8 SECTORS OF SOCIETY PRAISE REPORTS AND PRAYER TARGETS CITY AND GOVERNMENT

Praise Report:

From the Mayor's office: Thank you so much for reaching out to pray for us. What a great program! We at the city are so blessed to have such a caring and compassionate faith community supporting what we do every day.

Mayor Jim Ferrell hosted the annual State of the City address. He reported that crime continues to go down compared to last year. He included Pastors Dan Larson and Joe Bowman as event emcees and gave a shout out to We Love Our City. God is giving us, the faith community of Federal Way, much favor with the city government.

Young Life hosted their annual fundraiser. Many city leaders and community members attended and heard a very clear message of salvation and hope. Much money was raised for our young people to know Jesus.

Report from Police Chief Andy Hwang

While crime in general continues a subtle downward trend, like other cities in the King/Pierce County area we are dealing with a recent uptick in armed robbery. Unlike car prowling and burglaries, this wrinkle places victims themselves at greater risk. The robberies are attributed to increase in drug addicts.

God continues to show himself faithful as he is protecting our officers from harm on a daily basis. We attribute much of this protection to the prayers offered by believers in our community.

We appreciate your prayers of gratitude. We (the people of Federal Way) receive heaven's help and protection in enumerable ways and we want to be grateful recipients of that divine care.

Prayer requests:

Pray that robberies in our community will reduce before they become worse. We have seen a reduction for the first two months in 2019.

Pray for wisdom in dealing with the many challenges our city is facing with the crisis of homelessness. Mayor Jim Ferrell hosted an annual luncheon with the

faith based community and local non profits to discuss ways to assist the homeless, especially in times of extreme weather.

Pray for wisdom, protection and safety for our first responders and their families. Pray for Christian leaders to rise up to support those facing difficult situations, discouragement and thoughts of suicide.

We know that some in our community are likely struggling with opioid addiction, their own relationships with their families and loved ones, or even mental health. Pray that when approached by outreach workers or our police officers, they open their hearts to receiving help to deal with whatever is facing them.

Pray for our police officers going into the homeless camps and interacting with the transient population every day. They make difficult decisions with how best to proceed with those suffering from mental illness or those with nothing to lose.

Pray for our officers: We recently had a few officers that returned fire with their service weapons at a suspect a couple of weeks ago. Pray that they can come back to work without long-lasting effects from the shooting.

Pray for our road maintenance workers, who will likely be out and about more in the coming weeks. Please help protect them from distracted or aggressive drivers out on the road.

Pray against SB 5689 The bill singles out and promotes protection for Transgender Students. All students deserve to be protected from bullying; no group deserves special treatment. Like the Sex Ed bill, it is a way for OSPI to force its own ideological system on every family, school, and school district.

Pray against SB 5395 The bill violates the local control of parents and the elected school boards. WE do not want Comprehensive Sexual Education as defined by the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) SB 5395 seeks to make CSE 'integral' to the district's curriculum. Usually, integration means cross-teaching, or integrating, curricula into one another – Math into English, Science into History, etc. Doing so with CSE would make it impossible for parents to 'Opt-Out' their children from CSE.

Pray against SB 5082 No Social Emotional Learning programs in our public schools.

Pray against SB 5356 No special LGTBQ commission that would destroy religious freedom in our state.

CHURCH

Praise reports:

The Churches in Federal Way are planning to worship and pray together on Good Friday. Unity brings about spiritual transformation. Praise God for the Churches in Federal Way and their cooperation in the Gospel.

We are also going to gather for the National Day of Prayer on May 2nd at Integrity Life Church. Pray for all 24/7 slots to be filled so every moment in Federal Way there is a prayer covering over our city.
