New Business

- Sport Field Day Debrief
 - In future, do a warmup at beginning.
 - See Sports Field Day spreadsheet for event cost breakdown and other items to consider from debrief, especially the recommendation to purchase 2 first aid kits if SportsMed is unable to attend (most needed items include bandaids and antiseptic wipes due to Tug-of-War injuries)
- Awards Night Debrief
 - See Awards Night spreadsheet for event cost breakdown and other items to consider from debrief such as: A-frame like sign to direct traffic at Awards Night and other events (\$500 added to 2022-2023 recommended budget; if approved Mindi will look for one second hand), tripod for live streaming (if 2022-2023 team budgets/approves, Mindi will look for one second hand).
 - In future, post cadets in parking lot to be escorts for distinguished guests unsure of where to go and place a water bottle at each guest seat.
 - Discussed several ideas for food, including a dessert table after. Doing a 30 or so minute dessert table at the end seemed to be a popular idea because cadets eating before/during awards in their uniforms may not be a great idea, and there would not be enough room for dining tables for everyone (if dinner was served, people would have to eat on their laps). If we resume hosting in auditorium instead of cafeteria, dessert can be served in lobby but food probably can't be served inside. Another popular idea in addition to or instead of dessert was doing a restaurant fundraiser that night as an after party. Many of the cadets met out that night, anyway, and it would be a nice opportunity for families to meet and socialize.
- Discussed Community Sponsorship Outreach. Ideas included reaching out to companies like Boeing, Talley Defense, Sons and Daughters of the American Revolution, etc. to sponsor, possibly for things like field trips or the railroad tour in Colorado. Matt Frost to send information to Booster Club for next year's team.
- 2021-2022 Budget Review & recommendations for 2022-2023
 - Campus Donations: canceled Welcome Sign and completed Pull Up Bars
 - Classroom Supplies: Canceled printer but added inkjet supplies expense requested by Col & Sgt, added expense for new US Flag for \$100, added \$500 expense for Aframe sign(s) for directing traffic at events, etc.
 - Competition Supplies: increased Snacks expense to \$400, added Air Rifle bags expense for \$225
 - Corps Events: increased Awards Night expense to \$2,000 for dessert, etc., increased Dining Out expense to \$1,500, increased Holiday Potluck expense to \$800
 - Fundraising: added expense for new poster boards for July CBT (cadet basic training) and Car Wash





- Online Sales: added Decals expense of \$400 to redesign and make initial bulk purchase, increased Polo Shirts to \$1,500 (Note: make the logo bigger next year!)
- Restaurant Nights: Added Fat Willy's and next year think about having a Restaurant Night after Awards Night
- Scholarships: added STEM expense for iFly of \$1,500, increased USAFA Colorado Trip expense to \$8,000 to potentially cover bus
- Add Marlene Fox Memorial Scholarship: \$1,000 expense, award to be given to a senior cadet at Awards Night in memory of AZ-951 founder Lt. Col Fox's wife, Marlene. While Lt. Col Fox was AZ-951 SASI, Marlene was very involved with the Corps and viewed the Cadets as her own; awarding criteria to determined
- New Morale Shirt: Carly submitted final design for R.E.D. shirt, monies approved at March 2022 Booster meeting, to be purchased during 2022-2023 school year
