A Prayer for the Leaders of the Republic of the United States of America, Israel, Africa and all the Nations of the

World, the Mountains of Society and all the leaders of the world, from the least to the greatest, taken from the collection of Prayers for the Precious. The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament shows His handiwork. Day unto day utters speech, and night unto night reveals knowledge. There is no speech nor language where their voice is not heard. Their line has gone out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. In them He has set a tabernacle for the sun, which is like a bridegroom coming out of his chamber and rejoices like a strong man to run its race. Its rising is from one end of heaven, and its circuit to the other end; and there is nothing hidden from its heat (Ps. 19:1-6). Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, His name is great in might (Jer. 10:6), in His mighty name we speak words of life over you and your entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of your family on every side (Acts 13:26), all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all your natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of your spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2), your land and your nation. According to the joy of harvest (Isa 9:3) in the virtuous name of **Jesus Christ**, there is none like Him (Jer. 10:7), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for you, your posterity (Prov. 11:21) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), for your entire family, your friends, neighbors and countrymen(1 Tim. 2:1-2), for all the brethren (Eph. 6:18), all the leaders throughout the world and all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). We pray this prayer of faith with confidence (Jas 5:15) knowing that it is God's Word, His Will, and HIs heart (Col. 1:9). Therefore, let you know in your heart and in your soul that not one word will fail of all the good things which the LORD our God speaks concerning you in this prayer. All shall come to pass for you and your house; not one word will fail (Josh. 23:14). The words that **Christ**, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to you and your family (Acts 13:26) are spirit, and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Cor. 15:57)!

As a vessel of honor (Rom. 9:21) we cry to the Lord, and He hears us (Ps. 120:1)! Grace be with you (Col. 4:18). In the divine name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> of Nazareth (John 16:23), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house will clearly hear the call (Acts 2:39) that God has on your lives. For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call (Acts 2:39). According to all His wonderful works (Jer. 21:2), may the Lord help you and your people know who you are in <u>*Christ*</u> and give you certainty that you were created for a high purpose, being called with a holy calling, not according to your works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to you in Christ Jesus before time began (2 Tim 1:9). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), may the everlasting God (Gen. 21:33) show you and your family how to prioritize everything so that whatever steals life and peace, or has no eternal purpose (Eph. 3:11), will not occupy your time. The thief does not come except to steal, and kill, and to destroy. Jesus comes that you and your people may have life, and that you and your family may have it more abundantly (John 10:10). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that God will teach you and your family to number your days that you may gain a heart of wisdom (Ps. 90:12). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and yours will not look at those things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal (2 cor. 4:18). In all things let you and your people seek God (2 Chr. 15:12) to set your life in order before the Lord continually, in an everlasting covenant (Lev. 24:8). Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty! Just and true are Your ways, O King of the saints (Rev. 15:3)!

Let your first priority be to seek the face of the Lord (Ps. 27:8), the God who holds your breath in His hand and owns all your ways (Dan. 5:23). In the name of Jesus Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask God, Him who ought to be feared (Ps. 76:11), that you and your family will see His face in righteousness; and shall be satisfied when you awake in His likeness (Ps. 17:15). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your people will put Jesus Christ first in your lives, take up your cross and follow Him, and lose your lives to Him, so that you may find true life (Matt. 10:38-39). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), peace through Jesus Christ, He is Lord of all (Acts 10:36), let you and your house cleave to the Lord and follow Him (2 Kin. 18:6), as obedient children, not conforming yourselves to the former lusts, as in your ignorance (1 Pet. 1:14). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we urge you to follow the Lamb wherever He goes (Rev. 14:4), for he will guide you and your people to springs of the water of life, and God will wipe away every tear from your eyes (Rev. 7:17). Surely, you and your children will be redeemed from among men, being the first-fruits unto God and unto the Lamb (Rev. 14:4), walking with Jesus Christ in white for you and your house are worthy (Rev 3:4), for your obedience shall lead to righteousness (Rom 6:16). Let you and your people hunger and thirst for righteousness, for then, as it is written, you shall be filled (Matt. 5:6). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray you and your

family will not labor for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to everlasting life (John 6:27). May you and your people seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all needed things shall be added to you and your house (Matt. 6:33). In the name of <u>Jesus</u> <u>Christ</u> (John 16:23), praise the name of the Lord (Ps. 113:1), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven (Matt. 6:20), and there your heart will be also (Matt. 6:21). Surely, you and your family will come to <u>Jesus Christ</u> and never hunger and believe in Him and never thirst (John 6:35). The Lord's kindness shall not depart from you and your house, nor shall His covenant of peace be removed (Is. 54:10). Let you and your family worship the Lord your God, and Him only shall you serve (Matt. 4:10). Sing praise to the Lord, you saints of His, and give thanks at the remembrance of His holy name (Ps. 30:4)! But you are holy, who inhabit the praises of Your people (Ps. 22:3)!

In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), we fear the name of the Lord from the west, and His glory from the rising of the sun (ls. 59:19), in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your people will fear the Lord, for the secret of the Lord is with those who fear Him, and He will show you His covenant (Ps. 25:14). Incline your ear and come to Him. Hear, and your soul shall live; and He will make an everlasting covenant with you and your house (ls. 55:3). This is the covenant that the Mighty One, God the Lord (Ps. 50:1), makes with you and your house: "I will put My laws into your hearts, and in your mind, I will write them. Your sins and your lawless deeds I will remember no more" (Heb. 10:16-25). Therefore, in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house shall not be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion (Rom. 11:25). Come let you and your house join yourselves to the Lord in a perpetual covenant that will not be forgotten (Jer. 50:5). Enter into the covenant (Ezek. 16:8) with our Lord, the great and awesome God (Dan. 9:4), and you will be His (Ezek 16:8). Ask the way to Zion (Jer 50:5), and He will establish His everlasting (Jer. 32:40) covenant with you and your house (Ezek. 16:8). He will establish your house and multiply you (Ezek. 37:26), direct your walk in truth (ls. 61:8), and He will not turn away from doing you and your house good; but He will put His fear in your hearts so that you will not depart from Him (Jer. 32:40). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your family will diligently (Josh. 23:11) seek the Lord (Duet. 4:29), that you will make it a priority in your life to keep his commandments (John 14:21, 1 Cor. 7:19) and His testament (Heb. 9:16), to keep His covenant (Ex. 19:5): to love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind (Matt. 22:37); to love your neighbor as yourself (Matt. 22:39); and to love one another, as *Jesus Christ* has loved you, that you also love one another (John 13:34-35), loving from a pure heart, from a good conscience, and from sincere faith (1 Tim. 1:5). By this all

will know that you are His disciples, if you have love for one another (John 13:34-35). Let each of you examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread and drink of that cup (1 Cor. 11:28) with a pure heart (1 Tim. 1:5). The cup which is the new covenant in His blood (1 Cor. 11:25), a better covenant (Heb. 7:21-22), on better promises (Heb. 8:6), which is the promise of the Spirit through faith (Gal. 3:14). Being steadfast with Him, Jesus Christ, faithful in His covenant (Ps. 78:37), having respect to the covenant, for the dark places of the earth are full of the habitations of cruelty (Ps. 74:20). Always willing for the remission of sin (Heb. 10:18), repenting (Mark 1:15), confessing your sins (1 John 1:9), seeking forgiveness (Luke 11:4), for He is faithful and just to forgive you your sins and to cleanse you from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9). Let you and yours hold fast to the confession of your hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful (Heb. 10:23). And let you and your family consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of the saints together, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching (Heb. 10:24-25). The Mighty One, God the Lord, has spoken and called the earth from the rising of the sun to its going down. Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God will shine forth! Our God shall come and shall not keep silent; a fire shall devour before Him, and it shall be very tempestuous all around Him (Ps. 50:1-3)! The Lord has sworn to *Jesus Christ* and will not relent, "you are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek", by so much more <u>Jesus</u> has become a surety of a better covenant for you and your house (Heb. 7:21). He shall call to the heavens from above, and to the earth, that He may judge His people: "Gather My saints together to Me, those who have made a covenant with Me by sacrifice." Let the heavens declare His righteousness, for God Himself is Judge! Selah (Ps. 50:4-6)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), let us love the name of the Lord (Is. 56:7), may you and your family always remember that you, once Gentiles in the flesh, that at that time you were without <u>Christ</u>, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world (Eph. 2:11-12). But now you are children of hope, children of promise (Rom. 9:8, Gal. 4:28), and children of light (Eph. 5:8), sons of light and sons of the day (1 Thess. 5:5). So in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray you and your children walk in the light as <u>Jesus</u> is in the Light (1 John 1:7); that you walk in love, as <u>Christ</u> also has loved you and given Himself for you, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma (Eph. 5:2), and that you walk in truth (3 John 1:4), endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace (Eph. 4:3). According to all His righteousness (Ps. 7:17, 35:24, Dan 9:16), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask our Lord, the great and awesome God (Dan. 9:4), to give to you

and yours the boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of *Jesus*, by a new and living way which He consecrated for you, through the veil, that is, His flesh, and having a High Priest over the house of God, let you and your people draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having your hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience (Heb. 10:19-22). Therefore, since you are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken (Heb. 12:28), Lord Jehovah, your everlasting strength (Is. 26:4), grant you grace, by which you may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear (Heb 12:28). Since your sufficiency is from God, who made you sufficient as ministers of the new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life (2 Cor. 3:5-6); let you and your house make it a priority to choose life (Deut. 30:19) in all that you do or say (1 Cor. 10:31), having fruit to holiness and the end everlasting life (Rom. 6:22), being instruments of righteousness to God (Rom. 6:13). Sing, O heavens! Be Joyful, O earth! And break out in singing, O mountains! For the Lord has comforted His people and will have mercy on His afflicted (Is. 49:13). "For the mountains shall depart and the hills be removed, but My kindness shall not depart from you and your house, nor shall My covenant of peace be removed", says the Lord, who has mercy on you (Is. 54:10).

In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), we take up the cup of salvation, and call upon the name of the Lord (Ps. 116:13); in His name may you set your house in order (2 Kin. 20:1) and be ready for the coming of the bridegroom (Matt. 25:10). Watch therefore, for you do not know what hour your Lord is coming (Matt. 24:42), for He will come as a thief in the night (1 Thess. 5:2). Let you and your family do all things decently and in order (1 Cor. 14:40), and in *Christ* you and your family shall be made alive in God's order (1 Cor. 15:23). As you and your people have received *Christ Jesus* the Lord, so shall you and your house walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving (Col. 2:6-7), in good order and steadfast of faith in *Christ* (Col. 2:5), obedient to the faith (Rom. 1:5). May you and your people set your words in order before God (Job 33:5). Lord Jehovah, your everlasting strength (ls. 26:4) gives you wisdom that you and your family may teach knowledge, that you and your people may ponder and seek out and set in order many proverbs (Eccl. 12:9). Let you and your house be wise in what is good and simple concerning evil (Rom. 16:19). According to the Spirit of holiness (Rom 1:4) the God of peace (Rom. 15:33, Rom. 16:20) help you and your people bring every thought into captivity to the obedience of *Christ* (2 Cor. 10:5), and let the words of your mouth and the meditation of your heart be acceptable in His sight (Ps. 19:14). Surely, the peace of God rules in your heart (Col. 3:15). May you and your people lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence (1 Tim. 2:2). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we plead

with you and your family to not hide His righteousness within your heart; but declare His faithfulness and His salvation; far be it for you to conceal His loving-kindness and His truth from the great congregation (Ps. 40:10).

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), thanks to the name of the Lord (Ps. 122:4), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house are willing and obedient, so you and your people shall eat the good of the land (ls. 1:19), and receive the blessing of God (Duet 11:26-27). May you and your family acquaint yourselves with *Jesus*, and be at peace, thereby good will come to you and your house. Let you and your people receive instruction from His mouth, and lay up His words in your heart, so that you will be built up; and you will remove iniquity far from your house (Job 22:21-23). According to His word (Ps. 119) the Holy Spirit (John 14:26), which is in you (Rom. 8:9), will bring all things to your remembrance (John 14:26), so you and yours do not forget His law, but your hearts shall keep His commands; for length of days and long life and peace will be added to you and your people. Let not mercy and truth forsake you and your family; let God bind them around your necks, write them on the tablet of your hearts, so you and your house will find favor and high esteem in the sight of God and man (Prov. 3:1-4). By the grace of God (1 Cor. 15:10), be complete, be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you (2 cor. 13:11). Yes, the Lord will give what is good; and your land will yield its increase (Ps. 85:12). The Lord your friend (Luke 12:4, John 15:14) help you and your family lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares you and your house, and let you and your people run with endurance the race that is set before you, looking unto **Jesus** the author and finisher of your faith (Heb. 12:1-2). May you and your family fight the good fight, keeping faith, and finish the race (2 Tim. 4:7) with joy (Acts 20:24). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and yours run in such a way that you may obtain the prize (1 Cor. 9:24). Truly, your souls silently wait for God; from Him comes your salvation. He only is your rock and your salvation; He is your defense; you shall not be greatly moved (Ps. 62:1-2)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), glorify His name forevermore (Ps. 86:12), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray for your priorities to be in perfect order (Is. 9:7, Lev. 24:8). The Lord is faithful, who will establish you and your house (2 Thess. 3:3), counsel you and your people (Prov. 19:21), direct your path (Prov. 3:6), your every step (Prov. 16:9), perfect that which concerns you and your family (Ps. 138:8), comfort your hearts, and establish you and yours in every good word and work (2 Thess. 2:17). Of the increase and peace let there be no end, upon your house and over His Kingdom, to order it and establish it with judgment and justice from this time forward, even forever (Is. 9:7). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will not be ensnared by the

pride of life (1 John 2:16), the work of your hand (Eccl. 2:11), nor fall into the trap of vanity (Eccl. 5:7), for you are not sufficient of yourselves to think of anything as being from yourselves, but your sufficiency is from God (2 Cor. 3:5). According to the good pleasure of His will (Eph 1:5), God grant you wisdom (Rom. 11:33) that you do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind (Rom. 12:2), so that you do not put too great an importance on this world's goods (1 John 3:17). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you do not worry about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink; nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food and the body more than clothing (Matt. 6:25)? But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you (Matt. 6:33). My God shall supply all your need according to His riches and glory, by <u>Christ Jesus</u> (Phil 4:19). According to His own purpose and grace which was given to you in Christ Jesus before time began (2 Tim. 1:9), God, Him who is most just (Job 34:17), shall keep you from the traps of the workers of iniquity (Ps. 141:9), from the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eye (1 John 2:16), and give you a spirit of love (Rom. 5:5), that your spouse, your children your bloodline and the brethren shall take priority in your heart (song 4:9), setting them as a seal on your heart in love (song 8:6). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will not think more highly of yourself than you ought (Rom. 12:3). Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each of you esteem others better than himself. Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. Let this mind be in you which was also in *Christ* Jesus (Phil. 2:3-5). Thus, says the Lord, the King of Israel, and your Redeemer, the Lord of hosts: "I am the First and I am the Last; besides Me there is no God" (ls. 44:6). you are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for you created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created (Rev. 4:11)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), through whom grace and truth came (John 1:17), may you bring your children up in the training and admonition of the Lord (Eph. 6:4), with a balance of mercy (Rom. 9:23), judgment (Luke 12:57), and instruction (Prov. 1:3). For the Lord has known you and your family, in order that you may command your children and your household after you, that you keep the way of the Lord, to do righteousness and justice (Gen. 18:19). According to His glorious power (Col. 1:11) let, the Lord help you and your people to set in order the things that are lacking (Titus 1:5). Let the heritage you pass on (Prov. 13:22) be rich (Luke 12:21) in the fullness of His Holy Spirit (Eph. 1:23); for a good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children (Prov. 13:22). A posterity shall serve Him. It will be recounted of the Lord to the next generation, they will come and declare His righteousness to a people who will be born, that he has done this (Ps. 22:30-31).

As a child of God (John 1:12-13), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17, 19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and all of your people (Ps. 148:14); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time (is. 9:7, is. 59:21) so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Judges 18:6, Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Thess. 5:23). In the name of Jesus Christ, know that His name is the Lord (Jer. 16:21) and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (ls. 61:2)! In Him who is the First and the Last, who was dead, and came to life (Rev. 2:8), alive together with Him (2 cor. 13:4) as one we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. Oh, magnify the Lord, and let us exalt His name together (Ps. 34:3).

God said it. We believe it. It is settled forever. In Jesus' name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! Amen!
