**, and your God and Father, who has loved you and given you everlasting consolation and good hope by grace, comfort your hearts and establish you in every good word and work (2 Thess. 2:16-17). The Lord is faithful

who will establish you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and guard you and your family (Acts 13:26) from the evil one (2 Thess. 3:3). May the Lord direct your heart into the love of God and into the patience of **Christ** (2 Thess. 3:5). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), our help is in the name of the Lord, who made heaven and earth (Ps. 124:8), by His name may the angels of the Lord encamp all around you and your household and deliver you (Ps. 34:7) and your people (Ps. 148:14). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our **Lord Christ Jesus** (1 Cor. 15:57)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), inasmuch as there is none like Him, He is great and His name is great in might (Jer. 10:6); in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and all of your family (Acts 13:26) will be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through **Christ Jesus** (Phil. 4:6-7). According to the multitude of His tender mercies (Ps. 69:16, Lam. 3:32), let the Lord hold you up, in the multitude of your anxieties within you, His comforts, shall delight your souls (Ps. 94:18-19). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) will trust in the Lord with all of your heart and lean not to your own understanding but in all your ways acknowledge Him (Prov. 3:5-6); that you and your family (Acts 13:26) will commit your way to the Lord, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass. He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, and your justice as the noonday (Ps. 37:5-6). Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) put on righteousness, and it will clothe you; your justice will be like a robe and a turban (Job 29:14). In quietness and confidence shall be your strength (Is. 30:15) for if God is for you, who can be against you (Rom. 8:31). Because **Jesus** guards you (2 Thess. 3:3) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), the wicked one cannot touch you (1 John 5:18) and your family (Acts 13:26). Neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate you from the love of God which is in **Christ Jesus our Lord** (Rom. 8:38-39). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that **Jesus** will give you and your people (Ps. 148:14) eternal life, and you shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch you out of His hand. For God is greater than all; and lo no one is able to snatch you out of His hand (John 10:28-29). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our **Lord Christ Jesus** (1 Cor. 15:57)!

God is faithful, who will not allow you or your family (Acts 13:26) to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with every temptation, trouble, trial or tribulation, God will also

make a way of escape (1 Cor. 10:13). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the Mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you will ask and it will be given to you; you will seek, and you will find; you will knock and it will be opened (Luke 11:9). My God shall supply all your needs according to His riches and glory by **Christ Jesus** (Phil. 4:19). Let the God of knowledge (1 Sam. 2:3) guide you and your family (Acts 13:26) with His council, and afterward receive you to honor and glory (Ps. 73:24). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will give attention to the word of God and incline your ear to His sayings; that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will not let them depart from your eyes; keep them in the midst of your hearts; for they are life to those who find them, and health to all their flesh (Prov. 4:20-22). In the world you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will have tribulation; but in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) you are of good cheer, for **Jesus** has overcome the world. In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) you and yours will receive the peace of **Jesus** (John 16:33). Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let it be afraid (John 14:27). For though **Jesus** was crucified in weakness, yet He lives by the power of God. For you and all of your family (Acts 13:26), also are weak in **Jesus**, but you shall live with **Jesus** by the power of God (2 Cor. 13:4). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we call upon Jehovah-Shammah, Lord is here (Ezek. 48:35), to be with you in trouble; deliver you and honor you. With long life satisfy you and show you His salvation (Ps. 91:15-16). Though you may walk in the midst of trouble, He will revive you and your family (Acts 13:26), He will stretch out His hand against the wrath of your enemies, and His right hand will save you (Ps. 138:7) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). May the Lord cause your enemies who rise against you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to be defeated before your eyes; they shall come out against you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) one way and flee before you and your people (Ps. 148:14) seven ways (Deut. 28:7). Break the arm of the wicked and the evil man, O Lord; seek out their wickedness until You find none (Ps. 10:15). Destroy, O Lord, and divide their tongues (Ps. 55-9). May the Father (Math. 6:9), God of righteousness (Ps. 4:1), keep you and all of your family (Acts 13:26) from the snares they have laid for you, and from the traps of the workers of iniquity. Let the wicked fall into their own nets, while you and all of your family (Acts 13:26) escape safely (Ps. 141:9-10). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our **Lord Christ Jesus** (1 Cor. 15:57)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the great, the Mighty God, whose name is the Lord of hosts (Jer. 32:18), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and all of your family (Acts 13:26) will not be afraid of the terror by night, nor of the arrow that flies by

day, nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness, nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday. A thousand may fall at your side, and ten thousand at your right hand; but it shall not come near you. Only with your eyes shall you look, and see the reward of the wicked (Ps. 91:5-8). For God will redeem your lives from oppression and violence, and precious shall be your blood in His sight (Ps. 72:14). Violence shall no longer be heard in your land, neither wasting nor destruction within your walls; but He shall call your walls Salvation and your gates Praise (Is. 60:18)! May God Almighty arise and save you and all of your family (Acts 13:26). For He has struck all your enemies on the cheekbone; He has broken the teeth of the ungodly. Salvation belongs to the Lord! His blessing is upon you (Ps. 3:7-8) and all of your family (Acts 13:26)! For the Lord will bless the righteous, with favor He will surround you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) as with a shield (Ps. 5:12). The sun shall not strike you or yours by day, nor the moon by night (Ps. 121:6)! In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) the Lord will plead your cause with those who strive with you; fight against those who fight against you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Take hold of the shield and buckler and stand up for you and your people (Ps. 148:14). Also draw out the spear and stop those who pursue you and your family (Acts 13:26). Let those be put to shame and brought to dishonor who seek after your lives. Let those be driven back and brought to confusion who wish you and yours evil, who seek to destroy your lives, who plot your hurt, who rejoice at your hurt, who exalt themselves against you (Ps. 35:1-4, Ps. 35:26, Ps. 40:14) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our **Lord Christ Jesus** (1 Cor. 15:57)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the King over all the earth (Zech.+ 14:9), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and all of your family (Acts 13:26) will not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good (Rom. 12:21). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith (2 Cor. 13:5); **Jesus Christ** is in you (2 Cor. 13:5), you are not your own, you are bought with a price (1 Cor. 6:19-20), purchased with **Jesus'** blood (Acts 20:28), and are covered by the blood of the new covenant (Matt. 26:28) with God Most-High. Although the horn may make war against you and your posterity (Prov. 11:21) and prevail against you the Ancient of Days has judged in favor of the saints of the God Most-High and it is time for you to possess the kingdom (Dan. 7:21-22). Let each one of you examine your own work (Gal. 6:4), for you must bear your own load (Gal. 6:5), and by the measure which you give, will be given back to you: pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your

bosom (Luke 6:38). God is not mocked, for whatever a man sows that he will also reap (Gal. 6:7). Therefore, let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) confess your sins. God is faithful and just to forgive you your sins and to cleanse you from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9). May you confess your trespasses to one another and pray for one another that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much (James 5:16). Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), with all malice (Eph.4:31). May God forgive your sins just as you have forgiven those who sinned against you (Matt. 6:12). Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) cast off the works of darkness, and let you put on the armor of light (Rom. 13:12). Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) sow bountifully and reap bountifully (2 Cor. 9:6) the good seed of the Son of Man (Matt. 13:37); the spiritual things (1 Cor. 9:11). Let your natural bodies (1 Cor. 15:44) which are sown in corruption (1 Cor. 15:42), dishonor, and weakness (1 Cor. 15:43), know the resurrection of the dead and may you all be raised in incorruption (1 Cor. 15:42), glory, power (1 Cor. 15:43), a spiritual body (1 Cor. 15:44); having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever (1 Pet. 1:23). May you and your family (Acts 13:26) be clothed with the garments of salvation and covered with the robes of righteousness. Let us greatly rejoice in the Lord, our souls shall be joyful in our God (Is. 61:10). Rain down, You heavens, from above, and let the skies pour down righteousness; let the earth open, let it bring forth salvation, and let righteousness spring up together (Is. 45:8)! May the Lord deliver you and yours from every evil work and preserve you for His heavenly kingdom (2 Tim. 4:18) and keep you as the apple of His eye; hide you under the shadow of His wings from the wicked who oppress you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), from the deadly enemies who surround you (Ps. 17:8-9) and your people (Ps. 148:14). Instead of shame may God give you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) double honor, and instead of confusion let you and your family (Acts 13:26) rejoice in your portion. May everlasting joy be yours (Is. 61:7). Let you enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him and bless His name (Ps. 100:4)! Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) dwell in the secret place of the Most-High and abide under the shadow of the Almighty (Ps. 91:1). In a time of trouble may He hide you in His pavilion; in the secret place of His tabernacle he shall hide you and your family (Acts 13:26). He shall set you and your people (Ps. 148:14) high upon a rock. And now your head shall be lifted up above your enemies all around you; therefore, offer sacrifices of joy in His tabernacle (Ps. 27:5-6). May you and your people (Ps. 148:14) bless the Lord with all your souls, with all that is within you. May you

bless His holy name! And forget not all His benefits, who forgives all your iniquities, who heals all your diseases, who redeems your lives from destruction, who crowns you and yours with loving kindness and tender mercies (Ps. 103:1-4). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our **Lord Christ Jesus** (1 Cor. 15:57)!

As above and not beneath (Deut. 28:13), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and all of your people (Ps. 148:14); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time (Is. 9:7, Is. 59:21) so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Judges 18:6, Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our **Lord Jesus Christ** (1 Thess. 5:23). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, who is the way, the truth, and the life (John 14:6), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2)! In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. God said it. We believe it. It is settled forever. In **Jesus'** name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)!
