

THE ORIGIN AND VISION OF JOMAH ENTERPRISE, INC.

Jomah Enterprise, Inc. was founded in 2001 in response to the heartbreaking plight of a young girl named Klubo. At just 8 years old, Klubo had lost both her parents to the devastating civil war and was living with relatives who subjected her to harsh treatment. Instead of attending school, she was burdened with responsibilities well beyond her years—cooking, cleaning, and washing clothes. Despite her circumstances, Klubo had an eagerness to learn but was denied the opportunity to pursue an education.

Klubo's story was not an isolated one. Everywhere I looked, I saw children forced to bear the weight of responsibilities meant for adults. Children became breadwinners, selling goods on the streets to provide food for their families.

Witnessing these realities was both heartbreaking and infuriating—children who should have been nurtured and protected were instead thrust into survival mode, denied their basic rights to safety, love, and education.

After my father's burial, I returned to the United States with a single goal: to help one child. I believed that if I could make a difference in just one life, I would fulfill the purpose God had for me. But God had bigger plans. He revealed to me the larger vision that my late father had been striving to accomplish—building a foundation that would provide education, stability, and opportunity to the children and community of Sinoe County.
