

MESSAGE: Divine Transformation and Growth

Isaiah 60:22 NIV - The least of you will become a thousand, the smallest a mighty nation. I am the Lord; in its time I will do this swiftly.

This scripture indicates divine transformation and growth. Meaning God will rapidly fulfill His promises, turning the smallest beginnings into powerful realities at His perfect moment.

It speaks of exponential increase and divine intervention, assuring believers that God will swiftly bring about great change and fulfillment when the appointed time arrives, moving from insignificance to strength.

- **Transformation:** God takes what is small and insignificant and makes it great.
How? [Romans 12:2](#)

NIV - Do not conform to the pattern of this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

NLT - Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.

Special Note: This is where we as God's People and the church have failed short through "Transformation" ([Romans 3:23](#)). But God keep giving us more chances through Jesus Christ ([Romans 3:24](#)).

- **Divine Multiplication:** What starts small, even insignificant, will grow abundantly through God's blessing (a single family becoming a nation). It promises that those who were weak, few, or oppressed will become a "**strong nation**".
- **Hope in Delays:** It serves as a reminder to wait patiently and trust God's plan, knowing He is working behind the scenes, turning struggles into strength and showing His power.
- **Promise of Restoration:** It's part of a larger prophecy about a glorious future, restoration of God's people and bringing them back to His favor and making them influential.
- **The Guarantee of God's Name:** By stating "I am the Lord," God stakes His own character and sovereignty on the fulfillment of this promise.
- **Divine Timing:** This shows us that God controls the timing, fulfilling His plans when they are most effective, even if it seems slow to us. ("In its time") meaning that God has an appointed moment for every blessing and it will happen exactly when it is meant to.
- **Sudden Completion ("I will do this swiftly"):** Once the appointed time arrives, the fulfillment will occur rapidly and without further delay.

[Proverbs 13:22 NKJV](#) - A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children, But the wealth of the sinner is stored up for the righteous.

This means the sinner's resources are not truly theirs to keep and will benefit the people who are prepared to manage them responsibly.
