CITY & GOVERNMENT

Chief Hwang's Message: (June 29, 2021)

As a nation, we are experiencing a significant increase in murders, a 25% increase in 2020. This amounts to more than 20,000 murders for the first time since 1995, up from about 16,000 in 2019. And, so far this year the homicide rate is up another 24% and at this pace, our nation's murder rate will surpass the most violent era of the 1980's and 1990's when our nation grappled with the "crack" cocaine epidemic.

As for our region, King County is no exception and we are on record a pace for murders this year. The number of homicides in King County has increase 36% so far this year. In the first three months of 2021, there were 253 shots fired incidents, with a total of 69 people being shot, 16 of those people died. In 2020, King County saw a 58% increase in the number of fatal shootings. In Washington State, there were 302 murders in 2020 in comparison to 206 in 2019, an increase of 32 percent. In Federal Way, we have experienced three homicides for the first six months of this year, down from five the previous year.

We want to thank you and your congregation and other churches for the continual prayers that watch over and lift up police officers here in Federal Way, as well as continued support and prayers for the entire community. It has been a challenging year and the support from the faith community, in part, has helped us to endure during these difficult times. To meet the challenges that lie ahead of us, we must continue to ask God for added wisdom and guidance, as we know that there are no burdens too difficult and nothing is impossible with God. We want to thank you and many others who are continually praying for our officers and professional staff for their safety and well-being.

- 1. Pray for all of our brave police officers who are working tirelessly to ensure the safety of our communities.
- 2. Pray specifically for safe communities and reduction in crime, particularly for the decrease of gun violence and murders in our nation and region involving young men.
- 3. Pray for families a high percentage of violent individuals grow up in abusive, neglectful households, with lack of positive role models.
- 4. Prayers to reduce the "demand" on illicit drugs in our community and in our nation. The demand for drugs are responsible for a significant amount of gun violence.
