I am the light of the world according to Matthew 5:14, which says:

"You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. Matthew $5:14\ (NKJV)$

I am in Christ Jesus and I am sitting at the right hand of the Father until he makes our enemies our footstool according to Matthew 22:44, which says:

The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies Your footstool" Matthew 22:44 (NKJV)

I am a servant and I am great in the eyes of the Lord according to Matthew 23:11, which says:

"But he who is greatest among you shall be your servant. Matthew 23:11 NKJV)

I am a child of God, born of God according to John 1:12-13, which says:

But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name: who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. John 1:12-13 (NKJV)

I am obedient and love Jesus, I keep His word and Jesus Christ and His Father has made their home in me according to John 14:23-24, which says:

Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him. John 14:23-24 (NKJV)

I am the branch of Christ, I abide in Jesus Christ and He abides in me and I bear much fruit according to John 15:4-5, which says:

"Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. John 15:4-5 (NKJV)

I am called a friend by Christ according to John 15:15, which says:

"No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you. John 15:15 (NKJV)

I am chosen and appointed that I should bear fruit and my fruit shall remain according to John 15:16, which says:

"You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you. John 15:16 (NKJV)

I am consecrated in truth according to John 17:19, which says:

And for their sake I consecrate myself, that they also may be consecrated in truth. John 17:19 (NKIV)

I am one with Jesus and one with God according to John 17:22, which says:

"And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one: John 17:22 (NKJV)

I am a bondservant of Jesus Christ, separated to the gospel of God according to Romans 1:1, which says:

Paul, a bondservant of Jesus Christ, called to be an apostle, separated to the gospel of God. Romans 1:1 (NKJV)

I am called of Jesus Christ according to Romans 1:6, which says:

Among whom you also are the called of Jesus Christ; Romans 1:6 (NKJV)

I am beloved of God, called to be a saint according to Romans 1:7, which says:

To all who are in Rome, beloved of God, called to be saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. Romans 1:7 (NKJV)

I am saved by the gospel of God according to Romans 1:16, which says:

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. Romans 1:16 (NKIV)

I am justified freely by His grace according to Romans 3:24, which says:

Being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, Romans 3:24 (NKJV)

I am justified by faith according to Romans 3:29-30, which says:

Or is He the God of the Jews only? Is He not also the God of the Gentiles? Yes, of the Gentiles also, since there is one God who will justify the circumcised by faith and the uncircumcised through faith. Romans 3:29-30 (NKJV)

I am blessed because my lawless deeds are forgiven and my sins are covered according to Romans 4:7-8, which says:

Blessed are those whose lawless deeds are forgiven, and whose sins are covered; blessed is the man to whom the Lord shall not impute sin."

Romans 4:7-8 (NKIV)

I am of the seed of Abraham and through the righteousness of faith I receive the promise that I will be heir of the world according to Romans 4:13, which says:

For the promise that he would be the heir of the world was not to Abraham or to his seed through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.

Romans 4:13 (NKJV)

I am fully convinced what God has promised He is able to perform according to Romans 4:21, which says:

He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform. Romans 4:20-21 (NKJV)

I am justified by faith and have peace with God according to Romans 5:1, which says:

Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Romans 5:1 (NKIV)

I am not disappointed because the supernatural love of God has been poured out into my heart according to Romans 5:5, which says:

Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us. Romans 5:5 (NKJV)

I am greatly loved by God because while I was still a sinner Christ died for me according to Romans 5:8, which says:

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:8 (NKJV)

I am justified by the blood of Jesus Christ and saved from wrath through Him according to Romans 5:9, which says:

Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. Romans 5:9 (NKJV)

I am reconciled to God through the cross and have been saved by the life of Jesus Christ according to Romans 5:10, which says:

For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. Romans 5:10 (NKJV)

I am no longer a slave to sin according to Romans 6:6, which says:

Knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. Romans 6:6 (NKJV)

I am free from sin according to Romans 6:7, which says:

For he who has died has been freed from sin. Romans 6:7 (NKJV)

I am dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus according to Romans 6:11, which says:

Likewise, you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 6:11 (NKJV)

I am a slave to righteousness according to Romans 6:18, which says:

And having been set free from sin, you became slaves of righteousness. Romans 6:18 (NKJV)

I am a slave to God by my own choice and have the fruit to holiness according to Romans 6:22, which says:

But now having been set free from sin, and having become slaves of God, you have your fruit to holiness, and the end, everlasting life. Romans 6:22 (NKJV)

I am delivered from the law so that I can serve in the newness of the Spirit and not in the oldness of the letter according to Romans 7:6, which says:

But now we have been delivered from the law, having died to what we were held by, so that we should serve in the newness of the Spirit and not in the oldness of the letter. NKJ Romans 7:6 (NKJV)

I am spiritually minded which is life and peace according to Romans 8:6, which says:

For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. Romans 8:6 (NKJV)

I am led by the Spirit of God and I am a son of God according to Romans 8:14, which says:

For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. Romans 8:14 (NKJV)

I am adopted by God and my spirit cries out "Abba, Father" according to Romans 8:15, which says:

For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father Romans 8:15 (NKJV)

I am an heir of God and I am glorified with Christ Jesus according to Romans 8:17, which says:

And if children, then heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together. Romans 8:17 (NKJV)

I am predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, Jesus Christ according to Romans 8:29, which says:

For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. Romans 8:29 (NKJV)

I am predestined, called, justified and glorified by God according to Romans 8:30, which says:

Moreover, whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, and these He also glorified. Romans 8:30 (NKJV)

I am God's elect according to Romans 8:33, which says:

Who shall bring a charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. Romans 8:33 (NKJV)

I am a vessel of honor according to Romans 9:21, which says:

Does not the potter have power over the clay, from the same lump to make one vessel for honor and another for dishonor? Romans 9:21 (NKJV)

I am a vessel of mercy according to Romans 9:23, which says:

And that He might make known the riches of His glory on the vessels of mercy, which He had prepared beforehand for glory, Romans 9:23 (NKJV)

I am not conformed to this world but transformed by the renewing of my mind to prove that good and acceptable and perfect will of God according to Romans 12:2, which says:

And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God. Romans 12:2 (NKIV)

I am sanctified in Christ Jesus. I am called to be a saint according to 1 Corinthians 1:2, which says:

To the church of God, which is at Corinth, to those who are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all who in every place call on the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours. 1 Corinthians 1:2 (NKJV)

I am in Jesus Christ and I am filled with the wisdom of God according to 1 Corinthians 1:30, which says:

But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God and righteousness and sanctification and redemption. 1 Corinthians 1:30 (NKJV)

I am God's fellow worker according to 1 Corinthians 3:9, which says:

For we are God's fellow workers; you are God's field, you are God's building. 1 Corinthians 3:9 (NKJV)

I am a temple of God, the Spirit of God dwells in me according to 1 Corinthians 3:16, which says:

Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? 1 Corinthians 3:16 (NKJV)

I am joined to the Lord and one spirit with him according to 1 Corinthians 6:17, which says:

But he who is joined to the Lord is one spirit with Him. 1 Corinthians 6:17 (NKJV)

I am not my own, my body is the temple of God, the Spirit of God dwells in me according to 1 Corinthians 6:19, which says:

Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? 1 Corinthians 6:19 (NKJV)

I am a member of the body of Christ according to 1 Corinthians 12:27, which says:

Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually. 1 Corinthians 12:27 (NKJV)

I am love, I do not envy, I am not puffed up and I do not parade myself according to 1 Corinthians 13:4, which says:

Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; 1 Corinthians 13:4 (NKJV)

I am love, I am not rude, selfish, provoked and I do not think evil according to 1 Corinthians 13:5, which says:

(Love) does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil; 1 Corinthians 13:5 (NKIV)

I am love, I do not rejoice in iniquity but I do rejoice in the truth according to 1 Corinthians 13:6, which says:

(Love) does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; 1 Corinthians 13:6 (NKJV)

I am love, I bear all things, believe all things, hope all things and endure all things according to 1 Corinthians 13:4-7, which says:

(Love) bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, and endures all things. 1 Corinthians 13:4-7 (NKJV)

I am love. I never fail according to 1 Corinthians 13:8, which says:

Love never fails. But whether there are prophecies, they will fail; whether there are tongues, they will cease; whether there is knowledge, it will vanish away. 1 Corinthians 13:8 (NKJV)

I am not the great I AM, but I am what I am, by the grace of God and His grace in me is not in vain according to 1 Corinthians 15:10, which says:

But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain; but I labored more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me. 1 Corinthians 15:10 (NKJV)

I am anointed by God, sealed by the Holy Spirit and have the Spirit in my heart according to 2 Corinthians 1:21-22, which says:

Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and has anointed us is God, who also has sealed us and given us the Spirit in our hearts as a deposit. 2 Corinthians 1:21-22 (NKJV)

I am a new creation and old things have passed away according to 2 Corinthians 5:17, which says:

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NKJV)

I am reconciled to God and a minister of reconciliation according to 2 Corinthians 5:18-19, which says:

Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation, that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation. 2 Corinthians 5:18-19 (NKJV)

I am an ambassador of Christ according to 2 Corinthians 5:20, which says:

Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God. 2 Corinthians 5:20 (NKJV)

I am crucified with Christ. It is not I who live, but Jesus Christ in me according to Galatians 2:20, which says:

"I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me. Galatians 2:20 (NKJV)

I am a son of God through faith in Christ Jesus according to Galatians 3:26, which says:

For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. Galatians 3:26 (NKJV)

I am baptized into Christ and I have put on Christ according to Galatians 3:27, which says:

For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. Galatians 3:27 (NKJV)

I am a son of God and I have received the spirit of His Son in my heart according to Galatians 4:6, which says:

And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!" Galatians 4:6 (NKJV)

I am not a slave but a heir of God through Christ Jesus according to Galatians 4:7, which says:

Therefore, you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ. Galatians 4:7 (NKJV)

I am love and I am filled with joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control according to Galatians 5:22-23, which says:

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. Galatians 5:22-23 (NKJV)

I am blessed, I receive every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in accordance with Ephesians 1:3, which says:

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, Ephesians 1:3 (NKJV)

I am chosen by God to be holy and without blame in love according to Ephesians 1:4, which says:

just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, Ephesians 1:4 (NKJV)

I am predestined to be adopted as a son of God according to Ephesians 1:5, which says:

Having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will. Ephesians 1:5 (NKJV)

I am accepted in the Beloved according to Ephesians 1:6, which says:

To the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He has made us accepted in the Beloved. Ephesians 1:6 (NKJV)

I am redeemed and forgiven through the blood of Christ according to Ephesians 1:7, which says:

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace, Ephesians 1:7 (NKJV)

I abound in God's grace in all wisdom and prudence according to Ephesians 1:8, which says:

Which He made to abound toward us in all wisdom and prudence, Ephesians 1:8 (NKJV)

I am sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise according to Ephesians 1:13, which says:

In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise, Ephesians 1:13 (NKJV)

I am alive together with Christ according to Ephesians 2:5, which says:

Even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved, Ephesians 2:5 (NKTV)

I am raised up with Christ and seated in heavenly places right now according to Ephesians 2:6, which says:

And raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, Ephesians 2:6 (NKJV)

I am the workmanship of God, created for good works according to Ephesians 2:10, which says:

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them. Ephesians 2:10 (NKJV)

I am now made near to God by the blood of Christ no matter how far from God I have been in the past according to Ephesians 2:13, which says:

But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been made near by the blood of Christ. Ephesians 2:13 (NKJV)

I am reconciled to God in one body, all enmity has been put to death according to Ephesians 2:16, which says:

And that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity. Ephesians 2:16 (NKJV)

I am a citizen of heaven and a member of God's household according to Ephesians 2:19, which says:

Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God. Ephesians 2:19 (NKJV)

I am a prisoner of Christ, of my own free will, according to Ephesians 3:1, which says:

For this reason, I, Paul, the prisoner of Jesus Christ for you Gentiles. Ephesians 3:1 (NKJV)

I am strengthened with might through His Spirit in my inner self, Jesus Christ dwells in my heart through faith and I am rooted and grounded in love according to Ephesians 3:16-17, which says:

that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, Ephesians 3:16-17 (NKJV)

I am called of God according to Ephesians 4:1, which says:

Therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to have a walk worthy of the calling with which you were called, Ephesians 4:1 (NKJV)

I am a new person. I am righteous and holy according to Ephesians 4:24, which says:

And that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in righteousness and true holiness. Ephesians 4:24 (NKJV)

I am light in the Lord and I walk as a child of light according to Ephesians 5:8, which says:

For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light. Ephesians 5:8 (NKJV)

I am a member of His body, His flesh, and His bones according to Ephesians 5:30, which says:

For we are members of His body, of His flesh and of His bones. Ephesians 5:30 (NKJV)

I am a citizen of heaven according to Philippians 3:20-21, which says:

For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself. Philippians 3:20-21 (NKJV)

I am established in faith. I have received Jesus Christ, I walk in Him, and I am rooted and build up in Him according to Colossians 2:6-7, which says:

As you have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving. Colossians 2:6-7 (NKJV)

For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. Colossians 3:3 (NKJV)

I am in Christ, He is my life and I will appear with Him in glory according to Colossians 3:4, which says:

When Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory. Colossians 3:4 (NKJV)

I am the elect of God, holy and beloved, merciful, kind, patient, forgiving, humble and meek according to Colossians 3:12-13, which says:

Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering; bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do. Colossians 3:12-13 (NKJV)

I am a son of light and son of the day and not of darkness according to 1 Thessalonians 5:5, which says:

You are all sons of light and sons of the day. We are not of the night nor of darkness. 1 Thessalonians 5:5 (NKJV)

I am a partaker of the heavenly calling according to Hebrews 3:1, which says:

Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus, Hebrews 3:1 (NKJV)

I am a partaker of Christ according to Hebrews 3:14, which says:

For we have become partakers of Christ if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast to the end, Hebrews 3:14 (NKJV)

I am a partaker of God's divine nature and I have escaped the corruption that is in this world according to 2 Peter 1:4, which says:

By which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. 2 Peter 1:4 (NKJV)

I am born again of the incorruptible seed of God according to 1 Peter 1:23, which says:

Having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever, 1 Peter 1:23 (NKJV)

I am chosen by God and precious according to 1 Peter 2:4, which says:

Coming to Him as to a living stone, rejected indeed by men, but chosen by God and precious, 1 Peter 2:4 (NKJV)

I am a holy priest according to 1 Peter 2:5, which says:

You also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. 1 Peter 2:5 (NKJV)

I am a member of a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's own possession according to 1 Peter 2:9-10, which says:

But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy. 1 Peter 2:9-10 (NKJV)

I am a stranger to fleshy lusts of this world which war against my soul according to 1 Peter 2:11, which says:

Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul; 1 Peter 2:11 (NKJV)

I am love; I cover a multitude of sins according to 1 Peter 4:8, which says:

And above all things have fervent love for one another, for "love will cover a multitude of sins." 1 Peter 4:8 (NKJV)

I am an enemy of the devil and I resist him steadfast in the faith according to 1 Peter 5:8-9, which says:

Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. Resist him, steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your brotherhood in the world. 1 Peter 5:8-9 (NKJV)

I am loved by God, I am a child of God and the world does not know me according to 1 John 3:1-3, which says:
