- 2. We have 7 Suppression Full-time, 1 Administrative Full-time and 7 Reserve FF's.
- 3. Wildland Division Currently we have no engines or crews assigned to wildfires. I have been informed that the State of Arizona will begin filling orders from the Southwest Coordination Center tomorrow morning and I expect Hellsgate will be sending a Type 3 Engine to California or Oregon.
- 4. Grants I am currently waiting to hear back on the following grant requests:

**FEMA Fire Act/AFG Grants** - \$413,000 approx. for a new water tender. **Gila River Indian Community** - \$49,507.00 for a new SCBA air compressor system. (I have learned that the GRIC grants are not being awarded this year.

I received notice that we were once again unsuccessful in getting the **Governor's Office of Highway Safety** - \$38,000 approx. for powered extrication equipment. I will be drafting a letter to the Director and the Governor's staff requesting information on what we might do to improve our chances of receiving such a grant.

additional positions available in each program to bring on more reserves as interest grows.

- 11. New Gila County Treasurer Error –Business Manager Angela Lecher has informed me that due to a tax collection and distribution error, \$396 has been removed from the District's warrants account. Other fire districts report up to \$16,000 being removed from their accounts. This apparently is tied to how much solar energy projects exist in the district and a tax credit that was due to those property owners.
- 12. Major Call Activity over Labor Day Weekend HFD responded to several serious motor vehicle accidents over the holiday weekend as well as a 2<sup>nd</sup> Alarm structure fire in Payson. Two accidents were on the undivided portion of highway 260 resulting in one fatality and 5 seriously injured patients being flow to trauma centers. One accident involved an elderly Bear Flats resident who drove his ATV over a 30 foot rocky cliff. He was also flow to a trauma center. I assisted Christopher Kohls FD by setting up a landing zone for a medical helicopter that flew a 4 year old child with a head injury due to a UTV accident into a tree, to Phoenix Children's Hospital. The child's sister was transported to Banner Payson. On Monday afternoon following Labor Day, a shed caught fire in Payson and the flames quickly spread to the residence and the residence next door. HFD E211 was on the original dispatch but Payson had to call for a second alarm assignment, bringing

engines from Christopher Kohls FD, Waterwheel FD and Pine Strawberry FD to combat the blaze. I also was dispatched to the original call and acted as Safety and forward commander.

13. Station 22 – After meeting with USFS supervisors, I was able to get the local ranger district to purchase 300 castle blocks to erect barrier walls at station 22 to stop soil erosion. The blocks are being installed by the USFS engine crews who are using the station.

Jeff Shaw has been generously helping install speakers and a cellular phone booster system in station 22. I had purchased the upgraded equipment some time back but was unable to find the time to get it installed.

14. Vehicle Maintenance Issues - Both of our Type 3 wildland engines have needed repairs. It was discovered that multiple transfer case seals were needed on Engine 231 and the turbo booster failed in Engine 213. Engine 213 has been repaired and we are awaiting parts for Engine 231.

Ladder 211 had an air line distribution failure. Parts have come in and repairs are underway.

I want to note that we have continued to budget a significant amount for vehicle repairs due to the

age of our fleet. If unexpected repairs exceed our budgeted amounts, we have adequate funds in our capital reserve funds to make all repairs.
