The Word of God

I am significant because the Word of God says I am the salt and light of the earth according to Matthew 5:13-14 which says:

"You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled under foot by men. "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. Matthew 5:13-14 (NKJV)

I am significant because the Word of God says since I abide in Jesus Christ I bear much fruit according to 1 John 15:5 which says:

"I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. John 15:5 (NKJV)

I am significant because the Word of God says I have been chosen, appointed to bear fruit, that my fruit shall remain and whatever I ask the Father in the name of Jesus I will receive according to John 15:16 which says:

"You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you. John 15:16 (NKJV)

I am significant because the Word of God says I am a witness of Christ according to Acts 1:8 which says:

"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." Acts 1:8 (NKJV)

I am significant because the Word of God says I am the temple of God's, the Holy Spirit dwells in me according to 1 Corinthians 3:16 which says:

Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? 1 Corinthians 3:16 (NKJV)

I am significant because the Word of God says I am a minister of reconciliation and God has committed to me the word of reconciliation according to 2 Corinthians 5:18-19 which says:

Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation, that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation. 2 Corinthians 5:18-19 (NKJV)

I am significant because the Word of God says I am alive and raised up together with Jesus Christ to sit in heavenly places according to Ephesians 2:5-6 which says:

even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,
Ephesians 2:5-6 (NKJV)

I am significant because the Word of God says I am God's coworker according to 2 Corinthians 6:1 which says:

We then, as workers together with Him also plead with you not to receive the grace of God in vain. 2 Corinthians 6:1 (NKJV)

I am significant because I am God's fellow worker according to 1 Corinthians 3:9 which says:

For we are God's fellow workers; you are God's field, you are God's building. 1 Corinthians 3:9 (NKJV)

I am significant because the Word of God says I am God's workmanship, created for good works according to Ephesians 2:10 which says:

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.
Ephesians 2:10 (NKJV)

I am significant because the Word of God says I may approach God with boldness and confidence according to Ephesians 3:11-12 which says:

According to the eternal purpose which He accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord, in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him. Ephesians 3:11-12 (NKJV)

I am significant because the Word of God says I am an ambassador for Christ according to 2 Corinthians 5:20 which says:

Therefore we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God. 2 Corinthians 5:20 (NKJV)

I am significant because the Word of God says I am a holy priest according to 1 Peter 2:5 which says:

You also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. 1 Peter 2:5 (NKJV)
