suffering a severe stroke. My sister walked out of that hospital whole against all odds. The doctors did not expect her to live, and the prognosis was that if she did live, she would not be able to walk, or talk and she would be paralyzed on her right side. She can walk and talk and has full use of all her limbs. She has no lasting effect from the stroke that she suffered. I don't know what role the prayer cloths had on my sister's recovery, but I certainly am not discounting them.

The scripture reference that describes this practice is Acts 19:11 where many were healed by God through handkerchiefs that Paul prayed over. NKJ Acts 19:11-12 "Now God worked unusual miracles by the hands of Paul, so that even handkerchiefs or aprons were brought from his body to the sick, and the diseases left them and the evil spirits went out of them." Jesus Christ tells us that: "And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover." NKJ Mark 16:17-18 Two or more people in

Jesus (KJV Isaiah 53:5 - But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed), we cast down anything that is contrary to total and complete healing. The scripture reference is KJV 2 Corinthians 10:3-5: "For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;" Therefore, every time someone speaks contrary to complete healing, quietly declare that the Word of God is true and you or your loved one is healed by the stripes of Jesus, releasing the weapons of God to cast down any imagination contrary to that word. Or you could just simply declare Jesus is Lord.

Know that you are not alone. Be Blessed!

with various diseases and torments, and those who are demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics (Matt. 4:24), and all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease (Matt. 1:34) be healed by *Jesus Christ* today. May power go out of Him and heal them all. (Luke 6:19) For *Jesus Christ* is the same yesterday, today, and forever (Heb. 13:8) He, *Jesus Christ*, will seek what was lost and bring back what was driven away, bind up the broken and strengthen the sick. (Ezek. 34:16). For our heart shall rejoice in Him, because we have trusted in His holy name. Let Your mercy, O Lord, be upon us, just as we hope in You. (Ps. 33:21-22)

It is written "For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down imaginations, arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of <u>Christ</u>" (2 Cor. 10:3-5) As a fellow worker in <u>Christ Jesus</u> (Rom. 16;3), abiding in Him (John 15:4-5), and one with Him (John 17:22) and in His the

statutes, for He is the Lord who heals you (Ex. 15:26) and He will not let sin have dominion over you beloved. (Prov. 4:21-22) He will uphold you according to His word, that you beloved may live (and more abundantly); and he will not let you be ashamed of your hope. (Ps. 119-116) Therefore, as an ambassador in chains to *Jesus Christ* (Eph. 6:20), we plead with you beloved to take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to guench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. According to all His wonderful works (Jer 21:2) may **Jesus** Christ help your unbelief (Mark 9:24) and give you utterance, that you may open your mouth boldly, taking the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, speaking boldly, as you ought to speak; praying always

Christ Jesus before time began (2 Tim 1:9) the Lord grant (1 Tim 1;18) your eyes are opened and you see with your eyes, and hear with your ears, and understand with your heart, and return and be healed (ls. 6:10). Let the weak say 'I am strong' (Joel 3:10 15). For according to His promise (2 Pet. 3:13) you shall know that He has healed you beloved (Hosea 11:3) Jesus Christ, who is your redeemer, your savior, and your healer, having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it. (Col. 2:15). Thanks be to God who gives you victory through our Lord *Jesus Christ* (1 Cor. 15:57) and always leads you in triumph through our Lord Jesus Christ. For God has not given you beloved a spirit of fear, but a spirit of power and a spirit of love and a spirit of a sound mind. (2 Tim. 1:7) You are complete in Him, **Jesus Christ**, who is the head of all principalities & powers. Be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. (Eph. 6:10) Great is our Lord, and mighty in power; His understanding is infinite. The Lord lifts up the humble; sing to the Lord (30)

with thanksgiving. (Ps. 147:5-7) The Lord takes pleasure in those who fear Him, in those who hope in His mercy.

Praise the Lord! (Ps. 147:11-12)

In the name of **Jesus Christ**, who is the bread of life (John 6:48), in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you beloved will give attention to God's word, incline your ear to His sayings, and not let His word depart from your eyes, but keep them in the midst of your heart; for they are life to you, and health to all your flesh. May you keep your heart with all diligence, for out of it spring the issues of life. (Prov. 4:20-23) In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will not be wise in your own eyes; but that you fear the Lord and depart from evil. For it will be health to your flesh, and strength to your bones. (Prov. 3:7-8) Let God's word be a lamp to your feet and a light to your path. (Ps. 119-105) For the word of the Lord is true and it is proven. (Ps. 119:116) May the Lord help you beloved meditate on His word through the night watches (Ps. 119-148), direct your steps by His word, and let no iniquity have dominion over you. (Ps. 119-133) May the word of God become sweet to your taste, sweeter
