Scholarship Award: \$1,000.00 Annual Award

Scholarship Eligibility:

- High School Senior must receive diploma from a high school located within Mason County, Washington.
- 2.8 GPA or greater
- Must meet eligibility requirements for law enforcement.
- Acceptance to and enrollment in a two- or four-year college or university, in pursuit of a law enforcement or criminal justice career. The student must take a minimum of nine units per semester.
- Applicant needs to demonstrate that he/she is capable of succeeding in this
 educational pursuit and that this scholarship will help them in this endeavor.
- Submit completed Scholarship Application Form with Personal Essay and required Letters of Reference.

- **B.** Attach a certified copy of your high school transcript
- **C.** Attach two Official Letters of Reference the letters of reference should explain how the applicant meets the criteria and intent of this program to award a student who aspires to a carrier in law enforcement or criminal justice.
 - One letter of reference must be from a member of the applicant's high school staff or faculty a teacher, administrator, or activity sponsor.
 - The second letter of reference may be from someone whose life has been positively affected by the applicant such as a community or activity sponsor, employer, minister, teacher, etc.
- **D.** Attach a Personal Essay telling us about yourself and describing your dreams and goals. Tell us why you should be considered for this scholarship and how it will help you acheive your dreams and goals. Please also address each of the following, as they apply to you:

Leadership: Give an example of where you were able to demonstrate leadership and/or initiative, descision making skills, creativity, and generosity.

Community Service: Describe your involvement with your community. List organizations and clubs you have been a member of and/or extra-curricular activities you've participated in and how your participation helped to acheive a worthwhile goal. Tell us about what types of volunteer opportunities you've taken advantage of and how your contribution helped make a difference for someone.
