

Barrel to Keg Relay

Exchange Zone 5

Exchange: Old Mill on Harlan-Burnt Woods Road (23.27 total miles)

Parking: at Harlan Community Center (see attached maps)

Roads: paved, rolling hills

Notes: Traffic is busier on this leg, so be cautious

Landmarks: Johnson Creek Road at Mile 4.8

Where to Get Gas and Food: Blodgett Country Store (21412 Hwy 20)

Location: near intersection of Harlan-Burnt Woods Road and Mary's Peak Road (7.7 miles from Hwy 20)

What3Words Location: milestones.meadow.relaxed

Position A: Exchange Leader—responsible for knowing the layout of the exchange and parking. Make sure that all volunteers are in the right spots and know their jobs. Fill in for other volunteers as needed.

Position B: Spotter—assist the ham radio operator by spotting and recording which teams have passed this exchange

Position C: Monitor the exchanges, which occur between the orange delineators. There are no batons; touching hands is sufficient

Position D: No Parking—direct vans to *not* park near the exchange, but keep going and take a left at Mary's Peak Road

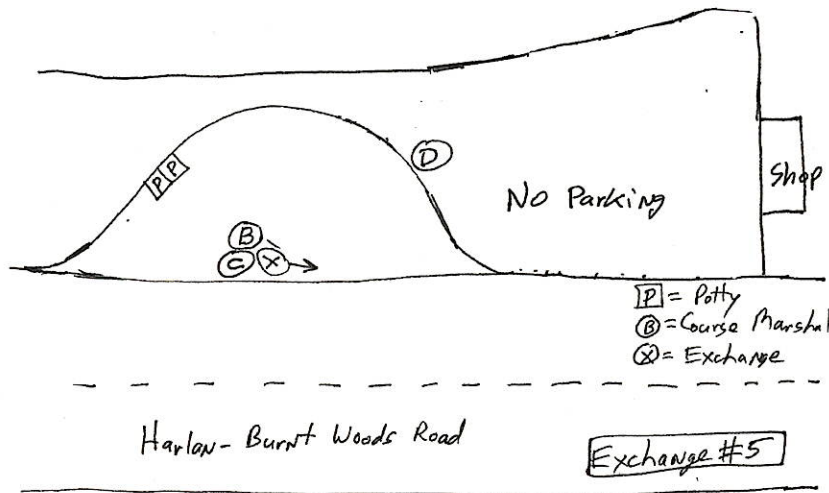
Position E/F/G: Direct vans to turn left at Mary's Peak Road, turn left into the Harlan Community Center parking lot, and where to park/not park in the lot. Parked vans should not block driveways.

How to get to Exchange #11:

From Corvallis: Go west on Highway 20 through Philomath (21.5 miles from Hwy 99W/34/20), turn left at Harlan-Burnt Woods Road. Go 7.7 miles. The exchange is at the pullover area on the left; parking is just past the next left.

From Newport: Go east on Highway 20 (29 miles from Highway 101). Just past Ellmaker State Park turn right at Harlan-Burnt Woods Road. Go 7.7 miles. The exchange is at the pullover area on the left; parking is just past the next left.
