Our Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. - Romans 10:17. So we defend ourselves with the shield of faith which comes by hearing the word of God. The offensive weapon of the armor that God has given us is the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. In the war for our soul our bullets are the Word of God and the gun is our mouth. I am the branch of Christ, I abide in Jesus Christ and He abides in me according to John 15:4 which says:


"Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. John 15:4

He has delivered us from the power of darkness and translated us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, Colossians 1:13

Since I am in Christ I have been buried, raised and made alive with Christ according to Colossians 2:12-13 which says:

buried with Him in baptism, in which you also were raised with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead. And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses, Colossians 2:12-13

Since I am in Christ I glory in the Lord according to 1 Corinthians 1:30-31 which says: To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. Colossians 1:27

Since I am in Christ I am also circumcised of the sins of the flesh according to Colossians 2:11 which says:

In Him you were also circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of the sins of the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ, Colossians 2:11

Since I am in Christ I have been washed, regenerated and renewed by the Spirit according to Titus 3:5 which says:

not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, Titus 3:5

Since I am in Christ I am consecrated and Jesus and I are brothers according to Hebrews 2:11 which says:

He who consecrates and those who are being consecrated all have one origin. Therefore, he is not ashamed to call them "brothers," Hebrews 2:11 Since I am in Christ I am the righteousness of God according to 2 Corinthians 5:21 which says:

For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him. 2 Corinthians 5:21

Since I am in Christ it is no longer I who live, but Christ in me according to . Galatians 2:20 which says:

"I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me. Galatians 2:20

Since I am in Christ I have been blessed with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places according to Ephesians 1:3 which says:

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, Ephesians 1:3

Since I am in Christ I am chosen by God, holy and without blame before Him in love according to Ephesians 1:4 which says: (22)
