

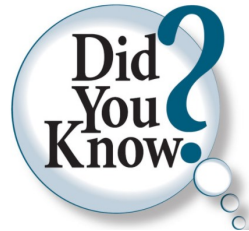


## AZ-951 AFJROTC FAMILY NEWSLETTER

- ◇ Thank you to all of our AZ-951 families and friends for a successful inaugural virtual fundraiser.
- ◇ **\$9,565.00** was donated in total via *RaiseAZ* with our Program receiving **\$7,652.00!**

#### Did You Know?

- \* Drill, Marksmen, and Orienteering teams are governed by the Arizona Interscholastic Association (AIA).
- \* After two years of participation, a JROTC Cadet is eligible to receive the school's Varsity Letter.
- \* Each Spring, Lt Col Wood and MSgt Mandell submit eligible Cadets to the CVHS Athletics Department for recognition.
- \* AZ-951 has the following roadmap awards for those participating in Drill, Marksmen, and/or Orienteering.

- 1st year on the team = Ribbon
- 2nd year on the team = Campo Verde Varsity Letter
- 3rd year on the team = JROTC pin to be placed on the CV letter
- 4th year on the team = Chevron pin to be placed on the CV letter

Additionally, participation in any aspect of a JROTC Program is beneficial when applying for college scholarships or enlisting in an armed service. The school has a great College and Career Center loaded with helpful information — — — →

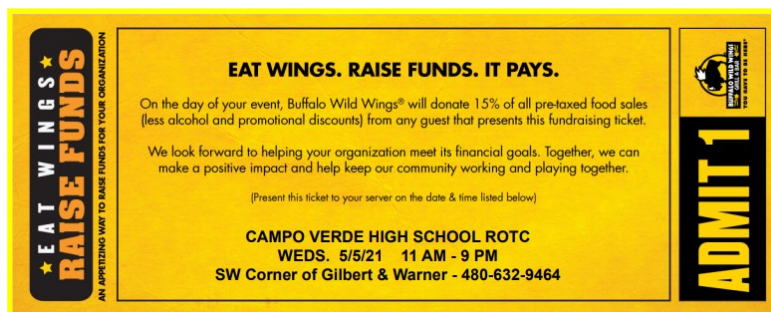


### Restaurant Nights
