- Crown Classical began organizing in 2022.
- We are a hybrid educational program for homeschool students in West Tennessee.
- We provide tutorial classes and educational activities for homeschooled children.
- We strive to foster creativity, joy in learning, and problem-solving by empowering students to take ownership of their education and commit to lifelong learning.
- Crown Classical is organized exclusively for educational purposes as described under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code.

Class Policy

- Crown Classical is an educational organization that respects all religious and spiritual backgrounds. Therefore, our classes are taught with mindfulness and respect of sensitive topics.
- Crown Classical does not discriminate based on race, gender, national or ethnic origin, or
- religion.
- Crown Classical retains the right to make admission, readmission, and continuing enrollment decisions on a case-by-case basis. By agreeing to the policies in this handbook, both students and parents/guardians acknowledge that Crown Classical can deny admission, readmission, or expel a student when deemed in the best interest of the student or the school.
- Crown Classical tutorial classes are taught by degreed professionals with knowledge in education or their specific subject area.
- Crown Classical does not issue credit or grades. Parents/Guardians may contact tutors for suggested grades.

Fees Policy

Crown Classical has an annual tuition for each academic year from August through May. In addition, classes may require purchased texts and supplies.

- All Crown Classical fees are Non-Refundable.
- All payments must be made on the 1st of the month, with a \$30 late fee after the 10th.
- Returned Check Fee: \$30
- Student absences, vacation days, and unforeseen Crown Classical closures are not deducted from tuition.

Student Code of Conduct

- I will respect, listen to, and obey all teachers and assistants.
- I will respect my peers and their personal space and property.
- I will treat the facility's property with care and will help clean-up with a positive attitude.

- I will not bring technology (phones, iPods, iPads, tablets, cameras, computers, etc.) to class unless permission has been obtained from Administration.

- I understand that failure to abide by the Code of Conduct will result in either temporary or permanent removal from the group.

Behavioral Guidelines

Crown Classical is committed to governing our actions to honor our Triune God. This commitment means that we are able to define appropriate behavior, promote positive actions, and discourage behaviors that are inconsistent with our values. Our goal is to promote an environment characterized by grace, accountability, forgiveness, learning, and growth. In circumstances when a student may not display appropriate behavior, we will work to bring training and restoration. Communication between Crown Classical and home are vital. When parents/guardians keep us informed of any concerns or problems, we are be able to work together to create a safe and rewarding atmosphere for all.

Facility Use Policy

All areas of the meeting location—including the buildings, playgrounds, sidewalks, and planted areas—shall be respected and treated with care.
