Dear Residents & Business Owners,

The Marlow Volunteer Fire Department would like to extend our heartfelt gratitude for the continued support of the community. Your contributions directly enable us to respond to emergencies, save lives, and serve our community with dedication and pride.

In 2024, our volunteers received 778 calls for service. These included medical emergencies, structure fires, motor vehicle crashes, and a variety of other incidents - each requiring trained personnel, reliable equipment, and community trust.

As we look toward the future, we remain committed to strengthening our capabilities. This year, we've taken significant steps to improve our fleet, equipment, and facilities:

- We recently purchased a new 2024 Class A mini-pumper at a cost of \$350,000, to enhance our emergency response. Loan payments of \$37,000/year for 15 years start in March 2026 from funds raised in this current effort.
- We are actively working to establish a third station on Sulphur Springs Road, a project estimated to cost upwards of \$80,000. This new station will improve response times and coverage for many residents in that portion of our jurisdiction.
- We were fortunate to receive and greatly appreciate the donation of a 2007 Class A pumper from the City of Clinton which will be housed at that station when it is ready.

These investments are essential - but they come at a significant cost. While we do receive some funding from Anderson County, it does not fully cover our annual operational expenses - especially when it comes to growth and critical infrastructure improvements. That's where we turn to you, our community. Your tax-deductible donation helps us: maintain our current activities, upgrade essential firefighting equipment, expand and maintain our fleet, enhance volunteer training, and build the facilities needed to serve you more effectively.

Every dollar makes a difference. No matter the amount, your contribution directly impacts the safety and preparedness of your fire department. We are honored to serve this incredible community and hope you will consider supporting us as we continue to grow and improve.
