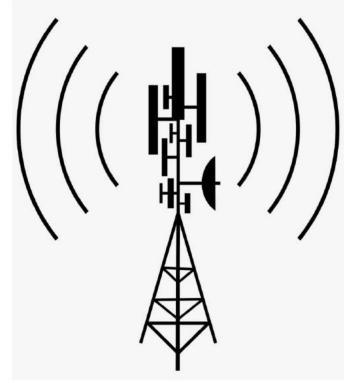

Salutations

It is with a heavy heart, but an immense sense of pride that I tender my resignation today as a Reserve Lieutenant with Hellsgate FD. I was hoping to make 20 years with the Department, but unfortunately that will not be the case. I was able to serve our community for about 17 years.

Bear with me as I reminisce.

I started in 1982 as a volunteer in my hometown of Wells Nevada (pop. 1200) in 1982 with a Certified Ambulance Attendant license and an Advanced First Aid Certificate. College and related career path took me in a different direction after a couple of years of service.

I joined the eventual Hellsgate Community as a homeowner in Collins Ranch in 2004. Within 4 months I found my self battling my first wildland fire solo and subsequently with other members of the community and random strangers with shovels and rakes when wind blew a tree into a power line just outside of the Collins Ranch/Mead Ranch Community. The conclusion was successful when a Tonto Village tender arrived on scene with a couple of volunteers and WATER.

In 2006 a fire coming down from the Rim and a potential evacuation notice introduced me to the concept of a "Red Card". I paid my way to Colorado to get Wildland Certified and was rewarded with a pair of wildland boots and a volunteer position with Tonto Village FD in June 2006.

I was privileged to participate in the "mini-Fire School" put on by the officers of Diamond Star FD for the members of Tonto Village FD prior to the merger. I was in the first class of Tonto Village volunteers sponsored in Fire-Ops training and EMT training and received my certification from the State in Fire Ops I&II, my EMT Certificate and became a sworn member of Hellsgate FD when the departments merged. This led to EMS and Fire calls, Wildland assignments, controlled burns and Firewise assessments during my time with Hellsgate FD.

I would like to express my gratitude to the Officers and fellow Firefighters that I served with, those that trained me and those that let me share my knowledge with them. Mere words will not be able to express how much I will always cherish the bond of those I served with.

I was able to fly the Hellsgate FD colors one last time by climbing 110 flights of stairs at the 2023 National Fallen Firefighters Foundation 9/11 Memorial Stair Climb last month in Scottsdale.

Thank you for the opportunity to serve and your indulgence in my trip down memory lane.

BOARD POLICY GUIDELINES



TITLE: Board Membership and Qualifications

EFFECTIVE DATE: 05/11/2011

I. PURPOSE

To set forth the membership and qualifications of the Board in accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes 48-805.

II. MEMBERS

There shall be five members of the Board.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

A member of the Board must be a resident of the District at the time of his or her election, and must remain so during the period of his or her incumbency. Additionally, at the time of his or her election, the member must be at least 18 years of age and be a registered voter.

IV. ELECTION AND TERMS

Members of the Board shall be elected in accordance with the laws of the State of Arizona. Board members are elected for a term of four years; the terms of the members are staggered in order to allow for continuity. The term of each member shall begin on the first day of the month following that member's election. Each Board member shall take the oath of office at least 24 hours prior to the first general meeting following his or her election.

When a District election is held for the purpose of electing Board members, the election shall be held per Arizona Revised Statutes 48-802, and shall be overseen by the powers of applicable County Boards of Elections. The Board shall cooperate with the applicable County requirements for conducting elections.

V. FILLING BOARD VACANCIES

In the event that there is a vacancy on the Board caused by the resignation or death of a Board member, this vacancy shall be filled by an individual selected by a majority of the remaining Board members. The Board shall select an individual to serve within a reasonable time following the occurrence of the vacancy. An individual selected by the Board to fill a vacancy shall serve the remainder of the unexpired term.

TITLE: Board Membership and Qualifications

EFFECTIVE DATE: 05/11/2011

The vote of the Board to fill a vacancy shall be carried out as follows:

- 1. The Chairperson shall call for a discussion of potential replacements.
- 2. The Board members may nominate replacement candidates and all members of the Board shall then vote on all such nominations collectively until one candidate receives the majority of the votes cast. In the event that there is a deadlock in the voting, the process shall continue until such a replacement is selected.
- 3. Once an individual is selected by a majority vote, the Chairperson shall call for a motion for that person to fill the vacancy on the Board for the unexpired balance of the term created by the vacancy.
- 4. The Chairperson shall direct the Fire Chief to notify the selected replacement Board member.

VI. COMPENSATION

The Board shall serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed for any actual and reasonable expenses incurred on behalf of the District, which are authorized by the Board.

LOYALTY OATH BOARD MEMBER HELLSGATE FIRE DISTRICT

38-231. OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES REQUIRED TO TAKE LOYALTY OATH; FORM; PENALTY

A. In order to ensure the statewide application of this section on a uniform basis, each board, commission, agency and independent office of this state, and of any of its political subdivisions, and of any county, city, town, municipal corporation, school district and public educational institution, shall completely reproduce this section so that the form of written oath or affirmation required in this section contains all of the provisions of this section for use by all officers and employees of all boards, commissions, agencies and independent offices.

- B. Any officer or employee who fails to take and subscribe to the oath or affirmation provided by this section within the time limits prescribed by this section is not entitled to any compensation until the officer or employee does so take and subscribe to the form of oath or affirmation prescribed by this section.
- C. Any officer or employee having taken the form of oath or affirmation prescribed by this section, and knowingly at the time of subscribing to the oath or affirmation, or at any time thereafter during the officer's or employee's term of office or employment, does commit or aid in the commission of any act to overthrow by force, violence or terrorism as defined in section 13-2301 the government of this state or of any of its political subdivisions, or advocates the overthrow by force, violence or terrorism as defined in section 13-2301 of the government of this state or of any of its political subdivisions, is guilty of a class 4 felony and, on conviction under this section, the officer or employee is deemed discharged from the office or employment and is not entitled to any additional compensation or any other emoluments or benefits which may have been incident or appurtenant to the office or employment.
- D. Any of the persons referred to in article XVIII, section 10, Constitution of Arizona, as amended, relating to the employment of aliens, are exempted from any compliance with this section.
- E. In addition to any other form of oath or affirmation specifically provided by law for an officer or employee, before any officer or employee enters upon the duties of the office or employment, the officer or employee shall take and subscribe the following oath or affirmation:
- F. For the purposes of this section, "officer or employee" means any person elected, appointed or employed, either on a part-time or full-time basis, by this state or any of its political subdivisions or any county, city, town, municipal corporation, school district, public educational institution or any board, commission or agency of any county, city, town, municipal corporation, school district or public educational institution.
