(The Prayer Cloth

In case you are not familiar with prayer cloths, I can vouch that they are very powerful and strong in the Lord. My first experience with a prayer cloth is when my husband had seven tons of Loader come down on his head. Although, through the grace of God, he survived there was brain damage. The doctors kept telling him that he would get better, but we never saw any signs of it. For a full year he basically (in his words) sat in a chair, drooling, and staring into nothingness. Then my brother and his family sent me a prayer cloth with the instructions to put it under his head. I placed it under the sheet where he laid his head every night. Although I was far from God at the time, I obeyed because I knew that my brother and his family were near to God. Anyway, we put the cloth under Gary's sheet and in no time he was off the medication and his head cleared up. God has restored his brain and even the area that was damaged had no lasting effect. We didn't know how it worked, but we were glad that it worked. We had almost given up.

Again my brother and the rest of NPMI prepared several prayer cloths for my sister when she was in ICU

agreement can create a prayer cloth by laying hands on a handkerchief and praying the prayer of faith. We anoint our prayer cloths with olive oil representing the Holy Spirit. We then send the prayer cloth to the sick as a point of contact, with the assurance that God's word has not failed from the time He spoke until this very day. We also send a copy of the healing prayer and a copy of the audio CD of the prayer. We ask the person desiring healing to join us in praying the prayer of faith as well, believing that God's word will not return to him void. During my sister's time in the hospital, I relied on written prayers to speak the word of God over her and the situation. God has promised to watch over His word to see that it is performed. We have sent out many prayer cloths, prayers and CD's and have received reports of miraculous healing.

Something else that we did with great results was cast down the imaginations. First you must take a stand that God's word is the truth regardless of what your eyes see or what your ears hear. After you have resolved in your heart that God's word is the truth, then knowing that His word declares that we are healed by the stripes of

In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), <u>Jesus Christ</u>, we pray the Lord will take away from you beloved all sickness, and will afflict you with none of the terrible diseases of Egypt (Deut. 7:15). In the name of <u>Jesus</u>

<u>Christ</u>, through faith in His name (Acts 3:16), let the blind receive their sight and the lame walk; the lepers be cleansed and the deaf hear; the dead be raised up and the poor have the gospel preached to them. (Matt. 11:5-6)

May the Lord <u>Jesus Christ</u> lay His hand on you beloved and heal you and may every unclean spirit or demon come out of you (Luke 4:40-41). Let every sickness and every disease (Matt. 9:35), all those who are afflicted

than honey to your mouth (Ps. 119-103) that you will rejoice at His word as one who finds great treasure. (Ps. 119-162) Let your heart stand in awe of his word (Ps. 119:160) and your tongue speak of His word, for all His commandments are righteousness. (Ps. 119:172) God creates the fruit of your lips (ls. 57:19), for by your words you beloved will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned. (Matt. 12:37) therefore may the words of your mouth be words of life and blessing (Deut. 30:19). May you have a merry heart for a merry heart does good, like medicine (Prov. 17:22) and he who has a merry heart has a continual feast (Prov. 15:15). Therefore, in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you beloved . (1 Thess. 5:18) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we beseech you beloved whenever you are afraid, trust in the Lord (Ps. 56:3), in God put your trust; do not be afraid. (Ps. 56:11) According to truth (Rom 2:12) may you believe the Word of God and sing His praise. (Ps. 106-12) Let you beloved diligently heed the voice of the Lord your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His

name which is raised up above all other names (Eph. 1:21), we come against the spirits of, and demolish the strongholds of, and cast down the imaginations of, fever, sickness, disease, brokenness, woundedness, blindness, muteness, infirmity, deafness, poison and demon possession, for it is written "by His stripes you are healed" (Is. 53:5). Therefore, let all fever, sickness, disease, brokenness, woundedness, lameness, blindness, muteness, deformity, deafness and unclean spirits be removed from your body (Matt. 21:21). In all your affliction, He, *Jesus Christ*, is afflicted, and the Angel of His Presence saves you; in His love and in His pity He redeems you; and He bears you and carries you all of your days. (Is. 63:9) He was wounded for your transgressions, He was bruised for your iniquities; the chastisement for your peace was upon Him, and by His stripes you beloved are healed. (Is. 53:5) The Lord will make an utter end of it. As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), in *Christ* we command the affliction not to rise up a second time. (Nahum 1:9) According to His own purpose and grace which was given to you beloved in
