

A Prayer for the Leaders of the World Holiness

A Prayer for President and First Lady of the Republic of the United States of America, and all the leaders of the world, from the least to the greatest, taken from the

collection of Prayers for the Precious. As a fellow worker in *Christ Jesus* (Rom. 16;3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), we lift the leaders of the world up. God is good. His mercy endures forever. God is good to all your people for the Lord God is faithful, who will establish you and guard *you* from the evil one. Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom comes into their heart. Your will be done in their life on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), *Jesus Christ*, we give thanks to the Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), for the leaders that God has raised up and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that *Christ* might make known to you the riches of His glory, we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall for you and all your house (Ezek. 13:5). In the name of *Jesus Christ*, we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). The words that *Christ* through us speak are spirit and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord *Jesus Christ* (1 Cor. 15:57)!

As a fellow worker in <u>Christ Jesus</u> (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we lift up you to the Father, you and your bloodline and your entire house, all of your people, on every side, all of your family, all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time, all those by adoption, and all those by marriage, all your natural seed and all of your spiritual seed.. In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23, John 14:13) of Nazareth, by the precious blood of <u>Christ</u>, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the grace of the Lord <u>Jesus Christ</u>, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all (2 cor. 13:14). But know that the Lord has set apart for Himself, him who is godly; the Lord will hear when we call Him (Ps. 4:3). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 cor. 1:30) we call to the Lord our God and ask in the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13), His great and awesome name (Ps. 99:3), that according to the Spirit of holiness (Rom. 1:4), the Lord will choose you and cause (Ps. 65:4) you to come near to Him (Deut. 21:5); that the Lord will establish you as a holy people to Himself (Deut. 28:9). He will set you high in praise, in name and in honor, that you may be holy to the Lord your God, just as He has spoken (Deut. 26:19). In <u>Christ</u>

(Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that the Lord will set His love upon you and choose (Deut. 7:7) you for Himself, a special treasure (Deut. 14:2), and redeem you from the house of bondage (Deut. 7:8). May God separate you that you shall be holy and belong to God (Lev. 20:26). Oh Lord, send out Your light and Your truth! (Ps. 43:3). Let Jehovah-Raah, the Lord our Shepherd (Ps. 23:1), lead you by still waters (Ps 23:2) and bring you to His holy hill and to His tabernacle (Ps. 43:3). May the Lord lead you in His righteousness and make your way straight before your face (Ps. 5:8). May the God of Israel give strength and power to you (Ps. 68:35) and cause you to approach Him, that you may dwell in His courts. In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will be satisfied with the goodness of His house, of His holy temple (Ps. 65:4); that you will eat the bread of God, both the most holy and the holy (Lev. 21:22) and remember His covenant always, the word which He commanded, for a thousand generations (1 Chr. 16:15) and not conceal the words of the Holy One (Job 6:10) but instead come into His house in the multitude of His mercy and in fear of Him you shall worship toward His holy temple (Ps. 5:7). Blessed be the Lord God of Israel from everlasting to everlasting! (1 Chr. 16:36)

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13), who gave Himself for your sins, that He might deliver you from this present evil age, according to the will of your God and Father (Gal. 1:4-5), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray that you will wash your hands in innocence (Ps. 26:6), you will not gather your soul together with sinners, nor your life with bloodthirsty men (Ps. 26:9). In His mercy may God lead you whom He has redeemed, guide you in His strength to His holy habitation (Ex. 15:13). May God give to you His counsel, and let your heart also instruct yourselves in the night season. Let you set the Lord always before yourselves so that He will be at your right hand, and you shall not be moved (Ps. 16:7-8). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that He may keep you from corruption and show you the path of life. In His presence is fullness of joy, at His right hand are pleasures forevermore (Ps. 16:10-11). Let you cleanse yourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God (2 Cor. 7:1). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will walk uprightly (Ps. 84:11), work righteousness (Heb. 11:33), speaking truth in your hearts (Ps. 15:2), stirring up love and good works (Heb. 10:24), exhorting one another (Heb. 10:25), not backbiting with your tongues, nor doing evil to your neighbors, nor taking up a reproach against your friends (Ps. In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will distinguish between holy and unholy, and between unclean and clean and that you will teach your children God's statutes (Lev. 10:10-11); that you will revere your mother and your father and keep His Sabbaths (Lev. 19:3). Let you sanctify yourselves and be holy, neither shall you defile yourselves (Lev. 11:44), nor profane His holy name (Lev. 20:3). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray you will have clean hands and pure hearts; you will not lift your souls to an idol, nor swear deceitfully and you shall receive blessing from the Lord,

and righteousness from the God of your salvation (Ps. 24:4-5). You shall abide in His tabernacle, and dwell in His holy hill (Ps. 15:1). You shall have a song and gladness of heart to come into the mountain of the Lord, to the mighty One of Israel (Is. 30:29). The nursing child shall play by the cobra's hole, and the weaned child shall put his hand in the viper's den. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all of His mountain, for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord as the waters cover the sea (Is. 11:8-9). Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised in the city of our God, in His holy mountain (Ps. 48:1). God reigns over the nations; God sits on His holy throne (Ps. 47:8). Exalt the Lord our God, and worship at His holy hill; for the Lord our God is holy! (Ps. 99:9)

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 14:13), the Son of Man which has come to seek and to save that which was lost (Luke 19:10), in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you shall seek the Lord and His strength; seek His face ever more, glory in His holy name and let your hearts rejoice (1 Chr. 16:10-11) for the joy of the Lord is your strength (Neh. 8:10). Let you look to your maker, and your eyes will have respect for the Holy One of Israel (ls. 17:7). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you shall hear the words of the book, and your eyes shall see out of obscurity and out of darkness, that you shall increase your joy in the Lord and rejoice in the Holy One of Israel (Is. 29:18-19). Where you have erred in spirit you shall come to understanding, and where you have murmured you shall learn doctrine (ls. 29:24). In returning and rest you shall be saved; in quietness and in confidence shall be your strength (ls. 30:15). May the Lord give you understanding according to His word (Ps. 119:169). Let the God of hope (Rom. 15:13) teach you His way so that you will walk in His truth; and unite your hearts to fear His name that you will glorify His name forevermore (Ps. 86:11-12). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will rejoice in the Lord and give thanks at the remembrance of His holy name (Ps. 97:12) and triumph in His praise (Ps. 106:47), because you have trusted in His holy name (Zeph. 3:12). Let His mercy be upon you (Ps. 51:1). His praise endures forever (Ps. 111:10). The Lord God is your Father; your Redeemer from Everlasting is His name (ls. 63:16). There is none holy like the Lord, for there is none besides Him, nor is there any rock like your God. (1 Sam. 2:2)

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13), who manifested God's name to men (John 17:6), according to all that the Lord has bestowed on you, and the great goodness toward your house, which He has bestowed on you according to His mercies, according to the multitude of His loving kindnesses (Is. 63:7), let the power of the Highest overshadow you (8). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that your heavenly Father will give (Luke 11:13) the gift of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:38), pouring out His Spirit on you abundantly through <u>Jesus Christ</u> your Savior (Titus 3:6) and the love of God also be poured out in your hearts by the Holy Spirit (Rom. 5:5). May the God of hope fill you

with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit (Rom. 15:13). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that the Helper, the Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Truth (John 14:16-17), will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all things; that you will have the peace that only **Jesus** gives (John 14:26-27) and you may have His joy fulfilled in yourselves (John 17:13). For your peace will be like a river, and your righteousness like the waves of the sea (ls. 48:18). According to His righteousness (Ps. 35:24) may the God of heaven and the God of earth (Gen. 24:3) make known to you the ways of life, that you will be full of joy in His presence (Acts 2:28), and bring you to His holy mountain, and make you joyful in His house of prayer (ls. 56:7). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you shall put your trust in God, and you shall possess the land, and shall inherit His holy mountain (ls. 57:13). Let you drink freely from the waters of life (Rev. 22:17). There shall be deliverance, and there shall be holiness; your house shall possess your possessions (Obad. 1:17). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that *Jesus Christ* will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire (Matt. 3:11), that you may inherit the desolate heritage's (Is. 49:8). With His holy oil may the Lord anoint you and by His hand you shall be established; by His arm you shall be strengthened. Your enemies shall not outwit you, nor the son of wickedness afflict you. God will beat down your foes before your face, and plague those who hate you. His faithfulness and His mercy shall be with you, and in His holy name your horn shall be exalted (Ps. 89:20-24). His covenant shall stand firm with you (Ps. 89:28). For the Lord will go before you, and the God of Israel will be your rear quard (ls. 52:12). Holy Holy, Lord God Almighty, who was and is and is to come! (Rev. 4:8)

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13), for you are washed, you are sanctified, you are justified in the name of the <u>Lord Jesus</u> and by the Spirit of our God (1 Cor. 6:11), in His precious name we pray that you shall be holy (Rev. 22:11) and receive the reward (Rev. 22:12), that you may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter through the gates into the city (Rev. 22:14). May you be people of holy conduct, godliness (2 Pet. 3:11) and honorable (1 Pet. 2:12). Let you, of your own free will (Lev. 19:5), by the mercies of God present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God (Rom. 12:1), being transformed by the renewing of your minds (Rom. 12:2), sanctified by the Holy Spirit (Rom. 15:16), glorifying God in your body, mind, soul and spirit (1 Cor. 6:20) for the kingdom of God is not food and drink, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit (Rom. 14:17). As the elect of God, holy and beloved, may you put on tender mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, long suffering; bearing with one another, and forgiving one another (Col. 3:12-13), putting on love which is the bond of perfection (Col. 3:14) and let the peace of God rule in your hearts (Col. 3:15) and the word of <u>Christ</u> dwell in you richly in all wisdom (Col. 3:16). May you be

blameless, as a steward of God, not self-willed, not quick-tempered, not given to wine, nor violent, not greedy for money, but hospitable, a lover of what is good, sober-minded, just, holy, self-controlled, holding fast the faithful word, being of sound doctrine (Titus 1:7-9). Remember Your covenant, O Lord (Ezek. 16:60). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that Jehovah-Raah, the Lord our Shepherd (Ps. 23:1) will put His laws into your hearts and in your minds He will write them. Your sins and your lawless deeds He will remember no more (Heb. 10:16-17). Let you have the boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus (Heb. 9:12). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray you will sanctify (Eph. 5:6) your house and carry out the rubbish from the temple of the Holy Spirit, your bodies (1 Cor. 6:19). May you sanctify and cleanse yourselves with the washing of water by the word, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that you should be holy and without blemish (Eph. 5:26-27). Let you draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having your hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and your bodies washed with pure water (Heb. 10:22). Let you gird up the loin of your minds, be sober, and rest your hope fully upon the grace of God (1 Pet. 1:13) laying aside all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor (Eph. 4:31), malice, quile, hypocrisy, envy, and all evil speaking as newborn babes, desiring the pure milk of the word, that you may grow (1 Pet. 2:1-2); but also coming to the Lord as a living stone, being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ (1 Pet. 2:4-5); not using your liberty as a cloak for vice, but as servants of God (1 Pet. 2:16), acceptable to God and approved by men (Rom. 14:18), that you will be fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God (Eph. 2:19). Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed you with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in *Christ Jesus* (Eph. 1:3). HOLINESS TO THE LORD! (Ex. 39:30)

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13), whose name alone is the Lord, who is the Most High over all the earth (Ps. 83:18), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will not limit the Holy One of Israel, but remember His power (Ps. 78:41-42). His right hand and His holy arm have gained Him victory (Ps. 98:1). He has sent redemption to you. He has commanded His covenant forever: Holy and awesome is His name (Ps. 111:9). The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding (Prov. 9:10). Being partakers of the heavenly calling (Heb. 3:1), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will have an anointing from the Holy One, and know all things (1 John 2:20), that light, insight, perception, intelligence, understanding, and wisdom be found in you (Dan. 5:11) Amplified. Let you build yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit, keeping yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> to eternal life (Jude 1:20-21). God has called you with a holy calling, according to

His own purpose and grace which was given to you in *Christ Jesus* before time began (2 Tim. 1-9). The grace of the Lord *Jesus Christ*, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you (2 cor. 13:14). And whatever you do in word or deed, let you do all in the name of the Lord *Jesus*, giving thanks to God the Father through Him (Col. 3:17). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will see the glory of God (Acts 7:55) and with all boldness you will speak His word (Acts 4:29), for it is not you that speak but the Holy Spirit within you (Mark 13:11). According to the faith of God's elect and the acknowledgment of the truth which is according to godliness (Titus 1:1), let you go from strength to strength (Ps. 84:7) and walk in the fear of the Lord and the comfort of the Holy Spirit (Acts 9:31), serving *Christ* in these things and are acceptable to God and approved by men (Rom. 14:18). You are Holy People, the Redeemed of the Lord (Is. 62:12). May our Lord God consecrate you that you may minister to Him as priests (Ex. 30:30). Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory! (Is. 6:3)

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline, your house and all of your people; by the blood of the lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space by the overpowering presence of God, who has made his home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Thess. 5:23). As a vessel of honor (Rom. 9:21), we continue petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to you according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to you (Luke 11:9). In *Jesus'* (John 16:23) name so be it! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever!
