A Prayer for the Leaders of the Republic of the United States of America, Israel, Africa and all the Nations of the World, the Mountains of Society and all the leaders

of the world, from the least to the greatest, taken from the collection of Prayers for the Precious. Also, Your righteousness, O God, is very high, You who have done great things; O God, who is like You (Ps. 71:19)? We love the Lord, because He hears our voice and our supplications (Ps. 116:1). Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9). In the name of Jesus Christ, our hope (1 Tim. 1:1) we speak words of life over you and your entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of your family on every side (Acts 13:26), all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all your natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of your spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2), your land and your nation. All shall come to pass for you and your house; not one word will fail (Josh. 23:14). The words that *Christ*, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to you and your family (Acts 13:26) are spirit, and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Cor. 15:57)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), blessed be His glorious name forever (Ps 72:19), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask God our Rock (Ps. 42:9), the Father of glory (Eph. 1:17), to grant (2 Tim. 1:18) to you and your family (Acts 13:26) the joy of the Lord,

which is your strength (Neh. 8:10). Mercy surrounds you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); be glad in the Lord and rejoice; and shout for joy, for mercy shall surround you (Ps. 32:10-11) and your family (Acts 13:26). Oh, send out Your light and Your truth, O Lord! May the Lord's light and His truth lead you and your family (Acts 13:26); let His light and His truth bring you and your loved ones to His holy hill and to His tabernacle. Then you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will go to the altar of God, to God your exceeding joy (Ps. 43:3-4); and make a joyful shout to God; sing out the honor of His name, and make His praise glorious (Ps. 66:1-2)! According to the riches of His glory (Eph. 3:16) may God, who alone is wise (1 Tim. 1:17), give you and your family (Acts 13:26) wisdom and knowledge and joy (Eccl. 2:26). May you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) know the joy of His way (Job 8:19); He will fill your mouths with laughing, and your lips with rejoicing (Job 8:21). Those who hate you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) will be clothed with shame, and the dwelling place of the wicked will come to nothing (Job 8:22). The Lord shall delight in you and your family (Acts 13:26). He shall see your faces with joy, for He restores to you and your people (Ps. 148:14) His righteousness (Job 33:26). The Lord desires truth in the inward parts, and in the hidden part He will make you and yours to know wisdom. He will purge you and your people (Ps. 148:14) with hyssop, and you shall be clean; He will wash you, and you shall be whiter than snow. He will make you and your people (Ps. 148:14) to hear the joy and gladness and He will hide His face from your sins and blot out all your iniquities. He will create in you and your family (Acts 13:26) clean hearts and renew a steadfast spirit within you (Ps. 51:6-10). For the Lord who heals, Jehovah – Rapha (Ex. 15:26), restores your souls (Ps. 23:3). Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ (Rom 15:6) from everlasting to everlasting (1 Chr. 16:35-36)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), the name of our Lord is a strong tower (Prov. 18:10); in His name let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) put your trust. Let you and yours shout for joy because He defends you (Ps. 5:11); in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) you and your family (Acts 13:26) will love His name and be joyful in Him. For the Lord will bless you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); with favor He will surround you and your family (Acts 13:26) as with a shield (Ps. 5:11-12). He will show you and your people (Ps. 148:14) the path of life; in His presence is fullness of joy; at His right hand are pleasures forevermore (Ps. 16:11). You and your people (Ps. 148:14) shall have joy in His strength, and in His salvation how greatly shall you rejoice (Ps. 21:1)! According to His tender mercies (Ps. 119:156), may God grant to you and your family (Acts 13:26) your heart's desire, and not withhold the request of your lips (Ps. 21-2). May He meet you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) with the

blessing of goodness (Ps. 21:2-3) and give you and your people (Ps. 148:14) life and length of days forever and ever. Your glory is great in His salvation; honor and majesty He has placed upon you (Ps. 21:4-5) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Your heads shall be lifted up above all your enemies all around you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your family (Acts 13:26) will offer sacrifices of joy in His tabernacle; and sing praises to the Lord (Ps. 27:6), that you and yours will do this willingly in the uprightness of your hearts (1 Chr. 29:17), raising your voice with resounding joy (1 Chr. 15:16). For you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) will triumph in His praise (1 Chr. 16:35)! God has a mighty arm; strong is His hand, and high is His right hand! Righteousness and justice are the foundation of His throne; mercy and truth go before His face! Blessed are you and your family (Acts 13:26) who know the joyful sound! May you and your people (Ps. 148:14) walk in the light of His countenance. In the name of the Lord may you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) rejoice all the day long, and in His righteousness you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21) will be exalted. For He is the glory of your strength, and in His favor your horn is exalted! For your shield belongs to the Lord, and your King to the Holy One of Israel (Ps. 89:13-18). For the Lord is there, the Lord is present, YHWH Shammah (Ezek. 48:35). Yea, though you walk through the valley of the shadow of death, you will fear no evil; for He is with you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); His rod and His staff shall comfort you (Ps. 23:4) and your family (Acts 13:26). Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever (1 Chr. 16:34)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), the Son of Man which has come to seek and to save that which was lost (Luke 19:10), let you and your family (Acts 13:26) shout joyfully to the Rock of your salvation. Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) come before His presence with thanksgiving (Ps. 95:1-2). For He is our God, and you are of the people of His pasture, and the sheep of His hand (Ps. 95:7). Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) hear His voice, and follow him, for His sheep hear His voice, and He knows them, and they follow Him (John 10:27). According to the riches of His grace (Eph. 1:7), He gives you and your people (Ps. 148:14) eternal life, and you shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch you out of His hand. His Father, who has given you to Him, is greater than all; and Io no one is able to snatch you out of His Fathers hand. He and His Father Are One (John 10:28-30). May the Lord make you and yours joyful and strengthen your hands in the work of the house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) of God (Ezra. 6:22). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), through whom are all things, and through whom we live (1 Cor. 8:6), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) you and your people (Ps. 148:14) serve the Lord with gladness and come before His presence with singing (Ps. 100:2). Let you and yours know that the Lord, He is God, He is who made you, and not yourselves; you and your family (Acts 13:26) are of His people and the sheep of His pasture (Ps. 100:3). Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. May you and yours be thankful to Him and bless His name (Ps. 100:4). For the Lord is good, His mercy is everlasting, and His truth endures to all generations (Ps. 100:2-5). According to His excellent greatness (Ps. 150:2), the Lord grant you and your family (Acts 13:26) to be multiplied and increased in your joy (ls. 9:3). Let your garments always be white, and let your heads lack no oil (Eccl. 9:8). May you and yours receive the word of knowledge through the Spirit (1 Cor. 12:8). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) you and your family (Acts 13:26) will have joy by the answer of your mouths, and a word spoken in due season, how good it is (Prov. 15:23). May you and your people (Ps. 148:14) joy in doing justice (Prov. 21:15) and be counselors of peace (Prov. 12:20). The Lord is your Peace, Yahweh Shalom (Judge 6:24). He makes you lie down in green pastures; he leads you beside the still waters. (Ps. 23: 2). Yours, O Lord, is the greatness, the power and the glory, the victory and the majesty; for all that is in heaven and in earth is Yours; Yours is the kingdom, O Lord, and You are exalted as head over all (1 Chr. 29:11)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), abundance of grace and the gift of Righteousness will reign in life through the **One**, <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 5:17); in His name we pray (James 5:16) you will live joyfully with your family (Eccl. 9:9). Whatever your hands find to do, may you and your people (Ps. 148:14) do it with might (Eccl. 9:10). According to the integrity (Ps. 78:72) of God's heart (Jer. 3:15), may God keep you and yours busy with the joy of your heart (Eccl. 5:20). In <u>Christ</u> (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) you and your people (Ps. 148:14) eat and drink and enjoy the good of all your labor for it is the gift of God (Eccl. 3:12-13). Let you eat your bread with joy and drink your wine with merry hearts; for God has accepted your works (Eccl. 9:7). In the day of prosperity (Eccl. 7:14) the God of patience and comfort grant (Rom. 15:5) you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to be joyful (Eccl. 7:14). Let the Lord be magnified, who has pleasure in the prosperity of His servants (Ps. 35:27)., you and your family (Acts 13:26). In the day of adversity (Eccl. 7:14) in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) will not sorrow, for the joy of the Lord is your strength (Neh. 8:10). For His anger is but for a moment, His favor is for life; weeping may endure for a night, but joy comes in the morning (Ps. 30:5-5). For those who sow in tears shall reap in joy (Ps. 126:5). Lord, by Your Favor You have made our mountain stand strong (Ps. 30:7). The Lord, YHWH - Yireh, will provide for you (Gen. 22:14) you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Both riches and honor come from You, O God, and You reign over all. In Your hand is power and might; in Your hand it is to make great and to give strength to all. You and your people (Ps. 148:14) shall be clothed with righteousness (Ps. 132:9), salvation (ls. 61:10) and gladness (Ps. 30:11). For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for you and yours, that you might become the righteousness of God in Him (2 Cor. 5:21). Jesus the Christ (Acts 9:34), the First and the Last, who was dead, and came to life (Rev. 2:8). The Lord our righteousness, YHWH Tsidkenu (Jer. 23:6), leads you in the paths of righteousness for His names sake (Ps. 23:3). The Lord reigns; the world also is firmly established; it shall not be moved (Ps. 96:10)! In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), your crown of glory (ls. 28:5), let you and your family (Acts 13:26) be joyful in glory; let you and yours sing aloud on your bed. Let the high praises of God be in your mouths, and a two edged sword in your hands, to bind the kings of darkness with chains, and the nobles of darkness with fetters of iron; to execute on them the written judgment this honor have all His saints. Praise the Lord (Ps. 149:5-9)! The Lord your banner (Ex. 17-15), your victory (1 Cor. 15:57), your miracle (Acts 19:11), your defense (Ps. 7:10), YAHWEH NISSI (Ex. 17:15), prepares a table before you in the presence of your enemies; He anoints your head with oil; your cup runs over (Ps. 23:5). Peace to you and your house

(Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) who are in <u>Christ Jesus</u> (1 Pet. 5:14). Grace and peace be multiplied to you and your family (Acts 13:26) in the knowledge of God and of <u>Jesus our Lord</u>, as His divine power has given to you and yours all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called you and your people (Ps. 148:14) by glory and virtue, by which have been given to you exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you and yours may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust (2 Pet. 1:2-4). Let you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) grow in the grace and knowledge of our <u>Lord and Savior Jesus Christ</u>. To Him be the glory both now and forever (2 Pet. 3:18)!

As a King of God (Rev. 5:10), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17, 19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and all of your people (Ps. 148:14); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time (Is. 9:7, ls. 59:21) so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Judges 18:6, Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Thess. 5:23). Grace might reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord (Rom. 5:21), in His magnificent name and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2)! In Him who is the firstborn from the dead (Col. 1:18), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. Let us join ourselves to the Lord, to serve Him, and to love the name of the Lord, to be His servants everyone who keeps from defiling the Sabbath, and holds fast to His Covenant (ls. 56:6), and He shall bring us to His holy mountain, and make us joyful in His house of prayer (ls. 56:7).

God said it. We believe it. It is settled forever. In <u>Jesus'</u> name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! Amen!
