This show is open to youth 18 and under from any county with the exception of classes #3,4,10,11,16,19,and 21 which are only open to Kenton County 4-H members in good standing. All Kenton County youth must enroll in 4-H by April 1, complete 6 hours of horse education with a certified leader by May 15, and turn in a companion animal project book by July 7 at 4 pm to be eligible for 4-H classes. Only Kenton County 4-H youth in good standing are exempt from entry fees and eligible for high point prizes. All other competitors will be subject to a \$5 per class entry fee and are not eligible for high point prizes. There is no cross entry between lead line and walk trot classes, or walk trot and walk trot canter classes. Members are limited to one division throughout the day. All competitors must wear long pants and boots, and an approved helmet.
