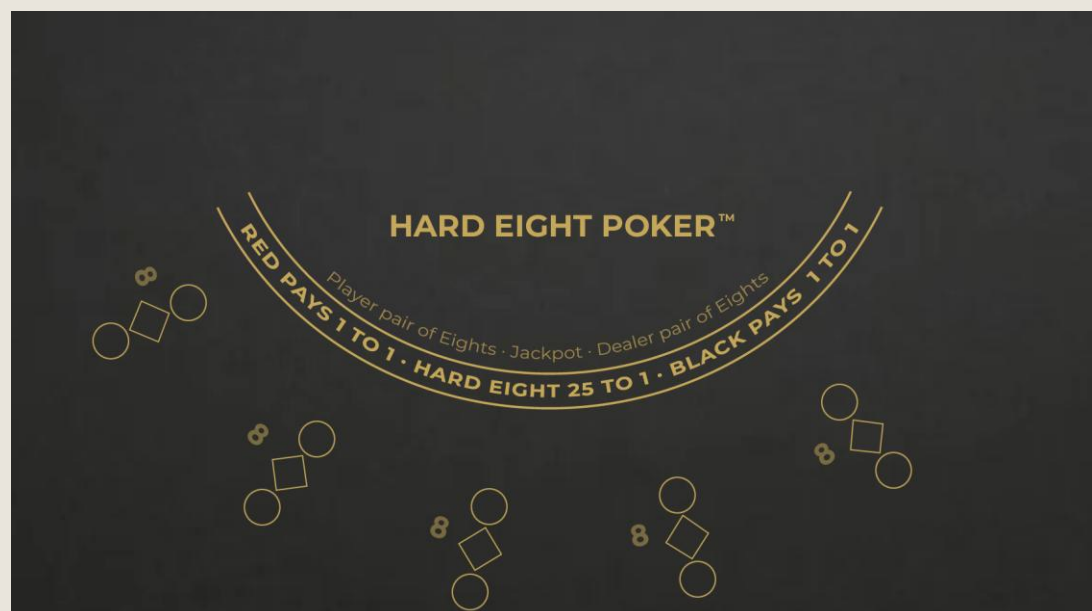

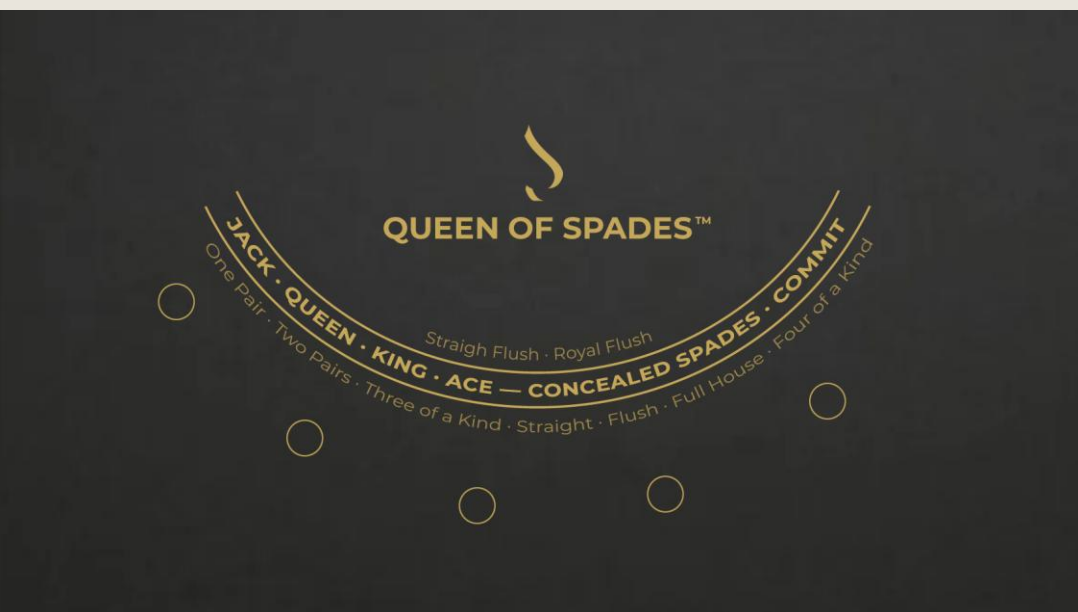

Draw Sevens™

Instant Outcome — fast, intuitive play with immediate tension, sustained engagement and progressive jackpots.

Hard Eight Poker™

Sequential Decisions — layered choices, rising anticipation and dynamic betting.

High Court Poker™

Continuous Flow — fast-paced card play with instant anticipation.

Crown 31™

Precision Resolution — higher strategic tension, deeper commitment.
Homage to Blackjack, but it ends there.

Desur™

Survival Tension — a progressive card challenge built around prediction, endurance and survival.

SIXENSE™

Progressive Commitment — temptation and consequence. Five cards, or go SIXTH.

House edge is based on the total
wagered at optimal play.

Imperial Poker™

House edge: 2.10%



SIXENSE™

House edge: 2.65%



COHA Poker™

House edge: 3.19%

Mechanics exist to support the player's experience — not to become the experience.



Queen of Spades™

House edge: 2.60%

House edge is based on the total
wagered at optimal play.



Draw Sevens™

performance sample

Round Speed and Wagering Capacity €720K - €2.6M

Single-Hand Play

- 300 rounds per hour
- €3,000 wagered per hour
- GGR €79 per hour

Three-Hand Play

- 180 rounds per hour
- €5,400 wagered per hour
- GGR €142 per hour

House Edge: 2.64%

Designed for fast rounds and continuous play.

Speed and simplicity are often underestimated in modern game design.

Higher round frequency increases wagering turnover within each player session. Ultimately, round frequency drives wagering volume.

Single-Hand Play

5 active players

Per hour: €396

Five hours/day: €1,980

Annual GGR: €722,700

Three-Hand Play

5 active players

Per hour: €712

Five hours/day: €3,564

Annual GGR: €1,300,860

10 active players

Per hour: €792

Five hours/day: €3,960

Annual GGR: €1,445,400

10 active players

Per hour: €1,425

Five hours/day: €7,128

Annual GGR: €2,601,720

€720K - €1.4M

€1.3M - €2.6M

GGR calculated on average bet €10.

Illustrative comparison: €70–€80 GGR/hour vs typical online blackjack €7–€10 GGR/hour.
