Windows Basics

Days: Half-day (3 hrs.)

Prerequisites: Basic keyboarding, mouse experience, and exposure to documents and files is helpful

Description: This half-day course introduces students to the major new features and enhancements in Windows. Students will learn how to customize the Windows environment, use jump lists and gadgets, manage content by using libraries and File Explorer, search for content, interact with devices, protect files, troubleshoot problems, and use new privacy and security features in Internet Explorer. Suitable for users of Windows 10.
