Where to Get Gas and Food: Chevron (254 W Highway 20, Toledo OR 97391) Location: Cannon Quarry Boat Ramp (3 miles east of Toledo on Elk City Road)

GPS: Latitude N 44° 36' 15.6" Longitude W 123° 54' 7.5"

<u>Position A</u>: Exchange Leader—responsible for knowing the layout of the exchange and making sure all volunteers are in the right spot and know what their supposed to do. Fill in if a volunteer doesn't report or extra help is needed.

<u>Position B</u>: Spotter—assist the Ham Radio Operator. Record walking team numbers and start times; report these to the race director.

<u>Position C/D/E</u>: Direct vehicles to park in the boat ramp parking lot. Double park when possible in the long spots.

<u>Position F</u>: Monitor the exchanges, which occur between the orange delineators. There are no batons; touching hands is sufficient.

How to get to Exchange #10:

<u>From Corvallis</u>: Go west on Highway 20 (44 miles from Highways 99W/34/20). Go south on Business Highway 20 (to Toledo). Turn left at NW A Street, left at NW 1st Ave, right on Butler Bridge Road (which becomes Elk City Road), to the Cannon Quarry Boat Ramp (6 miles from the intersection of Hwy 20 and Business Hwy 20).

<u>From Newport</u>: Go east on Highway 20 (5.5 miles from Highway 101), go southeast on Business Highway 20 (to Toledo). Turn right at NW A Street, left at NW 1st Ave, right on Butler Bridge Road (which becomes Elk City Road), to the Cannon Quarry Boat Ramp (5.5 miles from the intersection of Hwy 20 and Business Hwy 20).
