## Barrel to Keg Relay

## Exchange Zone 9

Exchange: Elk City County Park (44.05 total miles)

Parking: in parking lot or on right side of Harlan Road. Do not park on Elk City Road.

Roads: gravel, mostly flat

**Notes:** roads are dusty, so keep speed 25-30mph. Be careful crossing Elk City Road.

Landmarks: bridge at Mile 1.3

Where to Get Gas and Food: Chevron (254 W Highway 20, Toledo OR 97391) Location: Elk City County Park (intersection of Elk City Road and Harlan Road)

What3words Location: tried.sublime.yelling

<u>Position A</u>: Exchange Leader—responsible for knowing the layout of the exchange and making sure all volunteers are in the right spot and know what their supposed to do. Fill in if a volunteer doesn't report or extra help is needed.

<u>Position B</u>: Spotter—assist the Ham Radio Operator.

<u>Position C</u>: Stand by "Stop Ahead" sign. Direct runners to keep left; direct vans to park in the county park lot or on Harlan Road if the lot fills up.

<u>Position D/E</u>: Monitor traffic and runners. Direct vans to park in the county park lot or on Harlan Road if the lot fills up.

<u>Position F</u>: Monitor the exchanges, which occur between the orange delineators. There are no batons; touching hands is sufficient.

Position G: Monitor traffic as runners turn onto Elk City Road.

## How to get to Exchange #9:

<u>From Corvallis</u>: Go west on Highway 20, through Philomath (38 miles from Highways 99W/34/20), turn left at Elk City Road, and go 5 miles.

<u>From Newport</u>: Go east on Highway 20 (13 miles from Hwy 101), turn right at Elk City Road, and go 5 miles.
