CITY & GOVERNMENT

Chief Hwang's Message:

We want to thank you and your congregation and other churches for the continual prayers that watch over and lift up police officers here in Federal Way, as well as continued support and prayers for the entire community. It has been a challenging year and the support from the faith community, in part, has helped us to endure during these difficult times.

Gun violence continues to plague our communities in our nation. Our country is experiencing an increase in gun violence, and the greater Seattle-Tacoma region is caught up in it. Recently in Federal Way we experienced several shootings in a short span of time.

In United States, there were 21,570 murders in 2020, compared with 16,425 murders in 2019, an increase of 29%. In Washington State, there were 302 murders in 2020 in comparison to 206 in 2019, an increase of 46%. In King County, there were 102 murders in 2020, and 69 fatal shooting victims, an increase of 27%. In the first six months of 2021, there has been 42 fatal shooting victims in King County, which is up 46%. In Federal Way, we have experienced six murders year to date. Violent crime is on the rise in Washington and in King County.

With changes in our public environment, it is likely that unacceptable level of gun violence will continue in our region. Much of gun violence has nexus to drugs. Shootings often stem from drug transactions and

drug rips. Drug activity is a primary contributing factor for gun violence and other crimes in our community.

Prayer requests:

- 1. Pray for all of our brave police officers who are working tirelessly to protect our community.
- 2. Pray for all those impacted by gun violence, that they feel the presence of the Lord's protection and love.
- 3. Pray specifically for a safe community and reduction in crime, particularly for the decrease of gun violence in our region involving young men.
- 4. Pray for families a high percentage of violent individuals grow up in abusive, neglectful households, with lack of positive role models.
- 5. Prayers to reduce the "demand" on illicit drugs in our community and in our nation. The demand for drugs, particularly fentanyl and methamphetamine, are responsible for a significant amount of violence. If we can reduce the demand for drugs, our community and country would be much safer.
