Junior Livestock Auction Information

Each August the County Fair culminates with a livestock auction held on the Friday evening of the Fair for the 4-H and FFA youth of Lincoln County, who have raised Show Animals which have placed well at the Fair. Animals that make the Sale include Market Steers, Lambs, Pigs, Meat Goats and Meat Rabbits. Dairy Heifers, Yearling Prospect Colts and Turkeys are also sold. Indoor winning entries that are also available for purchase at the auction are the Grand Champion Pie and Cake and the Best Overall Indoor Award which can be anything from a quilt to a welding project that has been created by a 4H or FFA member. The sale is preceded by a Supporters and Buyers Dinner, which is invitation only based on previous years donations and or Sale purchases. Anyone wishing to become a new Buyer is asked to contact the Junior Livestock Sale Committee Co-Chairman Melody Gaines 575-430-0490 lcfsalecommittee@gmail.com to be placed on the Guest List.

Auction items sell anywhere from \$1,000 to \$10,000 each. All proceeds from the Junior Livestock Auction go back to the exhibitors to use for next year's projects or for their college education. Youth involved with the County Fair that have animals in the Sale range in age from 9-19 years old and are members in good standing with their 4-H Clubs or FFA Chapters. The 4-H Clubs and/or FFA Chapters are from the Lincoln County communities of Corona, Carrizozo, Capitan, Hondo and Ruidoso.

Several communities involved with the Fair have a Buyer's Club or Pool, where donations can be made to make purchases from the exhibitors in their area or give them Add-Ons, which are monetary gifts that can be added to a purchase someone else has made or is just additional money that can be given to any exhibitor whether they make the Sale or not.

When an animal is purchased, it can be sold to the packer, given back to the exhibitor or can be sent for processing to a local meat processor that will pick up the animals and deliver them back to Lincoln County all packaged up and ready for your freezer.

Contributing to a Buyer's Club is an economical way to be part of the Junior Livestock

The Booster Jack-Pot is a fund set aside for just those Exhibitors who <u>DID NOT MAKE THE</u>

<u>SALE</u> with any of their qualifying animals. This fund can be contributed to by anyone, at anytime. The funds are dispersed based on the amount of donations received and the weight of the exhibitor's heaviest market animal and is given to those exhibitors who show Market Lambs, Market Goats or Market Swine.

The LCF Sale Committee handles all funds regarding the Junior Livestock Sale, Add-Ons and Booster Jack-Pot. Those funds are dispersed directly to the Exhibitors in the form of a check sent to them and their parents beginning in October after the Fair.
