

## THE PROBLEM:

- Deep partisan divisions, media fragmentation, misinformation, and toxic politics are eroding civic engagement and depleting social capital.
- **Digital natives** under 40 could determine the next decade of American policy, but over half **are checked out, alienated from institutions, and not voting.**
- **Political violence is surging** as civic participation plummets—Reuters tracked at least 370 cases since January 6, 2021, including 51 in 2024 and dozens more in 2025, a level unseen since the 1970s.

Activating this voting bloc could determine the next decade of American policy, while low participation enables extremists on both sides to dominate the agenda.

That's why we're raising \$200K to build a nonpartisan digital solution that turns individual concerns into collective civic power.

THE SOLUTION: VoterPrime is a free mobile app that enables users to act quickly, easily, and, confindently based on their values.

- Users describe their top concerns in their own words.
- The app uses Natural Language Processing (NLP) and Machine Learning (ML) to match user concerns to policy terms.
- VoterPrime then delivers:
  - Aligned candidates and ballot measures
  - Ready-to-send emails to elected officials
  - Relevant petitions and interest groups
  - Civic ed resources from reputable, nonpartisan sources

### WHY IT WILL WORK:

- Digital natives expect personalized, values-driven experiences.
- Actions aligned with core values are intrinsically motivating, and clear, guided steps build voter agency and civic habits.
- When more constituents engage, politicians—who prioritize reelection—are incentivized to represent their interests!

### WHO BENEFITS?

- **Civic partners** gain from VoterPrime as an entry point—the app funnels users through civic "baby steps" toward increased engagement and voter activity.
- **Change advocates**—candidates, petition champions, civic educators, and elected officials—gain exposure to potential voters who were previously disengaged.
- **Society** benefits when leaders are held accountable to a broader, more engaged citizenry.

- 22% Prototyping, User Testing, UX Design \$44K
- 45% MVP Development & Deployment (full tech stack) \$90K
- 15% Technology & Infrastructure \$30K
- 18% Support Activities (fundraising, product management) \$36K

- Build prototype (v1 of policy mapping + clickable demo of core functionality) initial UX/UI
- Conduct user testing with target users, gather feedback on value, appeal, and usability
- Refine policy mapping engine & UX/UI design evolve requirements for MVP
- MVP development (full tech stack, data privacy, analytics & deployment)
- Launch app with civic partners in time for Nov midterms & gather user data
