Praise Reports

Crime down 10 percent from 2016 in Federal Way

Residential burglary, larceny, vehicle theft, forgery, vandalism all show decreases from 2016

In 2017, 329 residential burglaries have been reported, compared with 348 last year, a decrease of 5 percent. There were 3,531 reports of larceny in 2016 compared with 3,132 this year, an 11 percent decrease. Motor vehicle theft is down by 17 percent, with 783 reported this year and 941 last year. There were 150 reports of counterfeit/forgery in 2016 and 109 this year for a 27 percent decrease. Vandalism reports are down to 710 for 2017 from 881 last year, a 19 percent change.

Prayer Requests from Police Chief Andy Hwang

I ask for the faith community to pray for the safety of our first responders, police and firefighters. They face many challenges and danger while performing their daily duties to keep our citizens safe.

Please pray to reduce the "demand" on illicit drugs in our community and in our nation. The demand for drugs, particularly heroine and methamphetamine, is responsible for significant amount of violent and property crimes Our crime analyst believe that about 90 percent of all crimes has a nexus to drugs. If we can reduce the demand for drugs, our community and country will be much safer.

Please pray to strengthen our families in our community. Many of the kids and young people engaging in criminal activity and drug abuse come from neglected and abusive homes. Some kids join gangs or hang out with the unsavory people because this is

where they get self worth and acceptance. Some young people behave in a manner as though they have nothing to loose - lack moral compass.

MISSIONS (local and world)

Praise Reports

Light up the City movement (Directed by Union Gospel Mission) has successfully joined 23 city networks of churches and pastors with the sole focus to "Light up the city" where they live. Many are united in their cities with weekly and monthly prayer, Serve Days, ministries to the homeless and the poor, and partnerships with over 300 schools in King County.

World Vision continues to provide great assistance from Federal Way all around the world with all types of humanitarian needs.

Prayer Requests

These are 5 of the current worst disasters listed by World Vision:

East Africa – (Kenya, South Sudan, Ethiopia)

6.9 million children are suffering from malnutrition and 28 million need humanitarian assistance.

Syrian refugee Crisis -

5.3 million Syrians have fled the country as refugees, and 6.3 million are displaced within the country. About 13.5 million people inside the country – almost 3/4 of the population need humanitarian assistance.

Myanmar refugees in Bangladesh -

600,000 people have fled their homes from Myanmar to Bangladesh because of renewed fighting between inter-communal groups, minority groups, and government military forces. There is increased risk of disease in refugee settlements. Great need for food, fresh water, and basic tents and shelter.

Hurricanes Harvey, Irma, and Maria

The 2017 hurricane season in the Caribbean and Atlantic regions has been one of historic proportions.

Puerto Rico is devastated and struggling to recover after Hurricane Maria, the strongest storm to hit in more than 80 years, pummeled the island territory Sept.

20. Almost two months on, most of the island is still without power. Puerto Rican authorities estimate there was \$45 billion to \$95 billion in damages Many other Caribbean islands fared as badly or worse after Irma and Maria.

Democratic Republic of Congo refugees and violence

The people of the DRC have endured more than two decades of civil war and conflict, which has claimed as many as 6 million lives. More than 2.5 million people in Kasai, Tanganyika, and South Kivu were displaced in 2017.

Violence has continued to spread in DRC since 2016, displacing more than 4 million people internally and as refugees. More than 13 million people of DRC's nearly 80-million population need humanitarian assistance and protection. More than 7 million people face food insecurity.
