



## Holiness

How great are His signs, and how mighty His wonders! His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and His dominion is from generation to generation (Dan. 4:3). Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, the living bread which came down from heaven (John 6:41), we lift up you and your entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to the Father (Math. 6:9), all of your family (Acts 13:26), all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all your natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of your spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2). In the mighty and awesome name of **Jesus Christ**, the door to salvation (John 10:9), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for you, your posterity (Prov. 11:21) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). The words that **Christ**, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to you and your family (Acts 13:26) are spirit, and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our **Lord Jesus Christ** (1 Cor. 15:57)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23, John 14:13) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), by the precious blood of **Christ**, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the grace of the **Lord Jesus Christ**, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all (2 Cor. 13:14). But know that the Lord has set apart for Himself him who is godly; the Lord will hear when we call to Him (Ps. 4:3). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we call to the Lord our God (Gen. 4:26) and ask in the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), His great and awesome name (Ps. 99:3), that according to the Spirit of holiness (Rom. 1:4), the Lord will choose you, and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and cause (Ps. 65:4) you to come near to Him (Deut. 21:5); that the Lord will establish you and your family (Acts 13:26) as a holy people to Himself (Deut. 28:9). He will set you and your family (Acts 13:26) high in praise, in name and in honor, that you may be holy to the Lord your God, just as He has spoken (Deut. 26:19). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the Lord will set His love upon you, and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and choose (Deut. 7:7) you and your family (Acts 13:26) for Himself, a special treasure (Deut. 14:2), and redeem you and your people (Ps. 148:14) from the house of bondage (Deut. 7:8). May God separate you and your family (Acts 13:26) that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) shall be holy and belong to God (Lev. 20:26). Oh Lord, send out Your light and Your truth (Ps. 43:3)! Let Jehovah-Raah, the Lord our Shepherd (Ps. 23:1), lead you, and your house

(Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), by still waters (Ps 23:2) and bring you and your family (Acts 13:26) to His holy hill and to His tabernacle (Ps. 43:3). May the Lord lead you and your people (Ps. 148:14) in His righteousness and make your way straight before your face (Ps. 5:8). May the God of Israel give strength and power to you (Ps. 68:35), and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and cause you and your family (Acts 13:26) to approach Him, that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) may dwell in His courts (Ps. 93:13). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you, and your people (Ps. 148:14) will be satisfied with the goodness of His house, of His holy temple (Ps. 65:4); that you and your family (Acts 13:26) will eat the bread of God, both the most holy and the holy (Lev. 21:22) and remember His covenant always, the word which He commanded, for a thousand generations (1 Chr. 16:15) and not conceal the words of the Holy One (Job 6:10) but instead come into His house in the multitude of His mercy and in fear of Him you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) shall worship toward His holy temple (Ps. 5:7). Blessed be the Lord God of Israel from everlasting to everlasting (1 Chr. 16:36)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 14:13), who gave Himself for your sins, that He might deliver you from this present evil age, according to the will of your God and Father (Gal. 1:4-5), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you, and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), will wash your hands in innocence (Ps. 26:6), you will not gather your soul together with sinners, nor your life with bloodthirsty men (Ps. 26:9). In His mercy may God lead you, and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), whom He has redeemed, guide you and your people (Ps. 148:14) in His strength to His holy habitation (Ex. 15:13). May God give to you and yours His counsel, and let your heart also instruct yourselves in the night season. Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) set the Lord always before yourselves so that He will be at your right hand and you shall not be moved (Ps. 16:7-8). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that He may keep you, from corruption and show you the path of life. In His presence is fullness of joy, at His right hand are pleasures forevermore (Ps. 16:10-11). Let you and yours cleanse yourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God (2 Cor. 7:1). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you, and your people (Ps. 148:14) will walk uprightly (Ps. 84:11), work righteousness (Heb. 11:33), speaking truth in your hearts (Ps. 15:2), stirring up love and good works (Heb. 10:24), exhorting one another (Heb. 10:25), not backbiting with your tongues, nor doing evil to your neighbors, nor taking up a reproach against your friends (Ps. 15:3). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you, and your people (Ps. 148:14) will distinguish between holy and unholy, and between unclean and clean and that you will teach your children God's statutes (Lev. 10:10-11); that

you will revere your mother and your father, and keep His Sabbaths (Lev. 19:3). Let you and yours sanctify yourselves and be holy, neither shall you defile yourselves (Lev. 11:44), nor profane His holy name (Lev. 20:3). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) you, and your people (Ps. 148:14) will have clean hands and pure hearts; you and yours will not lift up your souls to an idol, nor swear deceitfully and you and your family (Acts 13:26) shall receive blessing from the Lord, and righteousness from the God of your salvation (Ps. 24:4-5). You, shall abide in His tabernacle, and dwell in His holy hill (Ps. 15:1). You and your family (Acts 13:26) shall have a song and gladness of heart to come into the mountain of the Lord, to the mighty One of Israel (Is. 30:29). The nursing child shall play by the cobra's hole, and the weaned child shall put his hand in the viper's den. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all of His mountain, for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord as the waters cover the sea (Is. 11:8-9). Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised in the city of our God, in His holy mountain (Ps. 48:1). God reigns over the nations; God sits on His holy throne (Ps. 47:8). Exalt the Lord our God, and worship at His holy hill; for the Lord our God is holy (Ps. 99:9)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 14:13), the Son of Man which has come to seek and to save that which was lost (Luke 19:10), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you, and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), shall seek the Lord and His strength; seek His face ever more, glory in His holy name and let your hearts rejoice (1 Chr. 16:10-11) for the joy of the Lord is your strength (Neh. 8:10). Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) look to your maker, and your eyes will have respect for the Holy One of Israel (Is. 17:7). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you, shall hear the words of the book, and your eyes shall see out of obscurity and out of darkness, that you shall increase your joy in the Lord and rejoice in the Holy One of Israel (Is. 29:18-19). Where you and your family (Acts 13:26) have erred in spirit you shall come to understanding, and where you have murmured you shall learn doctrine (Is. 29:24). In returning and rest shall you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) be saved; in quietness and in confidence shall be your strength (Is. 30:15). May the Lord give you and your people (Ps. 148:14) understanding according to His word (Ps. 119:169). Let the God of hope (Rom. 15:13) teach you, and yours His way so that you will walk in His truth; and unite your hearts to fear His name that you and your family (Acts 13:26) will glorify His name forevermore (Ps. 86:11-12). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will rejoice in the Lord and give thanks at the remembrance of His holy name (Ps. 97:12) and triumph in His praise (Ps. 106:47), because you have trusted in His holy name (Zeph. 3:12). Let His mercy be upon you (Ps. 51:1), and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21).

His praise endures forever (Ps. 111:10). The Lord God is your Father; your Redeemer from Everlasting is His name (Is. 63:16)! There is none holy like the Lord, for there is none besides Him, nor is there any rock like our God (1 Sam. 2:2)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 14:13), who manifested God's name to men (John 17:6), according to all that the Lord has bestowed on you, and the great goodness toward your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), which He has bestowed on you according to His mercies, according to the multitude of His loving kindnesses (Is. 63:7), let the power of the Highest overshadow you (Luke 1:35) and your house (Luke 1:35). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that your heavenly Father will give (Luke 11:13) the gift of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:38), pouring out His Spirit on you, and yours abundantly through **Jesus Christ** your Savior (Titus 3:6) and the love of God also be poured out in your hearts by the Holy Spirit (Rom. 5:5). May the God of hope fill you and your family (Acts 13:26) with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit (Rom. 15:13). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the Helper (John 15:26), the Comforter the Holy Spirit (John 4:26), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:16-17), will teach you, and your family (Acts 13:26) all things and bring to your remembrance all things; that you will have the peace that only **Jesus** gives (John 14:26-27) and you may have His joy fulfilled in yourselves (John 17:13). For your peace will be like a river, and your righteousness like the waves of the sea (Is. 48:18). According to His righteousness (Ps. 35:24) may the God of heaven and the God of earth (Gen. 24:3) make known to you, and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), the ways of life, that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will be full of joy in His presence (Acts 2:28), and bring you and your family (Acts 13:26) to His holy mountain, and make you and your people (Ps. 148:14) joyful in His house of prayer (Is. 56:7). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) shall put your trust in God and you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) shall possess the land, and shall inherit His holy mountain (Is. 57:13). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) drink freely from the waters of life (Rev. 22:17). There shall be deliverance, and there shall be holiness; your house shall possess your possessions (Obad. 1:17). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that **Jesus Christ** will baptize you, and your family (Acts 13:26) with the Holy Spirit and with fire (Matt. 3:11), that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) may inherit the desolate heritage's (Is. 49:8). With His holy oil may the Lord anoint you and your people (Ps. 148:14) and by His hand you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) shall be established; by His arm you and your family (Acts 13:26) shall be strengthened. Your enemies shall not outwit you, nor the son of wickedness afflict you and your people (Ps. 148:14). God will beat down

your foes before your face, and plague those who hate you and your house. His faithfulness and His mercy shall be with you, and your family (Acts 13:26), and in His holy name your horn shall be exalted (Ps. 89:20-24). His covenant shall stand firm with you (Ps. 89:28) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). For the Lord will go before you, and the God of Israel will be your rear guard (Is. 52:12). Holy! Holy! Holy! Lord God Almighty, who was and is and is to come (Rev. 4:8)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 14:13), for you are washed, you are sanctified, you are justified in the name of the **Lord Jesus** and by the Spirit of our God (1 Cor. 6:11), in His precious name we pray (James 5:16) that you, and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), shall be holy (Rev. 22:11) and receive the reward (Rev. 22:12), that you and your family (Acts 13:26) may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter through the gates into the city (Rev. 22:14). May you, and your family (Acts 13:26) be people of holy conduct, godliness (2 Pet. 3:11) and honorable (1 Pet. 2:12). Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14), of your own free will (Lev. 19:5), by the mercies of God present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God (Rom. 12:1), being transformed by the renewing of your minds (Rom. 12:2), sanctified by the Holy Spirit (Rom. 15:16), glorifying God in your body, mind, soul and spirit (1 Cor. 6:20) for the kingdom of God is not food and drink, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit (Rom. 14:17). As the elect of God, holy and beloved, may you and your family (Acts 13:26) put on tender mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, long suffering; bearing with one another, and forgiving one another (Col. 3:12-13), putting on love which is the bond of perfection (Col. 3:14) and let the peace of God rule in your hearts (Col. 3:15) and the word of **Christ** dwell in you richly in all wisdom (Col. 3:16). May you and your people (Ps. 148:14) be blameless, as a steward of God, not self-willed, not quick-tempered, not given to wine, nor violent, not greedy for money, but hospitable, a lover of what is good, sober-minded, just, holy, self-controlled, holding fast the faithful word, being of sound doctrine (Titus 1:7-9). Remember Your covenant, O Lord (Ezek. 16:60)! In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Jehovah-Raah, the Lord our Shepherd (Ps. 23:1) will put His laws into your hearts and in your minds He will write them. Your sins and your lawless deeds He will remember no more (Heb. 10:16-17). Let you, and your family (Acts 13:26) have the boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of **Jesus** (Heb. 9:12). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) you and yours will sanctify (Eph. 5:6) your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and carry out the rubbish from the temple of the Holy Spirit, your bodies (1 Cor. 6:19). May you sanctify and cleanse yourselves with the washing of water by the word, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but

that you should be holy and without blemish (Eph. 5:26-27). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having your hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and your bodies washed with pure water (Heb. 10:22). Let you, and your people (Ps. 148:14) gird up the loin of your minds, be sober, and rest your hope fully upon the grace of God (1 Pet. 1:13) laying aside all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor (Eph. 4:31), malice, guile, hypocrisy, envy, and all evil speaking as newborn babes, desiring the pure milk of the word, that you may grow (1 Pet. 2:1-2); but also coming to the Lord as a living stone, being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through **Jesus Christ** (1 Pet. 2:4-5); not using your liberty as a cloak for vice, but as servants of God (1 Pet. 2:16), acceptable to God and approved by men (Rom. 14:18), that you, and your family (Acts 13:26) will be fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God (Eph. 2:19). Blessed be the God and Father of our **Lord Jesus Christ**, who has blessed you, with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in **Christ Jesus** (Eph. 1:3). HOLINESS TO THE LORD (Ex. 39:30)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 14:13), whose name alone is the Lord, who is the Most High over all the earth (Ps. 83:18), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you, and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), will not limit the Holy One of Israel, but remember His power (Ps. 78:41-42). His right hand and His holy arm have gained Him victory (Ps. 98:1). He has sent redemption to you and your family (Acts 13:26). He has commanded His covenant forever: Holy and awesome is His name (Ps. 111:9)! The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding (Prov. 9:10). Being partakers of the heavenly calling (Heb. 3:1), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you, and your people (Ps. 148:14) will have an anointing from the Holy One, and know all things (1 John 2:20), that light, insight, perception, intelligence, understanding, and wisdom be found in you and yours (Dan. 5:11 Amp.). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) build yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit, keeping yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our **Lord Jesus Christ** to eternal life (Jude 1:20-21). God has called you, and your family (Acts 13:26) with a holy calling, according to His own purpose and grace which was given to you in **Christ Jesus** before time began (2 Tim. 1-9). The grace of the **Lord Jesus Christ**, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you (2 Cor. 13:14) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). And whatever you do in word or deed, let you and your family (Acts 13:26) do all in the name of the **Lord Jesus**, giving thanks to God the Father through Him (Col. 3:17). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you, and

your family (Acts 13:26) will see the glory of God (Acts 7:55) and with all boldness you will speak His word (Acts 4:29), for it is not you that speak but the Holy Spirit within you (Mark 13:11). According to the faith of God's elect and the acknowledgment of the truth which is according to godliness (Titus 1:1), let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) go from strength to strength (Ps. 84:7) and walk in the fear of the Lord and the comfort of the Holy Spirit (Acts 9:31), serving **Christ** in these things and are acceptable to God and approved by men (Rom. 14:18). You, and your family (Acts 13:26) be Holy People, the Redeemed of the Lord (Is. 62:12). May our Lord God consecrate you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) may minister to Him as priests (Ex. 30:30). Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory (Is. 6:3)!

As a fellow worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9) , abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and all of your people (Ps. 148:14); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time (Is. 9:7, Is. 59:21) so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Judges 18:6, Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our **Lord Jesus Christ** (1 Thess. 5:23). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, the Son of living God (John 10:36, Matt. 16:16), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2)! In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. God said it. We believe it. It is settled forever. In **Jesus'** name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! Amen!
