



Children and Grandchildren Blessing and Impartation

Lord, we come to Your gates with thanksgiving, and into Your courts with praise (Ps. 100:4). Blessed be the Lord our God who daily loads our children and our grandchildren with benefits and blessings. We thank you and bless Your holy name. (Ps. 100:4) In the name of **Jesus Christ**, make our children and our grandchildren one with the Holy Spirit and one with you Lord (John 17:21). Rain down upon them, oh Lord, rain upon them all the days of their life (Ps. 72:6). Let them feel your love from the day of conception. In the name of **Jesus Christ**, let your love encompass them, surround them, and comfort them even in their mother's womb throughout all their days (Zep 3:17, Rom. 8:39).

For You, Lord, formed their inward parts; You covered them in their mother's womb. We will praise You, O God, for they are fearfully *and* wonderfully made; marvelous are Your works. Their frame was not hidden from You, when they were made in secret, *and* skillfully wrought in the lowest parts of the earth. Your eyes, Lord, saw their substance, being yet unformed. And in Your Book, they all were written, the days fashioned for them, when *as yet there were* none of them. How precious also are Your thoughts to them, O God! How great is the sum of them! (Ps. 139:13-17).

God of mercy and patience (Ps. 145:8) lift our blood line up out of the horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set our feet upon a rock, and

establish our steps (Ps. 40:2). Grant to our children and our grandchildren that their steps be established in the Lord from the very first step they take (Ps. 37:23). Grant to them according to the riches of Your glory to be strengthened with might through Your Spirit in the inner being (Eph3:16-19) even when they are being wonderfully knit together in their mother's womb. (Is. 44:24) Create in them a clean heart (Ps. 51:10-11), cleanse them from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God (2 Cor. 7:1) purge our children and our grandchildren of all generational sin and curses by the blood of **Jesus Christ** Your Son (1 John 1:7) our Redeemer (Gal. 3:13). Transform them into a new creation (2 Cor. 5:17) through our **Lord Jesus Christ** as they grow older, not being conformed to this world but being transformed by the renewing of their minds to prove what is the good and acceptable will of God for their lives (Rom. 12:2); being changed into the image of **Christ** (Rom. 8:29) and as **Christ** is so are they in this world (1 John 4:17). As our children and our grandchildren grow older let them grow in both favor and high esteem with both God and man (Prov. 3:3). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, together, we declare old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. (2 Cor. 5:17) As far as the east is from the west, so far has God removed transgressions of our bloodline from our children and our grandchildren (Ps. 103-12). When our children and our grandchildren sin let them be quick to confess their sin to their heavenly Father for, He is faithful to forgive them of all sin and cleanse them of all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9).

Blessed be the God and Father of our **Lord Jesus Christ**, who blesses our children and our grandchildren with every spiritual

blessing in the heavenly places in **Christ**. They are chosen by God before the foundation of the world, that they shall be holy and without blame before God in love. (Eph. 1:3) In the name of **Jesus Christ** we pray that from the day of their birth the **Lord Jesus Christ** be continually with them, their light shall break forth like the morning, their healing shall spring forth speedily, and their righteousness shall go before them (Is. 58:8). Their light (in **Christ**) shall dawn in the darkness, and their darkness shall be as the noonday. The Lord will guide them continually and satisfy their soul in drought (Is. 58:10-11). The Lord will make their way straight before God's face (Ps. 5:8). From the day of conception our children and our grandchildren shall delight in the Lord and He will give them the desires of their heart (Ps. 37:4) and fulfill all their purpose (Ps. 20:4). They shall raise up the foundations of many generations; and they shall be called the Repairer of the Breach, the Restorer of streets to dwell in (Is. 58:12). The Lord shall cause showers to come down in their season, there shall be showers of blessing upon our children and our grandchildren (Ezek. 34:26). May God make our children and our grandchildren increase and abound in love so that He may establish their heart blameless in holiness before our God and Father (1 Thess. 3:12-13).

In the name of **Jesus Christ**, Lord I ask you to impart the gift of **Wisdom** (Rom 1:11) to our children and our grandchildren. Wisdom and knowledge will be the stability of their times, and the strength of salvation; the fear of the Lord is His treasure (Is. 33:6) and the wisdom of God be their life (Eccl. 7:12). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, abiding in Him and Him in us, we pray and impart to them that they walk in the

wisdom of God (Col. 4:5) every day of their lives always making choices for life and blessing (Deut. 30:19). And this we pray, that their love may abound still more and more in knowledge and all discernment, that they may approve the things that are excellent, that they may be sincere and without offense till the day of **Christ**, being filled with the fruits of righteousness which *are* by **Jesus Christ**, to the glory and praise of God (Phil. 1:9-11).

In the name of **Jesus Christ**, Lord I ask you to impart the gift of **Revelation & Teaching**, fill our children and our grandchildren with the Rama of God. Give them the word of knowledge (1 Cor. 12:8). For this reason abiding in **Jesus Christ** and Him in us, even before they are conceived, we do not cease to pray for our children and our grandchildren, and to ask that they may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that they may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing *Him*, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy; giving thanks to the Father who has qualified them to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light (Col. 1:9-12).

In the name of **Jesus Christ**, Lord we ask you to impart the gift of **Faith** (1 Cor. 12:9). Father of Glory (Eph. 1:17) we pray that You give our children and our grandchildren an abundance of faith from the day that they are born, may the spirit of faith (2 Cor. 4:13) fill them completely and may they increase in faith as they grow in age (Luke 17:5). Give them

the faith of a mustard seed (Math. 17:20). May they delight in the fear of the LORD, and they shall not judge by what they see with their physical eyes, nor decide by what they hear with their physical ears (Is. 11:3); but walk by faith and not by sight (2 Cor. 5:7). Let them receive **Jesus Christ** as their Lord early, in the days of their youth (Eccl. 12:1). As they have therefore received **Christ Jesus the Lord**, let them walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as they are taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving (Col. 2:6-8).

In the name of **Jesus Christ**, Lord we ask you to impart the gift of **Healings and of Working of Miracles** (1 Cor. 12:9-10); **the Spirit of Revival** (Eph. 4:11); **the Power of Refreshing of the Spirit** (Acts 4:36, Heb. 10L25); **the Power to Cast Out Evil Spirits** (Mark 16:17) and the gift of **Ministry** (Rom. 12:7) to them. Give them the desire in their hearts to walk in your ways (Deut. 10:12), the words to speak in due season (Prov. 15:23) and the anointing (1 John 2:27) to heal, work miracles, encourage and minister in all their gifts and give them such faith in God that doubt will never enter their heart (Mark 11:23) to do the works that you **Lord Jesus** did and even more (John 14:12).

In the name of **Jesus Christ**, Lord we ask you to impart the gift of **Holiness** to our children and grandchildren. Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify our children and our grandchildren completely from the day of their inception; their whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our **Lord Jesus Christ**. (1 Thess. 5:23)

In the name of **Jesus Christ**, Lord we ask you to impart the gift of **Discernment** (1 Cor. 12:10), a double portion of discernment to them. Even at an early age open their eyes to discern between what is God and what is from the power of Satan, what is light and what is dark (Acts 26:18), what is good and what is evil (Rom 16:19) and what is right in the eyes of the Lord our God (Deut. 12:28). May they discern between the righteous and the wicked, between him that serves God and him that serves him not (Mal. 3:18) and not be deceived by him who serves God with words only, false prophets, false apostles, deceitful workers disguised as angels of light (2 Cor. 11:14). Even as they enter this world and leave their mother's womb deliver them from the power of darkness and convey them into the kingdom of the Son of Your love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins. (Col. 1:13-14). Open their eyes, turn *them* from darkness to light, and *from* the power of Satan unto God (Acts 26:18) and do not allow them to be moved (Ps. 46:5) but reveal to them the strategies, schemes, tricks and snares of the enemy (2 Tim. 2:26). Moreover, do not let them fall into reproach and the snare of the devil (1 Timothy 3:7); do not let the cares of this world and the deceitfulness of riches choke the word so they become unfruitful (Matthew 13:22); as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, do not let their minds be corrupted from the simplicity that is in **Christ** (2 Corinthians 11:3). As they grow older let them increase in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men (Luke 2:52). In **Christ** we pray they will give all diligence to add to their faith virtue, to virtue knowledge, to knowledge self-control, to self-control perseverance, to perseverance godliness, to godliness brotherly

kindness, and to brotherly kindness love. Let these things be theirs from birth and abound in them all their days. We pray they *will be* neither barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our **Lord Jesus Christ** but be even more diligent to make their call and election sure, that they will never stumble; and an entrance will be supplied to them abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our **Lord and Savior Jesus Christ** (2 Peter 1:5-11).

In the name of **Jesus Christ**, Lord I ask You to impart the gift of **Love** (Rom. 5:5) to our children and our grandchildren. Our children and our grandchildren shall be blessed with an outpouring of love (Rom. 5:5), their cup shall run over (Ps. 23:5). In **Christ** we pray that our God and Father will grant our children and our grandchildren, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit; that **Christ** may dwell in their hearts by faith; that they, being rooted and grounded in agape love, may be able to comprehend with all saints what *is* the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; and to know the love of **Christ**, which passes knowledge, that they might be filled with all the fullness of Love (Eph. 3:16-19). May our children and grandchildren abide in the love of **Jesus Christ** and our Father in heaven all the days of their lives, having a heart knowledge of that love (John 15:19). Father God, we ask in the mighty name of our Lord and Savior, **Jesus Christ**, make us a great family; bless our children and our grandchildren and all our posterity and make our name great; and make us a blessing. Bless those who bless our family, curse him who curses us; and bless all the families of the earth through our **bloodline** (Genesis 12:2-3).

In the name of **Jesus Christ**, Lord I ask you to impart the gift of **Peace** (John 14:27) to our children and grandchildren. The work of righteousness shall be their peace, the effect of righteousness, quietness and assurance forever (Isa 32:17). They shall dwell in a peaceful habitation, in secure dwellings, and in quiet resting places (Isa 32:17-18). We pray the peace of God rules in their hearts all the days of their life (Col 3:15). Let them walk in the supernatural peace that **Jesus** gives (John 14:27) all the days of their lives in all circumstances never succumbing to the spirit of fear knowing with a deep heart knowledge the Spirit of Power (2 Tim. 1:7) being confident that He who is in them is greater than he who is in the world (1 John 4:4).

In the name of **Jesus Christ**, Lord I ask you to impart the gift of **Valor; of Tongues** (1 Cor. 12:10) and **Prophecy** (1 Cor. 12:10) to our children and grandchildren. May all our children and our grandchildren be filled with the Holy Spirit in their mother's womb and speak the word of God with boldness from the day they utter their first word in this world (Acts 4:31). Give them an intimate prayer language to speak to God of mysteries only their spirit knows (1 Cor. 14:2), that they might be built up and edified in the Spirit (1 Cor. 14:4) and gain revelation of the deep secrets of God (Jer. 33:3). Also give them a tongue of edification for the Church and the ability to interpret. Let them desire to prophecy and may they walk in the gift of prophecy speaking edification and exhortation and comfort to men (1 Cor. 14:3).

In the name of **Jesus Christ**, Lord I ask you to impart the gift of **Giving** to our children and our grandchildren. Give them a generous heart and a burning desire to give to the Lord above and beyond what is commanded. In **Jesus'** name I pray our children and our grandchildren will be tithers from the day they earn their first cent and reap the benefits of being a tither. The LORD of hosts will open for them the windows of heaven and pour out for them *such* blessing that *there will not be room enough to receive it*. And God Almighty will rebuke the devourer for their sakes, so he will not destroy the fruit of their labor (Mal. 3:10-11). The Lord God Almighty shall give our children and our grandchildren the power to get wealth (Deut. 8:8), great shall our children and our grandchildren be on the earth and wealth and riches shall be in their house (Ps. 112:2-3). In **Jesus'** name I pray our children and our grandchildren will honor the Lord with their possessions and with the first fruits of all their increase, so shall their storage places be filled with plenty, and their vats shall be overflowing with new wine (Prov. 3:9-10). Good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give to them (Luke 6:38). The Lord shall command the blessing upon them in their bank accounts and in all that they undertake (Deut. 28:8). He will bless them wherever they may be (Deut. 28:3). And the Lord will grant them plenty of goods and make them have a surplus of prosperity (Deut. 28:11). The Lord shall open to them His good treasury, the heavens, to give the rain in its season, the former rain and the latter rain and to bless all the work of their hands; and they shall lend to many people, but they shall not borrow. And the Lord shall make them the head, and not the tail; and they shall be above only, and they shall not be beneath (Deut. 28:12-13 (AMP)).

God chose our children and our grandchildren and appointed them even before the earth was formed that they should go and bear fruit, and that their fruit should remain, that whatever they ask the Father in **Jesus'** name God will give it to them (John 15:16). The peace of God which surpasses all understanding, will guard their hearts and minds through **Christ Jesus** (Phil 4:6). Father of glory raise our children and our grandchildren up for Yourself as faithful priests who shall do according to what is in Your heart and in Your mind. Build them a sure house, and they shall walk before You anointed forever (1 Sam 2:35), walking in unity with God the Father (Eph3:6); walking in love as **Christ** has also loved them (Eph. 5:2). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, they shall be a fountain of life, a bubbling spring of everlasting life (John 4:14), walking as a child of light (Eph5:8). The Lord will arise over them and His glory will be seen upon them. The Gentiles shall come to their light, and the kings to the brightness of their rising (Is. 60:2-3). They shall see and become radiant, and their heart shall swell with joy; because the abundance of the sea shall be turned to them (Is. 60:5).

In the name of **Jesus Christ**, our children and our grandchildren shall go to the house of God with the voice of joy and praise (Ps. 42:4). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, our children and our grandchildren shall be planted in the house of the Lord, they shall flourish in the courts of our God (Ps. 92:13). In **Jesus'** name they shall dwell in the secret place of the Most-High, they shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty (Ps. 91:1). God shall cover them with His feathers and under His wings they shall take refuge (Ps. 91:4). In the

name of **Jesus Christ**, they shall make the Most-High their dwelling place (Ps. 91:9), they shall dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of their life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to inquire in His temple (Ps. 27:4).

In the name of **Jesus Christ** God will uphold our children and our grandchildren in their integrity and set them before His face forever (Ps. 41:12). In **Jesus'** name we lift our children and our grandchildren up to You Mighty God and we ask that You make all grace (every favor and earthly blessing) come to them in abundance, so that they may always *and* under all circumstances *and* whatever the need be self-sufficient [possessing enough to require no aid or support and furnished in abundance for every good work and charitable donation] (2 Cor. 9:8 (AMP)).

In the name of **Jesus Christ**, Father, I ask that You pull down any strongholds that the enemy may use against our children and our grandchildren, that You cast down arguments, imaginations and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of **Christ** at a very young age, even from birth (2 Cor10:4:5) Together with **Jesus Christ** our Lord we lose the angels of heaven to minister to our children and our grandchildren (Math. 18:18), to accompany them, defend them, preserve them (Ps. 91*11-12) and provide safety day and night (Ps. 91:11 Amp). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, abiding in **Christ**, we take authority over and we bind on earth and in heaven all the schemes and strategies, words and actions that the enemy sends against our

children and our grandchildren and we put them under the obedience of **Jesus Christ**, (Math. 18:18) under the feet of **Jesus Christ** (1 Cor 15:27).

We do this for now and for all eternity. In the name of **Jesus Christ**, Father God make a hedge around our children and our grandchildren, around their household, and around all that they have on every side (Job 1:9). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, may the angel of the Lord encamp all around our children and our grandchildren (Ps. 34:7) and deliver them from every evil work and preserve them for Your heavenly kingdom (2 Tim. 4:18).

By the authority of **Jesus** and His precious blood, in **Christ** we bind you, Satan, according to Ephesians 6:12 and break your powers over our children and our grandchildren, we lose them from your hold and destroy your works and your assignment in **Jesus'** name. In **Christ** we take authority over all the power of the enemy and we command it not to bear any fruit in the lives of our children and our grandchildren from birth and forevermore. We speak to you Satan, in the mighty and precious name of **Jesus** of Nazareth. We take authority over you and bind all demonic spirits assigned to our children and our grandchildren. We command you Satan to loose them and let them go free in the name of **Jesus**. We demand that you stop your maneuvers against our children and our grandchildren. They are covered by the blood of **Jesus**, the precious Lamb slain for them; they are the children of the righteous and God will deliver them (Prov. 11:21). We execute the written judgment of God in 1 Corinthians 3:17 that declares that anyone that defiles our children and

grandchildren, who are the temple of God, God will destroy them, this honor have all His saints (Ps. 149:9).

Thank You, Father, you have given to us the keys to the kingdom of heaven, and whatever we bind on earth, shall be bound in heaven, and whatever we loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

(Math. 16:19) Father, in **Jesus'** name, abiding in **Jesus Christ** and Him in us, as one we bind and break off of our children and our grandchildren all principalities, powers, rulers of darkness of this world, and spiritual wickedness in high places (Eph. 6:12), all occult activity -- curses, witchcraft, hexes, divination and sorcery and all soul power that does not glorify the **Lord Jesus Christ**. In the precious name of **Jesus Christ**, we bind the kings with chains, and the nobles with fetters of iron; to execute on them the written judgment - this honor have all His saints (Ps. 149:9). In the name of **Jesus** and by the authority of **Jesus**, together we destroy the works of the enemy over our children and our grandchildren and come against any soul power or emotional ties that does not glorify our **Lord Jesus Christ**. For this purpose, the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil (John 3:8).

I pray Father, that our children and our grandchildren will continue in the faith firmly established and steadfast, grounded and settled, and that they not be moved away from the hope of the gospel which they have heard (Col.1:23). Sanctify them in Your truth; Your Word is truth (John 17:17). May our children and grandchildren delight in the Word of God, treasure it, meditate on it day and night (Ps. 119:48), and

keep the Word of God in the midst of their heart for it is the substance of their life and brings health to their flesh (Prov. 4:20-22) and strength to their bones (Prov. 3:8). In **Christ** we pray that our children and our grandchildren receive Your words of wisdom, they treasure your commands within their heart, they are quick to obey Your Word, they incline their ear to Your words, apply their heart to understanding, cry out for discernment and lift up their voices for knowledge (Prov. 2:1-3) for it is life to their soul and grace to their neck (Prov. 3:22-24), length of days, long life (Prov. 3:1-2), and days will be multiplied, and years of life will be added to them (Prov. 3:2). It is life and peace to their soul, health to their flesh, strength to their bones (Prov. 3:8), and their sleep will be sweet (Prov. 3:24). They shall have a long, fruitful, healthy, prosperous and satisfying life (Ps. 91:6), preaching the gospel and bearing fruit until the end of their days (Ps. 92:14), and serving our **Lord Jesus Christ** through all eternity. As their years are so shall their strength be (Deut. 33:25). In **Christ** we pray our beloved children and grandchildren may prosper in all things and be in health, just as their soul prosper. (3 John 1:2).

The Lord bless our children and our grandchildren and watch, guard, *and* keep them; the Lord make His face shine upon them *and* enlighten them and be gracious (kind, merciful, and giving favor) to them; the Lord lift up His [approving] countenance upon them and give them peace (tranquility of heart and life continually). The Lord put His name on our children and grandchildren and bless them” (Num. 6:24-27).

The Lord will go before our children and our grandchildren and the God of Israel will be their rear guard (Is. 52:12). The mercy of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting on our children and our grandchildren and His righteousness to children's children (Ps. 103:17). The LORD shall increase our children and our grandchildren more and more, and their children after them. They *are* blessed of the LORD which made heaven and earth (Ps. 115:14-15). God shall pour His Spirit on our children and our grandchildren and their descendants and His blessing on them and their offspring (Is. 44:3).

The Lord Himself will teach our children and our grandchildren and write His law on their hearts and they shall not depart from it. The Lord will establish them in righteousness and all their days shall be of peace, they will be far from oppression because they will not fear, and terror shall not come near them (Is. 54:13-14) because they have faith in God (Mark 11:22) and trust in the Lord (Philp. 2:24). No weapon formed against them will prosper and every tongue that raises up against them the Lord will condemn because they are not their own, they are bought with a price (1 Cor. 6:19-20), they belong to the **Lord Jesus Christ** and their righteousness is of God (Is. 54:17). They will have faith in God (Mark 11:22) and will not doubt in their heart and whatever they say they will have (Mark 11:23); whatever they ask the Father in prayer they will receive (Mark 11:24), because they shall delight in the Lord and He will give them the desires of their heart (Ps. 37:4) and fulfill all their purpose (Ps. 20:4).

This *is* the covenant we have with God Almighty, creator of the Universe: His Spirit who *dwells* within us, and His words which He has put in our mouth, shall not depart from our mouth, nor from the mouth of our descendants, nor from the mouth of our descendants' descendants, from this time and forevermore (Is. 59:21). We are the redeemed of the Lord and we say so! (Ps. 107:2).

Hallowed be the name of the **Lord Jesus Christ** (Matt. 6:9-10). Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as *it is* in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). Lord, I ask that your will now be done in the lives of our children and our grandchildren, and I thank you (Math. 6:10). May all these blessings and gifts pass down through our bloodline to all our posterity, now and forever.

Thank you, Lord, for watching over Your Word to perform it (Jer. 1:12), for all the promises of God are yes and Amen in **Jesus Christ** our Lord (2 Cor 1/20). God said it, we believe it, it is settled forever, in **Jesus'** name so be it. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen (Matthew 6:13).
