



HILLSBORO, Indiana—October 15, 2021 –Up next in Myers Dinner Theatre's 25th Anniversary season will be Thornton Wilder's Pulitzer Prize winning, *Our Town,* opening March 5 at 12:00, and running through March 21 at 5:00. A landmark in American drama, Thornton Wilder's Pulitzer Prize-winning drama tells the story of a small town, Grover's Corners, New Hampshire, in order to tell us the story of every town, the whole world over.



Narrated by the "Stage Manager", we follow the Gibbs and Webb families, residents of Grover's Corners, through twelve years of life changes -- from the mundane in Act I, "Daily Life," to the romantic in Act II, "Love and Marriage," to the devastating in Act III, "Death and Eternity." Through the young lovers Emily and George, their strong and loving parents, and the many other Grover's Corners' locals, Wilder delivers universal truths about what it means to be

human. "Oh, earth," Emily Webb exclaims towards the play's end, "you're too wonderful for anyone to realize you."

This outstanding drama will be directed by Paul Kerr of Kentucky, who is making his Myers
