Nelson Driving School, LLC WA State Examinations Policy

Fees:

- 1. The fee for the WA State written knowledge exam is \$40.
- 2. The fee for the WA State drive skills exam is \$40.
- 3. The fee for using Nelson Driving School, LLC's vehicle for the WA State drive skills exam is an additional \$50.
- 4. For each retake of the written knowledge exam the fee is \$40.
- 5. For each retake of the drive skills exam the fee is \$40.

Exam Policy:

- 1. For additional services and fees please inquire on our website www.nelsondrivingschool.com or by calling our office (360) 756-8777.
- 2. Nelson Driving School, LLC takes credit/debit cards and cash only. No checks are accepted.
- 3. All fees are non-refundable. No Refunds will be given.
- 4. The written knowledge exam consists of 40 multiple-choice questions about traffic safety laws. Applicants must answer at least 32 questions correctly to pass the exam. Passing is 80% or higher.
- 5. The drive skills exam will test the applicants' ability to drive legally and safely. Applicants must pass the drive skills test with a score of at least 80%.
- 6. Applicants WA State written knowledge and drive skills exam scores will be entered into the DOL database within 24 hours. You will have to visit the DOL office to apply for your license. Passing the written knowledge and drive skills test does not guarantee that an applicant will be issued a driver license. The Department of Licensing will determine if an applicant has met all licensing requirements. If you are under the age of 18 you must be at least 16 years old, successfully completed a traffic safety education course, have had your permit for at least 6 months and have had 50 hours driving experience with at least 10-night driving hours to apply for your driver's license.
- 7. The Department of Licensing reserves the right to conduct random re-examinations; applicants refusing to take a re-examination may have their license revoked.

- 9. For any grievance or complaint please call our office at (360) 756-8777 and ask to speak with the owner or manager.
- 10. Nelson Driving School, LLC, its examiners, employees, and instructors reserve the right to refuse services to anyone.
- 11. If an applicant has an obvious physical or mental impairment that may affect their ability to safely operate a motor vehicle, they will be referred to test at a Department of Licensing office. Nelson Driving School, LLC will not issue refunds for the written knowledge or drive skills exams if failure to disclose this information prior to testing was not provided.
- 12. Nelson Driving School, LLC offers an oral exam once per month. Please check the schedule on our website.
- 13. If an applicant has received a letter or email from the DOL with instructions on testing for re-licensing after a suspended/revoked license, Nelson Driving School, LLC will not issue refunds for the written knowledge or drive skills exams if this information was not provided prior to testing. Applicants are responsible for providing Nelson Driving School, LLC with the relevant DOL instructions on regaining their license. We ask that you show us a copy of the letter listing the re-testing instructions.
- 14. Your car must be legal to operate on public streets. This includes, but is not limited to windshield, seat belts, wipers, defroster, tires, mirrors, all brake, and reverse lights, turn signals and be legally licensed/tabs current.
- 15. You will need to demonstrate arm signals prior to beginning the drive skills test.
- 16. Pursuant to RCW 46.20.720 a driver convicted of an alcohol offense may be required to have an Ignition Interlock Device (IID) to drive. The applicant must take the drive skills exam in their vehicle using the IID.
- 17. Applicants wishing to use their own vehicle for their drive skills exam are required to provide proof of insurance and current registration, current license tabs, on the day of the test. Proof of insurance can be provided on a Smartphone, via email, or paper copy of insurance card.
- 18. At the time of the test, provide proof of identification such as a photo permit, out of state license, or school yearbook.
