

### **Packing List & Guidelines For HOTT Days**

- Bible and Pen
- Sleeping bag & pillow, (air mattress/pump-optional)
- Money for snacks (optional)
- Hat to block the sun (no offensive logos allowed)
- Sun screen
- Bug spray (with deet)
- Work gloves
