Every precaution will be taken to insure the safety of all exhibits but in no case will the Fair Board or Extension Service be responsible for loss of, or injury to, exhibits.

- Any item entered that does not conform to general rules will be placed on exhibit only.
- Any class may be divided if the judge feels the class warrants such division and there are at least three items on each new class. Entries must have been completed since the previous year's County Fair.
- Only ribbons will be awarded unless otherwise specified.

- **An annual "Homemaker Award" will be given to an exhibitor in the open class who enters five (5) different divisions. Points will be awarded as follows:**

**5 points for 1<sup>st</sup>  
4 points for 2<sup>nd</sup>  
3 points for 3<sup>rd</sup>  
2 points for 4<sup>th</sup>  
1 point for 5<sup>th</sup>**

If only 3 places are awarded, points will only be given to the places awarded.

**THE LINCOLN COUNTY FAIR USES THE AMERICAN JUDGING SYSTEM. EACH ENTRY IS CONSIDERED AGAINST EVERY OTHER ENTRY AND JUDGED AGAINST A STANDARD OR IDEAL. IF NO ENTRIES ARE WORTHY OF A FIRST PLACE SCORE AS SET IN THE STANDARD, THEN FIRST PLACE IS NOT AWARDED.**

# BAKING

## UNIT 1

- Adult (ages 16 and older)

### BAKED GOODS

No baked goods requiring refrigeration will be allowed. None of the following will be allowed: cream/meringue pies; custard- type pies (i.e. pumpkin, cheesecake); cream cheese icings/frostings or fillings; sour cream frosting/icings/frostings or fillings; icings/frostings with raw eggs; melted cheese toppings or fillings; and anything baked in a canning jar, can, bag, or clay pot. Items must be at room temperature at the time of entry. Baked goods must be entered on paper plates or in non breakable containers. No mixes.

## FOOD PRESERVATION

All food goods will be accepted in standard canning jars only and must be sealed with rings in place. Jars should be clean and unadorned except in the case of gift packs where decoration of jars will be allowed. Judges may remove rings during judging.

Dried foods and leathers must be in standard canning jars with seals and rings but do not need to be sealed. There should be a minimum of 10 pieces in each jar of dried foods and a minimum of 5 leather pieces.

### **SPECIAL RULES: PHOTO SHOW**

1. Each photograph must be mounted in a window mat
2. Framed or glass covered photos will not be accepted
3. Minimum overall matted size is 8" x 10"
4. Maximum overall matted size is 20" x 24"
5. Each matted photograph must be backed with a sturdy cardboard or foam board the same size as the mat. Mat and backing board must be **securely held together to create a displayable unit.**
6. Do NOT sign or mark the front of the mat or the photograph in any way that can identify the photographer.
7. No titles or captions

8. On the lower right hand corner of the back:  
Title of photograph, category, photographer's name and address, photographer's phone number and email, year taken
9. Photographs must have been taken within the past 12 months
10. No re-entry of previously entered photographs
11. Photographer must choose category

4. Each entry must have been completed since the 2015 Fair.
5. The Lincoln County Fair uses the American Judging System. Each entry is considered against every other entry in its class and judged against a standard or ideal. If no entries are worthy of a First Place score as set in the standard, then First Place is not awarded.

## FINE ARTS SHOW

Youth 12-17 years of age (Limit 2 Pieces)

Non-Professional Artist (does not receive income from work of art)

Professional Artist (shows or has sold any piece (1 artwork))

### SPECIAL RULES:

1. No picture will be accepted unless it is framed or matted and wired and ready to display, with the exception of "youth" which will be accepted as is.
2. The public will vote for Best of Show
3. Each entry will be judged on its own merit

**JUDGING PROCEDURES- FINE ART**

1. Judges will work independently and at different times
2. Judges will evaluate each print on a tally sheet
3. Entries will be judged on creativity, composition, technical quality, and image content on a scale of 1 to 5 for each criteria/lot/class
4. Highest score in each lot/class will win 1<sup>st</sup> place and so on
5. Judges will indicate their choices for highest awards overall in Painting/Drawing, 3 Dimensional Arts and Digital art. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion ribbons and awards will be given respectively.
6. The committee chairman will break any tie.

## **AWARDS**

1. Only the top three in each adult category/division will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place ribbons. Youth division will be awarded to the top 6 in each category and participation ribbons will be given to all youth who participate.
2. The Best of Show print will be selected by the judges from the highest score of all divisions and categories.
