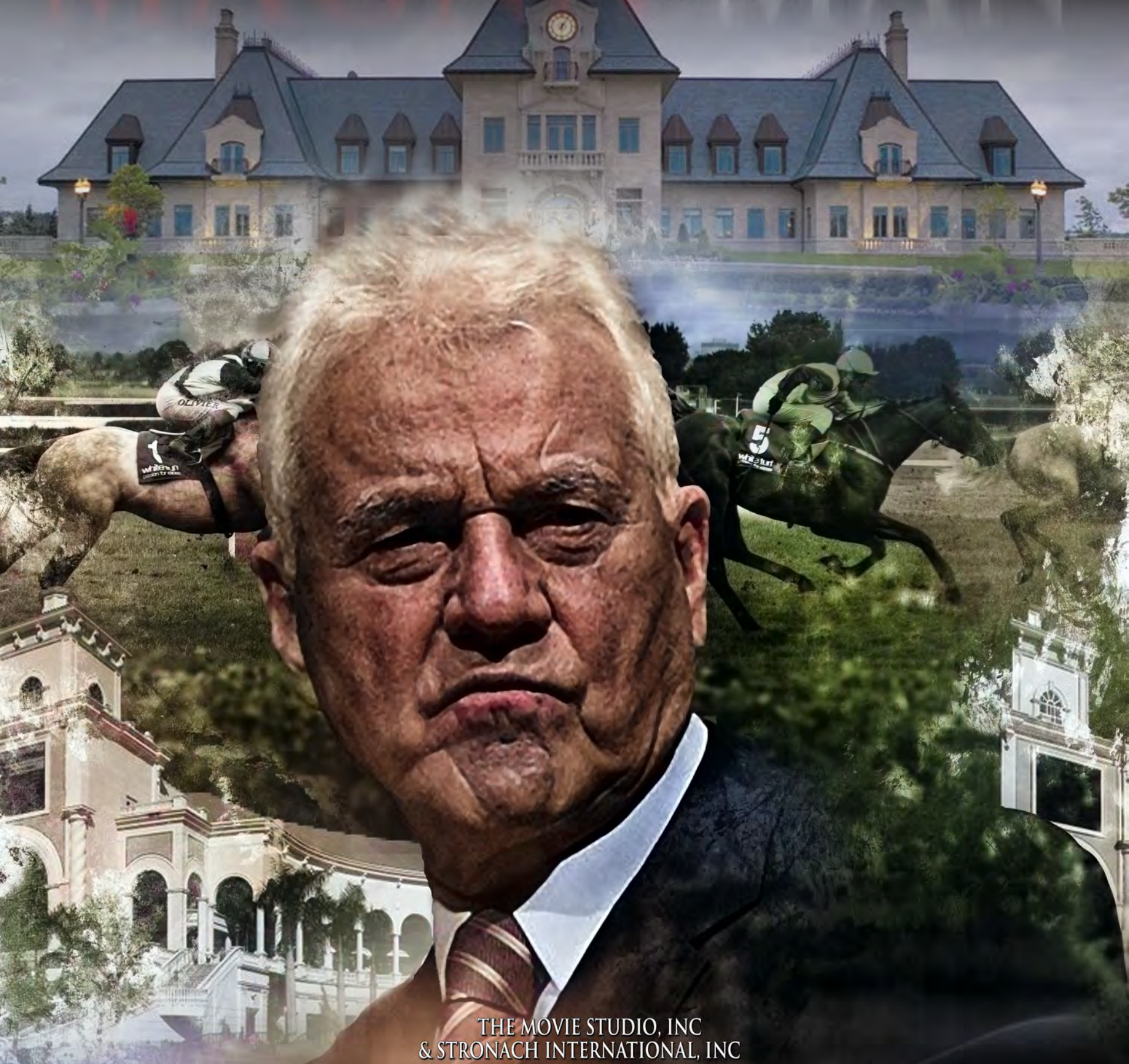

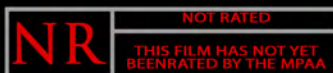

# THE MAGNA MAN

THE TRUE LIFE STORY OF FRANK STRONACH

Frank Stronach opened a one-man tool and die shop in a rented garage and built it into Magna International Inc., the New York Stock Exchange auto parts giant that boasts over \$40 billion in annual revenue and 180,000 employees at 450 manufacturing and R&D centers in 28 countries.

His love of horses led to the creation of Adena Springs – breeders of some of the world's greatest thoroughbred champions – and The Stronach Group, which owns and operates some of the most famous racetracks in America, including Gulfstream Park, home of the iconic Pegasus statue. The colossal bronze sculpture, one of the largest in the world, pays homage to the courage, speed and power of the horse and was created by Frank Stronach as an enduring tribute to the great contributions that horses have made to the civilization of mankind.

Stronach believes the world has always been dominated by the Golden Rule: whoever has the gold makes the rules. He wants to dismantle the chains of domination – not by violent revolution – but by a revolution of the mind, and he believes the best way to achieve that is through the creation of an Economic Charter of Rights Responsibilities. The rationale behind the Charter is that if the economy doesn't function, nothing else will – you cannot feed the hungry or look after the poor, the sick and the disabled. Stronach realizes that the economy is driven by three forces: smart managers, hard-working employees, and investors. All three have a right to the outcome, which is profits – one of the seven common-sense economic principles that make up the Charter. Frank Stronach's mission is that Canada becomes the first country in the world to enshrine an Economic Charter of Rights to lessen the growing divide between the wealthy and the workers and eliminate poverty.

Frank Stronach's legacy of fostering growth, fairness and shared prosperity has changed the future for the better and will live on for generations to come.

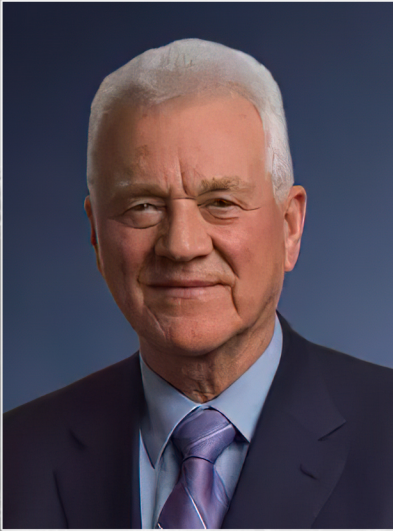

Frank Stronach is the founder and Honorary Chairman of Magna International Inc., the world's most diversified automotive supplier, and founder and Honorary Chairman of The Stronach Group, North America's leading Thoroughbred racetrack operator and one of the world's largest suppliers of pari-mutuel wagering systems, technologies and services.

Mr. Stronach founded Magna in 1957 as a one-man tool and die shop in a rented garage. The Company today employs 131,000 people in 313 manufacturing operations and 84 product development and engineering centers in 28 countries. Magna manufactures a wide range of vehicle systems, including: automotive interior systems; seating systems; closure systems; body and chassis systems; vision systems; electronic systems; exterior systems; powertrain systems; closure and roof systems; as well as complete vehicle engineering and contract manufacturing. Magna had sales in 2014 of US \$36.6 billion and is listed and traded on the Toronto Stock Exchange in Canada (MG) and the New York Stock Exchange in the US (MGA). Mr. Stronach introduced his unique management philosophy, known as Fair Enterprise, to Magna in 1971. Fair Enterprise is based on a business Charter of Rights that predetermines the annual percentage of profits shared between employees, management, investors and society. These rights are enshrined in a governing Corporate Constitution.

### **GORDON SCOTT VENTERS**

Mr. Venters, Is the President and CEO of The Movie Studio, Inc. a publicly traded Company (OTC: MVES) a vertically integrated Motion Picture Production Distribution and Acquisition Company.

With over 25 years experience and highly accomplished in the media space and is well known as a first mover disrupting distribution in the motion picture and digital signage sectors. Previously forming "destination television" (OTC: DSTV) with an article in Forbes, New York Times highlighting his accomplishments as was one of the pioneer innovators of forward storage digital delivery in the Out of Home (DOOH).

Producer Jonathan Sanger has enjoyed over a 40 year successful career as both a movie and theatre producer. To date his films have received 3 Academy Awards, 21 Academy Award Nominations, a British Academy Film award and a French Cesar among numerous other awards.

Jonathan Sanger is an American film, television, and theater producer and director known for his work on movies like The Elephant Man, Vanilla Sky, Mission Impossible 2 and The Producers. His career spans over 40 years, and his films have received numerous accolades, including three Academy Awards and 21 Academy Award nominations. He is Brooklyn, New York native who began his career after attending the University of Pennsylvania and working in the Peace Corps, where he helped create an educational television station in Uruguay.

## ACCLAIMED DIRECTOR



## MARS CALLAHAN

Mars Callahan started out in show business as a child actor called Gregory Martin. He played guest appearances on TV shows such as Growing Pains, Knots Landing and The Wonder Years, and was nominated for a Young Artist award for his role in the TV movie The Children of Times Square (1986). At 20, he was credited as Gregory Mars Martin for his role in the film Highway to Hell (1992), and when he played a small role in Kalifornia (1993) the following year, he'd dropped his first name completely. By the time he appeared in Tom Hanks' That Thing You Do! (1996), he'd changed his name again, this time to Mars Callahan.

After several years of playing small roles in films, Callahan decided to try his hand at writing and directing his own screenplays. An accomplished pool player, Callahan met writer Chris Corso in a pool hall, and after swapping stories about their mutual experiences playing pool, the two decided to write a script based on their experiences and observations. Callahan sent the finished script to Christopher Walken who, after reading the script, immediately called Callahan to tell him he wanted to be a part of the project. Having Walken on board gave Callahan the clout to approach other established actors such as Chazz Palminteri, who instantly agreed to join the cast after reading the script. Callahan not only co-wrote and directed Poolhall Junkies (2003), but he took on the main role as Johnny Doyle.

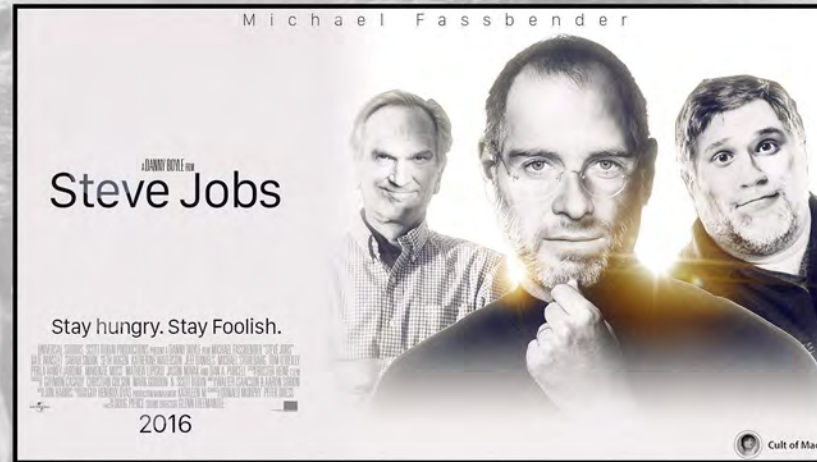
