

CAKE & PIE CONTEST

1. Only currently enrolled 4-H and FFA members in good standing may enter.
2. Boosters may not enter.
3. Entries must be checked in to the Fair Office located in the Fletcher Hall Building between 12:00pm and 1:00pm on **MONDAY August 3, 2026**.
4. Pies and Cakes entered must be made from scratch and entered in a disposable pie pan, or on a cardboard cake round.
5. A complete, printed or typed Recipe must be turned in with each entry and must include all ingredients, quantities and baking instructions. Any pie or cake turned in without a recipe will be disqualified.
6. The Entry Fee is \$5.00 per entry with a limit of two (2) entries per person. Bring a check or cash along with entries. No pre-entries will be done ahead of time. Participants are entered when cakes and pies arrive and entry payments are made. Make checks out to "LCFA" or bring \$5 cash.
7. Participants may enter up to two (2) cakes; or two (2) pies; or one (1) cake and one (1) pie. However, a participant can only make the Sale with one cake or one pie, not both.
8. Rules for the cakes and pies:
 - a. Cakes must be frosted and have at least two {2} layers.
 - b. Pies must be double crust pies; one for the bottom and one for the top. The top crust can be a full pie crust, a lattice crust, or covered with cut-outs made from pie crust dough that cover at least 50% of the top of the pie. Crumb crusts are not allowed.
9. A slice of each cake or pie, with the placing ribbons and recipes will be displayed during the Fair. The remaining cakes and pies will be released Monday at 3:30pm and can be picked up after the completion of the judging. Anything left after 4:30pm on Monday will be given away.
10. The Grand Champion Pie and the Grand Champion Cake winners will be eligible to be sold at the Junior Livestock Auction on Friday night.
11. A fresh Pie or Cake must be made for the Auction, displayed and presented on a nice covered pie plate or covered cake plate that will be sold along with the winning pie and cake. If more than one Buyer purchases the Pie or Cake, the exhibitor has 30 days to bake additional pies or cakes for the additional Buyers.
