All Kenton County youth must enroll in 4-H by April 1, complete 6 hours of horse education with a certified leader by May 15, and turn in a companion animal project book by July 6 at 4pm. Only Kenton County 4-H youth in good standing are exempt from entry fees and eligible for high point prizes. All other competitors will be subject to a \$10 per class entry fee and are not eligible for high point prizes. There is no cross entry between lead line and walk trot classes, or walk trot and walk trot canter classes. All competitors must wear long pants and boots, and an approved helmet. Ribbons only, no payout on any classes.
